European Championships - Verona

A t November 5th till 6th the European Championships were being held at the annual horse fair in Verona, Italy, A wonderful set-up with beautiful decoration and a big arena.

The judges for this event were mrs. Maria Annaratone Ferraroni from Italy, Mr. Christian Bourrasse from France, mr. Manfred Neubacher and Mr. Ferdinand Huemer from Austria, Mr. Marc Ismer from Germany, Mr. Peter Upton from the UK and Mrs. Christina Wale from Sweden.

The day started with the one year old fillies. Winner of this class was Marc's Star (QR Marc x FS Magnums Madonna) – bred and owned by Knocke Arabians from Belgium. Later in the championship, this filly took the golden medal of the junior fillies! The 2nd position was for her half-sister Wieza Mocy (QR Marc x Wieza Marzen) – bred and owned by Michalow Stud from Poland. Later in the final championship, this filly took the bronze medal!

After this great start, it was time for the yearlingcolts to make their entry! First in class was MM Nevio (Lorenzo el Bri x Nautis el Perseus) – bred and owned by Mario Matt from Austria. Later in the junior male championships, Nevio conquered the bronze medal!

2nd in his class was Forelock's Le Charmeur (Psytudel x La Brunette) – bred by the Kuijf family from Holland and in ownership of Al Muawd Stud from Saudi Arabia,

Next to go was a wonderful class of very high quality 2 years old fillies. A real eyecatcher was the WH Justice daughter Shirin by Aisha, who surprisely made it 'only' to a fifth place, achieving both a 20 and an 18,5 on head and neck. This strange judging remarkably continued during the whole show.

Classwinner of this beautiful class was Zigi Zana (QR Marc x Zagrobla) – bred and owned by Michalow stud and later winner of the silver medal in the junior championship. Runner up was her half sister and stable mate Waranga (QR Marc x Wilga).

The 2 years old colts were the next to enter the ring. Won by the beautiful Esspressivo (QR Marc x Emocja) — bred and owned by Knocke Arabians from Belgium. Later this colt took the silver medal in the final colt championships. 2nd in this class was Dream Design (Master Design x Psyannah) — bred by the Jones family of the UK and in ownership of Muawd Stud from Saudi Arabia. Later in the final championship he was awarded with the 4th position within the top five.

The show continued with the 3 years old mares. Again a beautiful class won by Psyche Kreuza (Ekstern x Pallas_Atena) – bred and owned by Chrcynno Palace Stud from Poland. Later in the final championship, this mare was awarded with the 5th position within the top five junior females.

2nd in this class was Al Princess Aliha (WH Justice x Al Aliha) – bred and owned by Al Hambra Arabians from Austria, taking a 4th position in the final Top Five of junior females.

Last to go within the juniors was the class of the three year old colts. A strong class, lead by the incredible beautiful Shangai EA (WH Justice x Salymah) – bred by Equus Arabians and in ownership of Sorroca Albert from Spain. Who also easily conquered the championship title of the junior colts.

2nd place was for the big moving Marshan (Meshan ihn Kubinec x Marni) – bred and owned by Sax Arabians – taking the 5th position within the top five of the final junior colt championships.

After these junior classes, it was time for the seniors!

First to start was the class of 4-6 year old mares. Won by Alia EA (Khidar x Arabeska) – bred by Agropecunaria del Mojanes from Spain and in ownership of Muawd Arabians from Saudi Arabia, This beautiful mare later took the gold medal in the final senior mare championships, surprising everyone! 2nd in class was Altamira (Ekstern x Altona) – bred and owned by Janow Podlaski from Poland.

Because of the size of the senior mare classes, there was also a B-section of the 4-6 years old mares, won by Chaos Persefona (Poganin x Ceres) – bred and owned by Chreynno Palace Arabians from Poland. Later in the final championships, this mare took the 5th position in the final top Five.

2nd in this class was Djoonam OS (Ajman Moniscione x Khaleifa) – bred by Osterhof Gestut from Germany and in ownership of Albidayer Stud from the UAE.

Next to go was one of the most excited classes of the event. The 7-9 year old mares. The whole class was filled with Polish beauties sired by Gazal al Shaqab. As they are all worth mentioning, I will mention them all.

First in class and later Reserve champion mare was Pistoria (Gazal al Shaqab x Palmira) — bred and owned by Michalow Stud — this mare scored 20's on type, head and neck and the full 5x20 for movement, earning a total of 94.5 points!

With only 0.1 point less followed by Etnologia (Gazal al Shaqab x Etalanta) Also a big moving beauty coming from the stables of Janow Podlaski, Later in the final


championship, this mare achieved the bronze medal with the senior mares.

3rd in class with 93.70 points was Wilda (Gazal al Shaqab x Wilga) from the stables of Michalow, scoring almost a perfect line with 4x 20 and 1x 19,5 points for movement!

In the 4th position was Belgica (Gazal al Shaqab x Perforacja) from Janow Podlaski Stud, scoring the highest points on type. In the 5th position was Perfirka (Gazal al Shaqab x Perforacja) from Bialka Stud. A mare with a beautiful arched neck, collecting a total of 92.10 points.

After this exciting class, it was time for the 10 years and older mares. Also a very beautiful class. Winner with 94.4 points and a big line up of 20's in both type, head and neck and movement, was former worldchampion Emmona (Monogramm

x Emilda) from Michalow Stud in Poland. Later in the championships she surprisely ended up 4th in the Top Five.

2nd in this class was another former worldchampion mare, Zagrobla (Monogramm x Acuba) – also from the Michalow stables in Poland. Strangely this mare totally disappear in the final top Five of Senior mare in the later followed championships.

After these classic beauties, it was time for the big moving boys!

A big class of 4-6 years old stallions made their entry. All snoring and blowing with tails up in the air, full of energy and power. Leader of this class and later silver medal winner was Ali Moniscione (Psytadel x Alianna Moniscione) — bred and owned by the Buzzi family from Italy and on lease to Blue Valley Arabians

from Germany. Runner up in this class was Kabsztad (Poganin x Kwestura) – bred and owned by Michalow Stud from Poland. Later in the final Top Five, Kabsztad got the 5th position.

The 7-9 years old stallions were up next. Winner and later Gold medal winner at the final championships was Lorenzo el Bri (CH el Brillo x Lara el Ludjin) – bred by La Movida Arabians from Austria and in ownership of Mario Matt. This boy scored the perfect 5x20 for movement!

2nd in class and later bronze medal winner was LVA Maximus (Espano Estopa x Challon Salana) – bred by Lilyview Arabians and in ownership of Athbah stud from Saudi Arabia.


