

WEST COAST NATIONAL C SHOW

On October 14th and 15th the annual West Coast Cup took place in Koksijde at the windy coastline of Belgium. As always, perfectly organized by Koenraad Detaillieur and his family. The show was divided between the national c-show on Saturday and the international b-show on Sunday.

Judges for the c-show were Mrs. Janet Court from the UK, Mr. Tommy Husebye from Norway and Mr. Eric Gear from France.

The show started with the foal classes. Both classes had only one participant. Winner with the filly foals was the big moving Amanda (Ajman Moniscione x Evita N) – bred and owned by Noel Gustav. Winner of the colt classes was Red Valentyno-D (Ajman Moniscione x Caprisa) – bred and owned by Dion Arabians.

Next to go was a beautiful class of yearling fillies, won by Safina Apal (Glorius Apal x Lady Brown) – bred by Vlinderbeek Arabians and owned by Hans Serroels.

The yearling colt class was won by Farhan-D (Ajman Moniscione x Farhanah bint Navarrone) – bred and owned by

Dion Arabians, who later took the gold medal at the final junior championships.

The next class was probably the best class of the day. Four impressive young 2-years old fillies made their entry, scoring all very close. Winner of the class and later silver medal winner, was Magnums Tulip (QR Marc x FS Magnums Madonna) – bred and owned by Knocke Arabians.

Also the next class, the 2 years old colts, was an interesting one, won by Al Khabeer-D (Enzo x Khabala) – bred and owned by Dion Arabians. This colt later was named bronze champion colt.

Next to go was again a class of impressive young ladies! The class of the three years old mares. This class was won by the later gold medal winner Jumaanah-D (WH Justice x Classic Junah-D) – bred and owned by Dion Arabians. She scored the same total as the second placed horse, A Golden Girl Kossack (Wh Justice x Abakana Kossack), bred by the Kossack Stud and in ownership of Flaxman Arabians, who later took the bronze medal in the final junior championship.

Another class of high quality youngsters was up next.

Snorting, blowing and moving... the class of the three years old colt was impressive. Won by Panthos (QR Marc x Palanga) – bred and owned by Knocke Arabians. Later this colt took the silver medal in the junior colt championship. Runner up in this class was the impressive and big moving ASE Marajó (Marajj x Manilah) – bred and owned by Arabian Stud Europe.

Off it went with the 4-6 years old mares. Only two showed up. Winner was FLA Excitation (Mistyck el Saintor x Sun Edyka) – bred by F. Leclere and in ownership of SMA Arabians.

Also the 4-6 years old stallions counted only three participants. Winner was the big moving Rectors Ramino (El Amin x Essita), scoring 2x 20 for movement! Ramino is bred and owned by Hubert Rector. This impressive stallion later won the Golden medal in the senior stallion championship. Second in class and later Bronze medal winner was Hypnotic ibn Eternity-D (Eternity ibnNavaronne x WH Marissa Rose) – bred by Dion Arabians and in ownership of B&B Arabians.

The 7-9 years old mares, had only one participant. Besides class winner, this mare was also named gold medal winner and later best in show! FarhannahbintNavarrone-D (Ansata Selman x Navarrone P) is bred and owned by Dion Arabians.

The class of the 7-9 years old stallions was also small with only 2 participants. The class was won by Maymoun ESM (CE Magnum x ESM Kendalina) – bred and owned by ESM Arabians. Besides winning the silver medal in the following senior stallion championship, this stallion also won the giant trophy for best movement, sponsored by Simone Leo of TuttoArabi.

The last two classes of the day were the ones of the 10 years and older mares and stallions, both with only one participant. The mares was won by RWL Odessa Estopa (Om el Abadan x MalikahEstopa) – bred by Redwood Lodge Arabians and in ownership of Flaxman Arabians. This mare later took the bronze medal in the final senior championships. The stallionclass was won by FA Zain (AnsataRamesses x AnsataHajira) – bred and owned by Flaxman Arabians.

WEST COAST INTERNATIONAL B SHOW

On Sunday the show continued with the International B-show. Judges for this show were Mr. Ali Shaarawi from Egypt, Mr. Bob Boggs from the USA, Mr. Jerzy Bialobok from Poland and Mr. AbdelouahedMaagoul from Morocco.

The show started with the foal classes. Both classes had only one participant, both coming from Belgium. Winner with the filly foals was the big moving Amanda (Ajman Moniscione x Evita N) – bred and owned by Noel Gustav. Winner of the colt classes was Red Valentyno-D (Ajman Moniscione x Caprisa) – bred and owned by Dion Arabians.

