# Mourshed Al Rayan renews its glory and gains championship of Lebanon, Silket Maria on the mares category and Zeina El Amin on fillies

Under the patronage of Sheikh Hamdan Bin Zayed Al Nahyan and Al Khalediah Stables, along with a group of companies, among which are: Dar Al Hayat, Laha magazine, Aramex belonging to Al Mokshef Group, property of His Royal Highness Prince Khaled Bin Sultan Bin Abdul Aziz, the Arab Horse Breeding Association has organized Lebanon's third regional Arabian Halter competition, which took place at the Al Rehab Equestrian Club in Zahle and had a remarkable attendance compared to the past two championships. The event had an increasing attendance of Arabian horse lovers, owners of horses participating in the competition, as well as a number of Arabian horse breeders from Syria and Jordan, headed by the Ambassador of Kuwait, and Ambassador of Poland, Deputy Assem Araji, Engineer Elias Saba, representative of the Ministry of Tourism Fadi Abboud, Head of Interior Security Forces in Bekaa Region General Emil Atallah, Commandant Ibrahim Jomaa, representing the Director of General Security Major General Ashraf Rifi, Ali Sabri Hmade, and several security leaders. The participating horses, reaching to 65 horses, were distributed among eleven categories, with a high level competi-

tion, under the supervision of a committee of international juries, we shall mention: Mr. Bassel Jadaan from Syria, Irena Sticklers from Russia, Carine Macray from America, Abdallah Daraki from Jordan and Tarek Hamza from Egypt. The competitions led to the following results: First Category: One- year- old yearling fillies This category witnessed a high level of competition. The first place was gained by the filly Zeina Al Amine that reached this position with one point ahead of its competitor Ramira Rose.
