Nelle giornate di Febbraio che vanno dal 15 al 19 si sono presentati nello splendido ring di BAIT AL ARAB, 407 cavalli, così divisi: 185 nel 1° Campionato Internazionale del Kuwait e 222 nell'Egyptian Event. Questo, per noi Europei è un evento molto ambito e prestigioso nell'ambito degli show, peccato che un numero così alto di cavalli è ancora oggi solo un sogno per i nostri organizzatori!

Il festival è stato patrocinato da Mr. Mohammed Jassim Al Marzouq e dall'affascinante Sheikha Sarah Fahad Al Sabah sempre presente, molto attiva e disponibile a scendere nel ring a premiare i vincitori. Ma il cuore pulsante, onnipresente e sempre disponibile a tutti è stato quello di Klaus Beste; "The voice" di uno degli show più importanti d'Europa (Aachen), è qui in Kuwait con il ruolo di direttore del centro e organizzatore dell'evento. Ruolo per altro che gli si addice in pieno, sempre cordiale, ottimo coordinatore, si è prestato in ogni occasione a favore sia del benessere dei cavalli che di noi ospiti. Inoltre l'organizzazione ha provveduto anche a farci visitare numerosi allevamenti in Kuwait.

Il territorio sul quale sono situati queste meravigliose farm si trova a circa 60 km dalla city. In località Al Wafra si trovano, Ezzain Arabians di Mr. Usamah Alkazemi, dove ci è stata proposta una presentazione dei prodotti del programma allevatorio della farm, magistralmente presentati dal trainer.

Over the years, Tutto Arabi has attended many shows around the world but never before have there been so many horses registered or so many handlers, members of the public and breeders from all over the world. And as you may notice from the logos in the photos, there were also a large number of sponsors.

From 15th to 19th February, 407 horses were shown in the splendid ring of BAIT AL ARAB. They were divided as follows: 185 horses took part in the 1st Kuwait International Championship; 222 horses took part in the Egyptian Event.

For us Europeans, this venue is considered one of the most prestigious shows. What a shame that such a high number of registrations is still a dream for our Organizers!

The Festival was under the patronage of Mr. Mohammed Jassim Al Marzouq and the lovely Sheikha Sarah Fahad Al Sabah who was as always very pro-active and happy to enter the show ring for the prize giving.

The 'soul' of the Show was the ever-present and always willing Klaus Beste. The 'voice' of Aachen, one of the most important shows in Europe, is now in Kuwait and Director of the Center as well as Organizer of this venue. This is the perfect role for him: he is always very polite; he is an excellent coordinator and goes out of his way to make sure horses and guests get the best attention.

While we were there, he made it possible for us to visit a number of Studs about 60 Kms. from the city center. In Al Wafra, we visited Ezzain Arabians owned by Mr. Usamah Alkazemi. His amazing 'production' was beautifully presented by their trainer.

The previous day, we visited the beautiful Ajmal Stud owned by Mr. Mohammed J. Al Marzouq, where we were able to see
