Unfortunately the weather gave so much rain the days before and also during the nights that the ground was very slippy and therefor some horses trotted a bit careful.

The weekend started with the National C-show of Holland. Judges for this show were K. Zeevenhoven, Mr. Pittaluga and Mr. Jimenez. Although the judging was a bit off from time to time, giving a 16 and a 19 to the same horse, the average lineup of the horses where quite correct and the competitors where happy with the results.

Off it went with the 3 yrs old mares. Unfortunately only 2 participants in this class. Won by NashakanaKossack (AjaShakakhan x Nereska) – bred by the Kossack Stud and in ownership of E. Loots. 2nd in class was ND's Aruba (Valerio Ibn Eternity VI x Amerika) – bred and owned by ND Arabians.

After the fillies it was time for the young boys. The yearlingclass was won by the flashy Forelocks Yucatan (Psytadel x Yarra). Bred and owned by Forelocks Arabians. This colt took the golden medal in the final colt championships. 2nd in this class was Eroyal T (AV Montoya x Rigona) — bred and owned by the van Duijvenbode Family.

The last class of the day was the one of the stallions 6 years and older and counted only two participants. Class winner and later Gold medal winner was Kubay Khan (Kubinec x Vonaia) – bred and owned by – and on lease to Arabian Fantasie. 2nd and bronze medal winner was ES Rivas (Sivmen B x Raquin) – bred by ES Arabians and is ownership of Benjamin Kooiker.

Before the day ended, two more awards where handed out. One was the trophy for best movement. In every class, the horse with the highest points for movement was nominated to participate for this trophy. Some horses where withdrawn for this last trophy, but still leaving enough participants to bring some excitement to the public! The final winner of the best movement trophy was FS Bengal Bay!

The last trophy was the trophy Best in show. The judges saw again all the gold medal winners and where unable to agree on the best in show winner. In this case, the horse with the highest points of the show was named the winner. In this case it was the stallion Kubay Khan.

With this, the National C-show in Holland came to an end.

The following day, June 17th, it was time for the first International C-show. A well filled show with more than 90 participants! With its location in Holland, being very close to Germany and Belgium, this new international show attracts a lot of competitors from different countries, creating interesting but difficult contestants.

Judges for this show were Mrs. Darius from Germany, Mr. Detailleur from Belgium and Mr. Santoro from Italy.

The show started with a big group of yearling fillies. A class won by the gorgeous grey filly Lola OS (Monther al Nasser x El Lucina) – bred and owned by GestutOsterhof from Germany. This filly later took the silver medal in the final junior mare championships. 2nd in class was the exotic Farida PC (RFI Farid x RC Danzika) – Bred by Mr. Capizzi and in ownership of Aretusa Arabians, Italy.

Next to go where the 2 yrs old fillies class, led by Forelocks Yessy (Psytadel x Yakima) – bred and owned by Forelocks Arabians from Holland. 2nd in this class was A Lady of Kossack (WH Justice xAbakanaKossack) – bred and owned by the Kossack Stud from Holland.

Now it was time for the 3 yrs old fillies to





This mare took straight 20's on type and with this also earned the trophy for best head, generously sponsored by TuttoArabi. Anette was also named gold medal winner in the final junior mare championships.

After these fine young ladies, it was time for the young boys! Again a class of high quality youngsters where entering the arena. The show ended with the class of the veteran stallions, stallions born before 1997. Winner was Kubay Khan (Kubinec x Volnaia) - bred and owned by Stark Arabians, Austria and on lease to Arabian Fantasie, Holland, 2nd in class was FlaxmansRabdan (Niyashin x WaseemSerasaaba) - bred and owned by Flaxman Arabians, Belgium.
