
Very good result monthly tender



of the Michałów's in October





Almost 120 thousand euro (119800 exactly) was the result of the Michałów's monthly tender held on Saturday, October 7th. It was organized at the end of the week of breeding inspections at the State Studs in Poland. The most expensive Arabian mare of the four that found new homes (in total eight were offered) was the 8 year old Endrra (Ekstern - Endorra/Pesal), in foal to Sahm El Arab. She was sold for 60 thousand euro to Al Baydaa Stud, Egypt. The other three were sold to Italy: the two year old Flamia (El Omari - Flaminia/Gaspar), the 11 year old Wazira (Wachlarz – Wróżka/Ganges), in foal to Equator and the 9 year old Dżakarta (Piruet – Dombra/ Eldon), bred to Empire. The stallion Larando (QR Marc - Laranda/Ekstern) was purchased by an owner from the UAE (Babel Stud Poland).

The result seems to be more than satisfaying. Together with the half-bred mares, 25 horses were offered. Between the buyers that took part in the bidding there were guests from abroad that proved to be very effective and most of the horses purchased left the country. Maybe the Polish breeders wait for the Winter Sale – last year the majority of the mares sold at the Michałów's December auction went to Polish private breeders. Anyway, the October tender is a good omen. It shows that there is demand for Polish horses. The potential buyers expect interesting offer, efficient bidding and prices that match with the horses' quality. All that we could witness at Michałów Stud in October.
