PASYWA

Daughter of legendary World Reserve Jr Champion Mare

The mare TAKTIKA, born in 1943 at Tersk Stud, Russia was a daughter of Polish bred stallion Taki Pan (halfbrother to legendary Ofir) and the mare Krona, by French-bred Kann, sire of very brave racers. The dam of Krona was Crabbet Park – bred mare Star of the Hills, who established one of the damlines existing in Russian breeding and that tracks back from desert bred mare Selma whose daughter Sobha (born in Egypt) was imported to Crabbet in XIXth century. This line, lengthened by Taktika, made one of the biggest merits to worldwide breeding of Arabian horses. All 15 foals of Taktika (6 colts and 9 fillies) sired by different stallions had all and the same marking – the marking of future wins, both at shows and the race courses. Probably the most known produce of Taktika was 1954 born Pietuszok that, widely used in Poland, was a sire to Algonkina – dam of legendary Janów Podlaski brood matron: Algeria while US-born Gaypolka (Pietuszok x Caliope), purchased from Poland in utero happened to be a

great grandsire of 1999 World Champion Stallion – Galba, while Orla & Orzel (full siblings by Pietuszok) became legendary stakes winners and establishers of excellent race lines in Poland and USA.

Taktika was bred to Priboj 9 times, besides Pietuszok producing 2 more colts and 6 fillies. Many of them established valuable racing lines in Russia nowadays. One of the daughters was 1952 born POTENCJA a future Derby winner. She came to Poland to be included into Michałów State Stud breeding program where she was great producer giving birth to 2 colts and 5 fillies. Her 1966 daughter – POTĘGA by Czardasz (grandson of Ofir and Kuhailan Zaid desert bred) was granddam of PASSA1980 (Eukaliptus x Pascha by El Paso), World Reserve Junior Champion Mare and All Nations Cup Champion Filly-the first mare that won the trophy at World Championships for Michałow Stud!

PASSA turned the history of Polish private Arabian horse breeding out! Her first son used in breeding was Posejdon by Falsyfikat, sold to Bautista-Vich stud in Mallorca, Spain, where he is still admired as a sire and beloved for his beauty and calm character in the age of 21 now: „He has been a great show horse, a very nice producer, the sweetest riding horse ever and of course a friend forever – says Antonia Bautista - He has overreached all my expectations since my father imported him from Poland. And we are still enjoying 3-4 times a week a walk in the afternoon around the farm, to have a look to our mares, to see the youngsters having fun and of course sharing some confidences about our plans for the breeding program at Bautista-Vich. I don't want to wait until we have to say goodbye to each other...to thank him for all the good moments we have spent together.”

Pasja (Wojslaw x Passa) born 1995 continued the line at Michalów Stud producing some great mares valuable in

Poland and abroad – at the recent 2012 Prague Intercup show we could see her lovely 2002 daughter POLONIA by Ekstern owned by Knocke Arabians, who became Gold Champion Mare of Prague European Cup. The greatest and show entitled line of Passa was settled at the Polish private farm – Slowianin Argo, being one of the very first private farms established in Poland after II World War in the difficult times of communism. This breeding program happily and succesfully survived with over 30 years of its history until nowadays. Passa was acquired by Slowianin Agro farm in 1995 being an unquestionable beauty and noble addition to its forming breeding program. The last daughter of PASSA was Pasywa by Wachlarz, born in the year 2000, the same when her mother left to the greener pastures. PASYWA although without an important show palmares herself she became the strong bridge passing the genes of wonderful World Reserve Champion Mare Passa into the future – her grandget and great grandget, bred by Slowianin Agro is

being seen at Polish and international showrings today.

The first daughter of Pasywa was 2005 born filly PASYMA - 3rd placed at difficult Białka Junior Spring Show in Poland that is the first Polish show of the season with roughly over 150 entries of horses 1-3 years old entered each year.

Maternal sister to PASYMA – PASTERNA born 2007 by Ekstern went even better with her show results becoming Autumn Show Champion Filly at Janów Podlaski, 2nd at Polish Nationals in Janów Podlaski (scored 91,00) , 3rd at Białka Junior Spring Show (scored 90,33) and Top Ten of the group at European Championships! She is now sold to Suweco Stud in Czech Republic.

This perfect match with Triple Crowned champion producer – Ekstern was a brilliant breeding idea of Mr Błaszczyk. Later this damline produced the best with Ekstern indeed! Her owner bred Pasywa to Ekstern 3 times. In 2008, 2010 and 2011. As first foal of that cross an amazing darkgrey filly PAEMA was born, having one of the most spectacular movements one may have seen on the little foal. She debuted at Janów Podlaski Autumn Show as class winner and Junior Champion Filly.

Later she continued her triumphant march gaining 2nd place in the class (after further Silver Medal winner) of Bairactar Memorial International Show in Marbach/Germany, and 2nd in the class at B International Show in Strohen/Germany as well as 4th (scored 90,00 points) at Polish National Show

in Janów Podlaski in 2012, getting one of the best total score for movements from the whole show! This success she repeated one month later at 2012 Breeders Championship Europe – Warsaw becoming Silver Medal filly having one of the best movements at the show. This is not a surprise that the breeder continued covering her mother – Pasywa to Ekstern again twice having nice chestnut colt – PASJANS sold to UK and 2011 filly, also darkgrey like Paema – named PATJENA. In the opinion of many visitors to Słowianin Agro this filly, yearling now, looks comparable or even more promising to Paema and the first high prize offers has been made for her already. The owner, being long time experienced breeder is not very willing to sell his best foals however this year Słowianin Agro would like to share its success proudly offering for those who would like to add some unquestionable promise of the future show trophies – no one else then...PASYWA herself a fantastic daughter of legendary World Reserve Champion PASSA and granddam to the most show entitled Paema!

In the moment of publishing this article Pasywa is already being sold! But for those who would like to enjoy Passa – Pasywa family at the showrings: look carefully for Paema appearance in 2012 and 2013 season! She will surely catch your eyes with the type and spectacular movements!
