Santiago, the Chilean capital, shines in springtime. The dramatic colors of the sundown delineate the highest skyscrapers of South America. The top of the snowed Andes Mountains breaks the monotony of the urban terrain. The warm weather seems to stimulate people. At night the restaurants and bars at the elegant streets and avenues are crowded. The long, sunny days during the weekend bring parents and children to meet nature at parks around the city. It was in this vibrant and, at the same time, serene atmosphere that, during two afternoons in December (15 and 16), the Exposición Primavera Caballos Árabes, promoted by ANCA Chile (Associacion Nacional de Caballos Arabes), took place.

The stage of the Exposición de Primavera was the pleasant and beautiful garden of the Military Academy and the judge was the Argentine Jorge Cóncaro. He analyzed 39 horses and elected LL Ali Bey the Champion Stallion and Shamis El Madan his Reserve, both originated in Brazil. LL Ali Bey is the son of Bey Shahdow TGS by Shahllenger of the stables of Georginho Naoum of Haras TGS-Brazil. Bey Shahdow was Brazilian National Champion Jr Colt and after being imported by the Chilean Alfredo Hasbun, owner of Haras La Laguna, became Chile and Argentina National Champion, and today he is one of the most important sires in South America. At this show he won the Best Get of Sire. The mother of the champion Ali Bey is LL Alia, daughter of the American Esfahan by Echo Magnifficoo, imported by the Hasbuns. Ali Bey, bred at La Laguna, already shows his abilities as a sire. His daughter Hippie Bey was Champion Potranca Maior, the equivalent of our Jr Filly. Hippie Bey was bred at Haras Altovalsol of Ricardo Walsen who is also the owner of Ali Bey.

The Reserve Stallion Shamis El Madan is the son of the Italian Shael Dream Desert, imported to Brazil and re-exported to the USA. His mother is the winner Endyara HRO, daughter of the Brazilian National Champion Lumiar Amadeus, today in England. Shamis was imported by Sergio Vergara of Haras Montegrande and other than Reserve Champion he achieved the title of the "Most Classic Male", the male with the most Arabian characteristic in the show.

The title of Most Classic Female went to the Champion Mare LL Honey Dream. She is one of the daughters of the winning couple Bey Shahdow TGS and Touch a Dream that produced the stunning LL Beauty Dream, National Chilean Champion, Brazilian National Champion and World Champion in Las Vegas-USA. Bey Shahdow is famous in Brazil. Recently he stayed for a breeding season there and left his trademark in several Brazilian haras. Touch a Dream is American, daughter of Negatraz and carries three bloodlines of Bask's blood. She came to Brazil briefly, without leaving any

progeny, before being exported to Chile. Alfredo Hasbun of Haras La Laguna, responsible for the acquisition of Bey Shahdow and Touch a Dream, is the breeder and exhibitor of LL Honey Dream and five other Champions at this show. They were: the filly LL Shaella that became the Champion Jr Hembra, the title is the equivalent to Champion Filly. Shaella is the daughter of Shael Dream Desert the father of the Reserve Champion Stallion. Her mother is LL Beauty Dream, this breed took place when Beauty Dream was temporarily in Brazil to compete at the National and had already won Vegas. LL Shaella was also chosen as the Most Classical Head at the show. The champion Potrillo Maior, equivalent to Jr. Colt, was LL Alamein, full brother of the Champion Horse LL Ali Bey. Alfredo Hasbun also had the Reserve Champion Potrillo Menor (Yearling Colt) with LL Kurdo, son of LL Khartoum the new sire at La Laguna. Son of Esfahan by Echo Magnifficoo in LL Sweet Dream by Bey Shahdow. LL Khartoun is also the father of the Reserve Champion Potranca Menor (Yearling Filly) LL Lady K. And closing the winning cycle of Alfedo Hasbun the Reserve Champion Colt LL Maglud, who comes from a pedigree completely different from the ones La Laguna is famous for. Maglud is the son of ZT Magnanimus by AB Magnum in ZT Ludjteyna daughter

of the Brazilian Ludjin El Jamaal in the National North American Champion Shahteyna by Bey Shah. ZT is the prefix of the Argentine breeding program of Frederico Zichy-Thyssen.

The Champion Jr Colt was the American Abrakadabra RH bred by Robin Hood Farm belonging to the Kassis Sabag family of Haras Santa Ana. The Kassis family, started their program three years ago. Eli Kassis did come to Brazil occasionaly but invested mainly in the USA to form their breeding program. With the help of the traditional breeder Jaime Valdés, Eli bought several broodmares and at her father's request took the Champion Abrakadabra to Chile, a black son of the Canadian National Champion ROL Intencyty by Cytosk, grandson of Bask. Abrakadabra's mother, Miss Starbuxx has Ali Jamaal and Padrons Psyche in her bloodline. The Kassis also had the Reserve Champion Mare the American Ppoetry, bred by Will-O-Mar Arabians and daughter of the Reserve American and Canadian Champion, Pprovidence by Echo Magnifficoo. Ppoetry's mother is the daughter of Padron named Rosebud SS. To close their winnings, the Kassis family also won Champion Potranca Menor (Yearling Filly) with HSA Marian by Da Vinci FM, Reserve Champion in Scottsdale and twice Reserve National Champion in the USA.

The breeder Jorge Selume of Haras Santa Marta came out with four champions. All from his own breeding program, sons of the Brazilian Dayran HCF and Ryad El Jamaal. Dayran HCF, a son of Legacy of Fame in NV Impresshahn by Bey Shah is from Haras Capim Fino. He also won the Champion Potrillo Menor (Yearling Colt) with HSM Hachim son of Trisha Van Ryad by Ryad El Jamaal and his full brother HSM Atharid, Reserve Champion Jr Colt. With the Brazilian Yllana UB by Yllan El Jamaal, Dyran HCF produced the Reserve Champion Jr Filly, HSM La Javi and with the breed produced by an embryo Santa Marta had the Reserve Champion Filly HSM Daniella, daughter of Ryad El Jamaal in LL Sweet Dream by Bey Shahdow, one of the fundamental mares of Alfredo Hasbun.
