

# Haras Vale Formoso win the Brazilian Breeders' Cup and Premium Cup

**T**he combined points of the judges Jay Constanti and Terry Holmes from the USA, Jerzy Zbyszewski from Poland, Jorge Concaro from Argentina and Luis Eduardo Moreira Caio from Brazil, gave Haras Vale Formoso, of the Sorvilo family, the Breeders' Cup 2013. Other than this award the breeding program of João Roberto, Elisa, Raquel, Roberto and Renato also won the Premium Cup with Querydda Sams, the animal with the highest total points - 331.5 out of possible 360 (see box).







***Haras Vale Formoso of the Sorvilo family wins the Breeders' Cup and the Premium Cup with Querydda Sams***

Querydda is a beautiful daughter of the young sire HK Keav Power by Power World JQ. In only three generations, since 2009, the sons and daughters of HK Keav Power won 5 National titles and Reserve, without a doubt very few sires obtained the same level of results, like his father Power World JQ. Querydda Sams is part of this group of National Champions from HK Keav Power, she was Reserve National Jr Filly last year. The other Sams that gave Haras Vale Formoso a total of 983.5 points out of 1,080 and the Breeders'

Cup this year was: Spartaccus Sams with 326.5 points, a son of Psyche HBV by Padrons Psyche out of Glaucy Sams by TS Don Brave. The other two horses competing by Vale Formoso had the same points 325.5, Scarlatt Sams daughter of Form Carillon by \*Laddin BA out of Tifanny EB by El Nabila B and Sharllote Sams daughter of El Shakhry by \*FA El Shawan out of Hasmyne Sams by Borsalino K. The total points of the winner at the Breeders Cup is the points sum of the best three horses out of four. (See box).

The filly Alma HVP of Haras Vila dos Pinheiros tied with Querydda Sams, the two had the same combined points 331.5. In case of a tie there are twenty-one alternatives to break it. The first one is to compare the total points without discarding any. In this case Alma HVP and Querydda Sams decision happened at the first alternative, Querydda had 551.5 points and Alma 551, Alma came in second place giving the HVP of Jaime Pinheiro also a second place at the Breeders' Cup. Alma is the daughter of Marwan Al Shaqab out of Foxbriar Shakita by ZT Shakfantasy. This is the same cross that gave us \*FA El Shawan Brazilian National Champion five times. Champion of the Arabian Breeder's Cup in Las Vegas and father of Champions that are well known in Europe as the Yearling Female Gold Esperanza Al Ventur and the Junior Colt Silver FA El Rasheem at the Nations Cup this year. Haras Vila dos Pinheiros also took the sixth place with Tawany HVP daughter of \*FA El Shawan in Tasmin HVP by JJ Senor Magnum.

The third place at the Top Ten at the Breeders' Cup went to RFI Fantina Al Maktub with 329 points. She is the daughter of RFI Maktub in RFI Fayara El Shiraz by Shiraz El Jamaal, paternal sister of RFI Farid. The prefix RFI belong to Haras Santo Antonio da Bela Vista of the Foz Forte family that took fourth place at the Breeders' Cup and had other filly at the Top Ten, RFI Sophie Al Maktub also daughter of RFI Matbuk in Sophia Al Nechi that came in ninth place.

Haras El Madan of the Amaral family, had total points that gave them third place at the Breeders' Cup with the fourth place given to Tina El Madan, daughter of \*El Tino by DA Valentino in Grace LM by Mirage LM and the tenth place went to Zadar El Madan son of \*DA Lirium BMW by DA Vinci FM in Lietra FHP by Don El Chall.

The fifth place at the Breeders' Cup went to the new breeder Rodrigo Faias of Haras das Faias that show the seventh place at the Premium Cup, HDF Milano, son of WH Justice in Premia Al Tahl by Tahl De Wic. Flávia Torres of Haras Quatro Estações took sixth place at the Breeders' Cup and Haras Paiquere of Lucio and his son Tersio Miranda took seventh place showing a Top Ten (fifth place) Attalea LM daughter of Enzo in Tarsila LM by Yllan El Jamaal. The eighth place at the Premium Cup was the filly Fillity Johnny a daughter of Karim El Power by Power World JQ in Princesa D'Oro by Gris El Jamaal. She comes from the breeding program of Haras Johnny of Joao Henrique Neto that took ninth place at the Breeders' Cup.

## Brazilian Breeders' Cup: How and Why

Breeders' Cup in Brazil have very specific characteristic, different from other Brazilian shows. The rules were introduced in 1996 by the journalist and judge Luiz Rocco and by the engineer Rubens Jordão, members of the board of directors of the Association. One to four horses no more than 36 months older from both sexes. Using the point system they are judged by five judges only on its classes by age and sex. There is no Championship. There are five items to be judged: type, head, neck, "body and legs", and "movement and presence". The higher and lower points are discarded and the three that remained are added. The horses with the highest total points enter the competition to win the Premium Cup, parallel to the Top Ten. Breeders' Cup title will go to the breeder with the highest points, excluding the horse with less points, if the breeder has four animals at the competition. Owning the Cup permanently only happens if the breeder wins three times in a row or five times alternatively, then the Cup is permanently his and a new Cup is made. Only Haras Vanguarda of Fabio Diniz achieved this after winning in 1999, 2000, 2003, 2004 and 2006.

Four breeders have won the Cup twice, winning the crystal trophy that represents an opening palm, Seven breeders up to now had the privilege to show it among their trophies.
