

Chilean NATIONAL shows an evolving Breeding

t is always good to be in Santiago for the Chilean National, which this year had as the stage the International Equestrian Club of La Dehesa, located in a new and noble neighborhood of the capital Santiago from March 25th to 26th. In addition to the beautiful presentation of horses for the halter judgment, the Chilean breeders welcomed their visitors, mainly Brazilians breeders, who were able to defray the extraordinary reception in two magnanimous dinners at the residences of the president of the Chilean Association of Breeders, Hernan Chadwick and that of its Director José Miguel Bulnes.

The horses shown in this National once again surprised by the beauty and quality. Brazilian judges Reinaldo Rocha Leão and Cesar Schmidt who have already judged

the Chilean National to emphasize the evolution of the quality of the country's horses: "Every year I come to Chile I realize a significant genetic improvement of the breeding," says Reinaldo. "I always try to follow what happens in the Latin America breeding and Chile is undoubtedly a great highlight," says Cesar. Already the American judge Doug Dahmen relates of being in Chile many years ago and you can not make comparisons, "Back then it was a breeding looking for a way, today you see that the way was found, so I saw here horses that would compete in any show of the world. "- assures Dahmen.

On the ring many exciting moments. The three judges were keen to emphasize that the Senior Mare Championship as the most beautiful and unanimous Champion Lumiar Ethna



as the best horse in the show. Doug Dahmen stressed that he recently judged important shows in the US and Europe where Lumiar Ethna would certainly be a highlight: "Ethna is among the most beautiful and correct mares I have ever judged, it was a privilege to judge her" - guarantees Dahmen. Lumiar Ethna was National Champion Filly in Brazil, before arriving in Chile. She is a daughter of RFI Maktub, the father of the well-known RFI Farid sire who today is in the United Arab Emirates. Ethna also begins to stand out as a dam, her first daughter, Gloriosa El Power was Champion Jr. Filly unanimous in this show. Gloriosa is the daughter of Power World JQ, so she is the paternal sister of the beautiful Miss El Power JQ, important mare of Al Shaqab Stud. The Reserve National Champion 2017 was Brahma, a daughter of the Chilean sire LC Farid. Champion Ethna, her daughter Gloriosa and Reserve Brahma are owned by the Haras Panquehue of the Bulnes Family and the Haras Águas Claras of the Chadwick family. The Bronze Mare was Alma Al Ventur, daughter of Bertrand Carol grandson of Parys El Jamaal owned by Dutch Matthei of Haras Lonco. Another great moment was the dispute of Stallion Senior Championship. Two National Brazilian Champions made

exciting clash in ring of the Club Ecuestre: Jazeer De Wiec by Debowiec of Haras Panquehue and Aguas Claras of Bulnes and Chadwick families and Matisse FM by Marwan Al Shaqab owned by Dutch Matthei from Haras Lonco. The unanimous Champion was Jazzer De Wiec, Reserve Matisse FM and Bronze was HP Al Fayed by Johann El Jamaal from Haras Panquehue. At the end of the judgment Rocha Leão commented that the two stallions had many qualities: "They are very good horses with great attributes, but today the Champion Jazeer seemed to me brighter, with more attitude" – concluded.

The Judge Doug Dahmen drew attention to the Young Horse Championship, specifying the unanimous HP Alí Champion of Haras Panquehue and Águas Claras, son of HP Shakir by LC Farid: "A distinguished horse, of great beauty and many qualities, will certainly have great future in the shows "-said Dahmen. Rocha Leão remembered that he last saw him when he was Brazilian National Champion Colt two years ago: "Alí impressed me today because he has evolved a lot since he was a Champion in Brazil. He was already a very good colt and is becoming a sensational horse". The Reserve Champion was LL Mag Beau son of LL Maglud by ZT

Magnanimous of the Haras La Laguna by Alfredo Hasbún and the Bronze was HP Mabrouk also son of HP Shakir of the Haras Panquehue of the Bulnes family.

Overall Championships females pleased enough judges and Cesar Oliveira much praised Young Mare Championship, for him the Champion LL My Khart was one of the shows' highlights: "A beautiful mare, refined, a long set of throat and neck, and very balanced. "The three winning mares of this Championship are based on the LL breeding program of Haras La Laguna by Alfredo Hasbún. Champion LL My Khart by Alfredo Hasbún and Reserve HHC Ali K by Carlos Barros of Haras Hacienda Chada, are daughters of LL Khartoum by Esfahan / Echo Magnifficoo, sire of Hasbún and Bronze LL Fernanda also of Hasbún is daughter of Señor Magnum by Magnum Psyche. The mothers of the three Champions are Haras La Laguna's mares: LL My Dream is the mother of Champion LL My Khart, the mother of Reserve HHC Ali K is Albujaira and Bronze's LL Fernanda mother is LL Sweet Dream.

The grandson of Echo Magnifficoo LL Khartoum is also the father of the unanimous Colt Champion Altovalsol Jagger of the Haras Altovalsol of Ricardo Walsen. The Reserve was

Among Fillies besides Lumiar Ethna's daughter the Champion Glory El Power, won the Reserve Championship Llancay Shakyra daughter of Llancay Sultan and the Bronze was another Shakira, LL Shakira by Bey Shadow TGS of Haras La Laguna de Alfredo Hasbún.

In the Jr. Filly Championship the judge Rocha Leão was enthusiastic about the Champion HSA Afrika: "I liked her a lot, she's lovely, with a lot of type and very feminine", he said. Afrika HSA is the bread by Haras Santa Ana of the Kassis Sabag family and daughter of Leonardo GA, a son of DA Vince FM imported from the United States by Jaime Valdez. Reserve was Llancay Jade by HP Shakir of Nicolas Duch from Haras Llancay and the Bronze was HDM Sapphire by HDM Maktub of Haras El Mar by Diego Benavente. In the Jr. Colt Championship, the sire HP Shael, son of LC Farid of Bey Shah's line, is the father of the three winners. The unanimous Champion HP Hariry, the Reserve HP Hadidy, both of the Bulnes Family from Haras Panquehue and the Bronze HL Borago of the Lonas Haras of Duch Matthei. □
