

### 25th International Arabian horse B-show

# Ströhen Germany

s always, the second weekend of July is reserved for the always entertaining International Arabian Horse show, hosted at the Ströhen zoo of show organizer Dr. Nils Ismer. Judges for this event were Dr. Aragno from Italy, Mrs. Garde-Ehlert from Germany, Mrs. Schibler from Switzerland and mr. Tarczinski from Poland.

The show started with the yearling filly class. The weather was lovely and the showring being in the middle of the Elephants and Camels, made this show extra special. The quality was high and the classes well filled. The point system was changed to separate points for head and neck. Also the movement points were separated in walk en trot. The average of these points were then enlisted in the total score. Winner of the yearling filly class with 40.92 points and later bronze medal winner in the junior filly championships was Al Justyra (Al Justice x Amyra bint Khidar) — bred and owned by Sax Arabians from Germany. 2nd in this class with 40.58

points was Ghala al Shaqab (Farhoud al Shaqab x Ghalla al Shaqab) – bred and owned by Al Shaqab from Qatar.

Next to go was another big class of beautiful fillies, aged two years old. Clear winner of this class with 42.17 points and later unanimous Gold medal winner in the final championships was Mississippi J (QR Marc x Magnifficent Lady J) - bred and owned by Jadem Arabians from Belgium. 2nd in this class with 41 points was Al Loubna (Ajman Moniscione x Al Aliha) - bred and owned by Al Hambra Arabians from Austria.

The show continued with a large class of yearling colts. Also here all of good quality. Winner of the class with 41.08 points and later gold medal winner with the junior colts was Galahad Juliver (WH Justice x Baswani) - bred by Galahad Arabians and owned by Al Baydaa Stud from Egypt. 2nd in this class with 40.58 points was MS Alis Pasha (Ali



Moniscione x HS Klowa) - bred and owned by the Malorny/Scherle partnership from Germany.

Next up were the two years old colts. Winner of this class with 40.75 points was Gzavi (Aja Justified x Gwandolyn) - bred by Suweco Stud and owned by DB Arabians from Belgium. At the second place with 40.42 points was the typy ZT Farid (Anaza el Farid x ZT Fardiyyah) - bred by Count Zichy Thijssen and owned by Hanaya Stud from Switzerland.

The Silver and the bronze medal in the junior colt championship came from the next class – the three years old colts. Class winner with 41.50 point and silver medal winner was the big moving Al Marid (Al Milan x Bata B) – bred by Thomas Holubec and owned by Sax Arabians from Germany. At the second place with 41.25 points and bronze medal winner was WW Stivallea (Stival x Arwen WW) – bred by Wildwood Arabians and owned by Jalal Marei from Israel.

After the young boys it was time for the battle of the ladies! Gorgeous three years old fillies were presented. Most of them scoring above the 40 points. However it was the very beautiful and typy Alfabia Akiabara (ZT Marwteyn x ZT Ludbecka) — who got the lead in this class with a total of 41.58 points. Later in the championships, she was awarded with the silver medal. A great success for her breeder Count Zichy Thijssen and her owners of Halsdon Arabians from the UK. Second in this tough class with 41.25 points was Desha Bahreyn (Laheeb al Nasser x Bint Kalyah) — bred by De Shazer and owned by Hanaya Stud from Switzerland.

After the juniors it was time for the seniors! Starting with the mares aged four to six years old. Beautiful mares who most of them just started their legacy in the breedingbarn. Winner of this class with 41.83 points was Donya Tamal (Nader al Jamal x Aroussa) - bred by Yusef Asali and owned by Dorno Balolo from Israel. Second with 41 points was Ajmana (Ajman Moniscione x Yazmin) — bred and owned by Voran

Arabians from Norway. Later this mare gave a great show in the championships, making the judges crown her the bronze medal winner of the senior mares!

The mares aged seven to nine years old were again a treat for the eye. Winner with 42.17 points was the beautiful and big moving Biruta (Ekstern x Bajada) - bred by Janow Podlaski and owned by Halsdon Arabians from the UK. This stunning mare continued her success by being named silver medal winner as well! Second in this class with 42 points was Bint Tahanie (Suhal al Nasser x Tahanie) - bred by Linda Lashley and owned by Hanaya Stud from Switzerland.

Just when you thought you have seen the best, the last class of mares, aged ten years and older, make their appearance. Only two participants but both gorgeous mares. Winner with 42.67 points and later gold medal winner in the final senior mares championships was Jamilla al Zobair (Ahhal al Rayyan x My Silk Stolking) – bred by Al Zobair Stud and owned by Al Khalediah Stables from Saudi Arabia. Second with 40.25 points was MA El Ehlaa (El Yashmir x Ewelina) – bred by the Miedl-Ohlsson family and owned by MT Training center and Al Fares Arabians from Sweden.

Then it was up to the senior males to impress! And what a

show they gave! Catching the eye of many with his proud movement and beautiful type was Espressivo (QR Marc x Emocja) - bred and owned by Knocke Arabians from Belgium, scoring a total of 42.25 points and claiming the silver medal in the final championships. Second in this class with 42.08 points and later bronze medal winner was Al Aneed LDA (Alixir x La Magidaa LDA) - bred by LD Arabians and owned by Hanaya Stud from Switzerland.

The gold medal winner of the senior stallions came from the next class: seven to nine years old stallions. With a total of 42.50 points, El Palacio vo (Al Lahab x El Dorada) scored

full 10's on type. El Palacio was bred by Valley Oak Arabians and is owned by al Khalediah stables from Saudi Arabia. Second in this class with 41.50 points was Zigi Zan (Padrons Psyche x Zagrobla) – bred by Michalow Stud and owned by Sinus Arab Stud from Sweden.

With this last class another great edition of the Ströhen show came to an end. Always entertaining and being able to visit the zoo and the baby tigers makes this show a real treat for the whole family!
