FFICULT START

ot without some organization problems causing the delays, the third and last of qualifying shows of 2012 Breeders Championship Europe, held in Poland, was finally run during September weekend in Warsaw, at huge and comfortable Torwar arena located in beautiful central part of Polish capital city.

The overall event is a new idea of new community organ (established 2010) in Arabian horse world - Arabian Horse Organization (AHO) created by several Middle Eastern partners to support the breeding programs of both big and small breeders in Europe. Although helpful, the idea started many rumours and controversions across Europe, beeing seen by some as serious competitor against ECAHO and its

long term worked rules, or against attractivity and objectivity, as the prize money for each of top five class places as well as for Best Handler have been donated in the number of 150 000 Euro, where 35 000 Euro went to support just Warsaw show. But I think no one can anyway deny that Middle East is still the biggest and most attractive partner in financial support of world's and European breeding so organizing the events that promote breeders work (the horses entered must have been both bred and owned by the same person in the moment of show) may seem to be a very clever idea working well for both parties. And the variety and quality of entries and visitors at the previous competitions in St. Tropez and Berlin just could confirm the rightness of this activity. At Polish field the conditions seemed to be not

so easy from the beginning. As past show organizing committee member I may confirm that bringing international horses to compete at Polish ground is as hard as entering the sheep to the lion's cave. However this time the strongest Polish competitors — Michalow and Janow Podlaski studs didn't bring their horses, but the third big state stud of Bialka and several leading private breeders of Poland made this show really interesting preview of what Poland has the best. Its just a pity that due to short and late entry time not as many horses as could, had a time to plan Warsaw in their show schedule.

Anyway the biggest congratulations to Essam Abdullah and his team should be passed for great care for the quality details and nice atmosphere they managed to create in such a short time! The show was personally attended by important persons as Ambassadors of Egypt, Morocco and Pakistan who enjoyed a lot watching and presenting the trophies.

The nice organization with free entries for spectators to the perfectly set up and prepared showground, with fantastic catering staff, these were all details that made the good appearance and positive emotions from the beginning. The show was judged by the various team of: Władysław Guziuk (PL), William Richardot de Choicy (FRA), Marianne Tengstedt (DK) and Mohamed Zaghloul (EGY). The scoring system excluding the highest and lowest scores as well as

separating the score for head, neck, front legs and hind legs was making the final placement more accurate.

The quality of show was high from the very beginning with yearling fillies class winner — lovely Noumea by Ekstern bred by Marek Kondrasiuk being not only class winner but also the Junior Champion Filly at the end of the show. The evidence for quality of that filly may be the fact that she was sold to new owner almost straight after the show!

Class winner of another section – 2 years old fillies was an opening of big triumphant march for Chrcynno-Palace stud. Their homebred Gaja Hera by Psytadel was the first horse winning the class and bred by this close Warsaw located

farm. At the end of the event the filly went back home with Bronze medal and her breeders brought almost 1/3 of all prize money of the show home, thanks to its horses high places! Another section of fillies 3 years old was a break through the 90 points level score. It was given to fabulous Ekstern daughter, known already from Polish and international rings Paema (out Pasyma) bred by Lech Blaszczyk. Her over 19 average score for type and movements gave her 91,75 of total and Silver Champion title, 0,75 points more then second placed in this amazing quality class – Fortycja from Belżyce Arabians. We could have seen her several days before winning the trophy for Best Mover of Prague Intercup Show in Czech Republic. High level of scoring continued in the next section for

yearling colts where both top two winners also got over 90 points. It were Gajman PS, chestnut Ajman Moniscione colt out of Gracja-Bis by Monogramm, the mare who produced World Reserve Champion colt Girlan-Bey in the past. The colt bred by PS Arabians was soon after the show sold to Gerald Kurtz who was showing him to the class winning and Junior Champion and Best Male of Show title later. Second horse in his class was also scored over 90 points, it was Espekt by Ekstern bred by Lech Blaszczyk. This colt finally placed Top Five in championships soon after the show also changed the ownership to Norway! It seems like the Warsaw event was very successful in the matter of horse promotion... Silver Junior Champion colt became another horse brought by Chrcynno-Palac — Echo Mars by Ajman Moniscione, the

winner of 2-3 years old section. The Bronze went to Primanus Qatar by Abha Qatar bred by Zalia Arabians. He was placed as third in the strong class won by the Bronze Champion, Although here the judges votes were not very lucky for him as he could easily get silver medal if not the vote of just one judge that, unlike the rest, placed him as far as on 10th place in championships! Anyway it is surely one of the most interesting sons of his father across Europe now. First class of older mares 4-6 years old was a show debut of its winner Europesa, lovely and rare grey Psytadel daughter. Is was her second appearance just after Prague Intercup 2 weeks before. She finally won the class and the Silver medal for her breeder, Nazareth Arabians. The eldest class of mares 7 years and older was a real parade of classic Polish

beautiful mares. The winner of the class, Gold Champion, Best Female and Best in Show as well as highest scored horse was lovely Gazal Al Shaqab daughter — Perfirka from Bialka Stud who got 92,88. All this class top four horses got over 90 points and the Bronze Champion from Chrcynno-Palac, Pallas Atena also came from this class while the silver went to Europesa mentioned above. The group of senior stallions contained just one class — 4 years and over so the winners became automatically awarded champions. It was won by another Chrcynno-Palac horse, correct and great mover Echo Adonis by Al Maraam, scored the same total aas second horse — Montello by Derby winner and handsome Tulip Cup past contender Gafal. Montello bred by Jan Głowacki is a horse famous for his moving abilities

while he once got the highsst marks for that feature at Białka Junior Spring Show as yearling. Now he repeated the success getting the average of 19,75 for movements. The third this time was lovely show veteran and promissing beginner as sire – Elmaran by Al Maraam this time placed as third. Although Michalow and Janow Podlaski State Stud unfortunately decided not to take part in this cometition, its directors appeared at the event to...get the trophies as well. Nice accent from the organizers was to honor Michalow with the trophy of Best Sire that went for Ekstern, to Janów Podlaski Stud as well as to Mrs Izabella Pawelec-Zawadzka, former ECAHO Vice President and Polish Arabian Horse Society long time President – for overall impact in Arabian horse promotion to the world. Probably the most happy

triumphant of that day was the breeder from Chrcynno-Palace, Alicja Poszepczynska who got not only the most prize money for horses but also the famous 5000 Euro cheque for the Best Handler this time! But important fact that need to be a conclusion of that event report was the fantastic atmosphere during this intersting event. Many private breeders, so happy with sometimes first wins and also some prize money covering the cost of entry and travel underlined that for the first time they experienced so familiar and fair play aura of the competition in Poland, where breeders were not against each other but they were all supporting each other and each others good horses. I think this was exactly the idea of organizers, as Essam Abdullah, the Director of show commented after the event: "We wanted

to make the show for individual breeders to honor them and support as they often need it. We wanted to organize it in best way and best place possible and hopefully we succeeded however it was sometimes not easy". So in last words we just owe congratulations and hopes that the show organizers will repeat their activity next year. For all those who qualified their horses this year during St. Tropez. Berlin and Warsaw shows at the places from 1 to 5 we wish good luck for the 2012 Breeders Championships Europe finals at Deauville!
