The entire affair had quite a sophisticated European feel to it and the show was better organized, and the venue more beautiful, than at any previous Israeli show. A panel of five international judges, including Mrs. Christianne Chazel from France, Mr. Richard Pihlstrom from France, Dr. Francesco Santoro from Italy, Mr. Jerzy Bialobok from Poland, and Mr. Cedes Bakker from The Netherlands presided over nearly 200 purebred Arabians.

Afula, whose support was felt in so many ways - from the quality of the seating, to the flower arrangements and ring decorations, and simply providing an elegant feeling of sheer quality to the entire physical venue. Massarak showcased its new line-up of passenger cars around the entire show area, and produced an exciting auto rally staged in the horse arena just before the championship classes on Saturday. Other corporate show sponsors included Samsung/Pelephone and Rav-Bariah Doors.

As we have long become accustomed, the Arabians competing were of extremely high quality, and most would

Large enthusiastic crowds were greeted both days with almost perfect weather, and this year's audience included a good number of foreign visitors from both Jordan and Europe who enjoyed the horses and the typically generous Israeli hospitality. The show committee had things down almost to a science, with classes running smoothly and on schedule both days, great background music and show commentary, a very efficient ring crew, and a VIP section boasting a most friendly and attentive staff.

This year the show gained a very supportive corporate partner and major sponsor — Massarak Volkswagon of have been competitive in any showring in the world, especially those in the junior sections and the futurity classes. Once again, a good number of horses were imported throughout this past year specifically to participate in this show which raised the emotional level to an even higher than usual pitch and made the show all the more exciting to watch.

The show began with four very strong futurity classes which attracted a record 43 fillies and colts; each of which had two sections, and it was a great start to this writer's show day that three of the highest placed foals in the Filly

sections were out of mares from her own breeding program. In the first Filly Foal section, the very strong-bodied and upright Seelia (Mouadaar BKV x Atiq Donia) convinced the judges to win both First Place and then Silver Medal Champion Filly Foal, with Second Place awarded to the very typical and beautiful moving True Colours' daughter Shayma Al Ashkar, out of Atiq Tamaara. The classic grey Hala Al Fawaz (Laheeb x Zara TDD) followed with Third Place honors.

In the second section a second True Colours' daughter, the exquisitely refined Riyam HD out of RM Tamaar was

the charismatic Hadaua El Haual (True Honour x RK Mabroukka).

The very typical and pretty bay JPJ Talal AA (Al Baraki x JPJ Talasha) was the judges' choice for both First Place in the Colt Foals b) section and eventual Gold Medal Colt Foal winner. He was followed by the very smooth and refined Al Maraam son Badr (Baraqaa AA), who stood in Second Place and then went on to win the Bronze Medal. Third Place was awarded to the very upright and classic Omer Al Hadivah (Al Hadiyah AA x Zarka).

In the Colt Foals a) section, the very classic and bold Drug Sirin (Phadishah x Chamami) dominated a deep class to win First Place and later the Silver Medal in the Colt Foals section. Second Place honors went to the tall and elegant Ragadan (Extrim DM x AA Ghaniyah) and Third to Yearling Fillies was also divided into two sections, and attracted many strong contenders from the local show scene as well as some high competitive new imports. The locally-bred and very classic Daliyah AA (Nader Al Jamal x Dafina AA) scored very high marks for Type and Head & Neck to win First Place and eventually the Bronze Medal of the Fillies section. Second Place went to the elegant liver chestnut MD Serafina (Stival x Anastasiaa) who gave a sterling ring performance, and Third Place was awarded to still another True Colours' daughter, the recently imported Italian-bred Miss Magic MyLove (x Magic Ma Cherie).

In the b) section of Yearling Fillies, the wonderfully charismatic and exotic Italian-bred Alfabia Mascat (Marwan Al Shaqab x Star of the Hills) totally charmed judges and spectators with her extreme type and extravagant movement to win First Place in her age section and the title of Gold Medal Champion Filly at the end of the day. Mascata garnered the first two scores of 20 of the show, including one for Type and one for Head and Neck, and also earned the highest score awarded at this show, with 92.4 points. Second Place was awarded to the lovely Laheeb daughter Safiyyah AA (x Saniyyah RCA), who scored a very solid 90.6 points and is a direct daughter of this year's Silver Medal Mare. A second Laheeb daughter, the classic and refined Basmah AA

bred Justina KA (WH Justice x Ciarka), who earned a very solid score of 90.6.

A very strong b) section was won by a second Q Marc daughter, the bay Zahared Dream (x Zarpa), who continued on to win the Silver Medal in the Filly section. Both Q Marc fillies were bred by Christine Jamar of Belgium, who, we are pleased to say, attended this year's show. In Second Place stood the scopey bay American import Americaan Sky (Stival x Americaan Beauty), who was Spring Show Gold Medal Filly earlier this year. The locally-bred Maiuma BKV (Leran AA x Shakyra) stood Third, earning high scores for both Type and for Movement.



The Eight Year & Older Stallions class was filled with popular local and international show winners, all of which had very loyal and vocal audience support, but there was no question that the beautiful Laheeb son AA Assal out of Asia Atiq Donia), maternal brother to this year's Silver Medal Filly Foal, who earned a score of 20 for movement and a very good total score of 90.3 points.

Just before the final championship classes the 2011 WAHO Cup was awarded with full ceremony to the multichampion 2000 mare W Warda (MH Weston x Queens Allegiance), bred by Weston LTD, and owned by Yusuf Assali. Warda remained undefeated in halter competition throughout a long show career and the dam of many influential Israeli champions and halter winners.