Off it went with the yearling fillies. A very strong class with the winner and second placed horse, both scoring over the 92 points. Winner of the class was My Fair Rose-D (Marajj x WH Marissa Rose) – bred and owned by Dion Arabians, Belgium. This filly took also the gold medal in the final junior female championships, as well as being named best in show at the end of the day!

Runner up in this tough class was D'Thikra (Marajj x Psynata) – bred and owned by Dubai Arabian Horse Stud, UAE. This filly later achieved the bronze medal in the final championship.

The yearling colt class was up next. Won by CS IzazAsayl (Royal colours x CS Opportunity) who had already an impressive show career during the Middle East show season. This colt was bred by Marco Sensi and is in ownership of Dubai Arabian Horse Stud, UAE. Second in this class was Mabrouk al Jassimya (Shagran al Nasser x Om el Sanadiqa) – bred and owned by Al Jassimya farm, Qatar.

A huge class of two years old fillies followed. Won again by Magnums Tulip (QR Marc x FS Magnums Madonna – bred and owned by Knocke Arabians from Belgium, followed by Forelocks Jessy (Psytadel x Yakima) – bred and owned by Forelocks Arabians from The Netherlands.

The two years old colts where up next, won by Emanos K.A. (QR Marc x Emantka), a colt that was also successfully shown in the Middle East this year. He is bred and owned by Knocke Arabians from Belgium and later took the silver medal in the final junior championship. Second in class was Al Khabeer-D (Enzo x Khabala) – bred and owned by Dion Arabians from Belgium.

Another big filly class was up next. The one of the three years old fillies, won by the black Ava (Vervaldee x Aziza) – bred and owned by Pat Hannay from the UK. Later this filly

took the silver medal at the final junior championships. She later was awarded with the trophy for best moving horse of the show. Second in class was Dhyana K (Shael Dream Desert x Bohitila K) – bred by and in ownership of H.R.H. Mohammed Bin Saud Bin Naif al Saud from Saudi Arabia.

Next to go were the three years old stallions. Won by the later gold medal winner, Mascot des Alpes (Marwan al Shaqab x EAMT Marihuana) – bred by Otto Berg and in ownership of H.R.H. Mohammed Bin Saud Bin Naif al Saud from Saudi Arabia. Second in class and later bronze medal winner was Khalif OS (Marajj x Khaleifa) – bred by GestutOsterhof and in leasing to HarasStigmatas from Brazil.

The show continued with the 4-6 years old mares. Winner and later gold medal winner was Jador Star (Hannibal by Gioia x Lucky's Majarra) – bred Arabian Stars from Italy and in ownership of H.R.H. Mohammed Bin Saud Bin Naif al Saud from Saudi Arabia. Second in this class and later silver medal winner was ESA Naadirah Nile (Ansata Nile Nadir x Imperial Baarikah) – bred by Imperial Egyptian Stud and owned by Hanaya Arabian Stud from Switzerland.

Three stallions of 4-6 years old were entered in the class that followed. Won by Al Aneed LDA (Alixir x IllaMagidaa LDA) – bred LD Arabians and owned by Hanaya Arabian Stud from Switzerland that later took the golden medal. Second in class and later silver medal winner, was GloriusApal (Justify x

Gloria Apal) – bred and owned by James Swaenepoel from Belgium.

Two mares were entered in the next class of 7-9 years old mares, both scoring the exact same score. Winner on type and later bronze medal winner was Zaira by Serengeete (Serongeete x ZawahMamlouk) – bred by PipitonoCalvatore and in ownership of Mauro Morelli from Argentina. Second in class was FarhannahbintNavarrone-D (Ansata Selman x Navarrone P) – bred and owned by Dion Arabians from Belgium.

Next to go was the class of 7-9 years old stallions. Although only two participants, the quality was high. The class was won by MM Fabrizio (CH el Brillo x MFA Forgetmenot), who was later named bronze medal winner – bred by Mario Matt and in ownership of Tripodi Arabians from Italy. Runner up was Redwood Lodge Artique (Al Adeed al Shaqab x Redwood Lodge Romantik) – bred and owned by Redwood Lodge Arabians from Australia.

With these classes the Westcoast Arabian Cup came to an end. As always a very nice and competitive show, although maybe a bit early in the season, as it was still quite cold for both the handlers and the spectators. Seen its beautiful location near the beach, moving the show up further in the year, could be a very good idea! Unless the cold, the show was definitely worth the visit and we will for sure be there again next year!
