GERMAN NATIONS CUP 27th of September 2013

As every year, on the Friday prior to the All Nations Cup, the German Nationals are held at the Albert Valhe Halle in Aachen, Germany. Since many many years, the German Arabian horses are well known for their outstanding quality. The show started with some gorgeous foal classes. The hope for the future and what a quality they were! Gold medal foal champion was the very typy AJ Sayeda (Vervaldee x Sweet Caroline LL) – bred and owned by Ajman Stud. Silver champion foal was chosen Expiria OS (El Sid x Amory OS) – bred and owned by Gestut Osterhof. The bronze medal was given to Inspired Asim (Ajman Moniscione x Natalia) – bred and owned by the Schick family from Germany!

The junior filly championship was won by the beautiful Al Justyra (Al Justice x Amyra bint Khidar) – bred and owned by Sax Arabians. The silver medal went to Angel Afrikhan Queen (TF Afrikhan Shah x Angel Aziza) – bred by Jeanine van Oosterwijk and owned by the Zimmermann family! The bronze medal was given to the typy MS Mary Lou (WH Justice x Bajah Badiya) – bred and owned by the Malorny/Scherle partnership.

The junior colt championships were showing some future stallions for the breed. All very consistent in type and a promiss for the future. Gold medal winner was the Straight Egyptian BK Latif (Nader al Jamal x Latifa AA) – bred and owner by the Becker family. The silver medal went to

RP Burj el Arab (WH Justice x Pamira bint Psytadel) – bred by Agmal arabians and owned by Di Grazia Arabians. The bronze medal was given to Mouammar (Gazwan al Nasser x Amurath Mofeedah) – bred and owned by Gerd Meixner.

The senior mare championships was filled with beautiful mares in their prime breedingage. Some already showing off their beautiful baby bellies. Gold medal winner was Naha (WH Justice x Nahbayka) – bred and owned by Sax Arabians. The silver medal was given to Bellanna Estopa SLM (Al Lahab x Om el Bediya Dream) – bred and owned by Sandra Menzal. The bronze medal was for MF Helona (JD Chalice x Heloisa) – bred by Dr. Kirschner and owned by Bourhani arabians.

The stallion championships was a pleasure to watch with all the big moving stallions parading in the arena. Difficult to pick your favorite. The gold medal winner was Altis (WH Justice x Albia) – bred by Falborek Arabians and owned by Gestut Ismer. The silver medal was given to the ultra typy Muranas Jassehr (Major x Jana el Bri) – bred and owned by Gestut Murana. The final bronze medal was awarded to the big moving bay Kalif OS (Marajj x Khaleifa) – bred and owned by Gestut Osterhof.

The Nationals were again of great quality and a good warm up for the All Nations Cup!

ALL NATIONS CUP 28th of September 2013

The last weekend of September is the date were all breeders and lovers of Arabian horses are anxiously looking forward to all the year long as this is the weekend of the All Nations Cup in Aachen, Germany. Arabian horse lovers from all over the world gathered at the Albert Vahle Halle to see the crème de la crème of Arabian horse breeding. Participating and being placed in Aachen is to many breeders a dream come true. This year, twenty more horses were entered compared to last year. Ten judges were asked to judge this year's All Nations Cup. Mrs. Cecilia Bourghardt from Sweden, Mrs. Annette Dixon from Great Britain, Mrs. Deidre Hyde from United Arab Emirates, Mrs. Marianne Tengstedt from Denmark, Dr. Gianmarco Aragno from Italy, Mr. Cedes Bakker from The Netherlands, Mr. Scott Benjamin from Canada, Mr. Holger Ismer from Germany, Mr. Allan Preston from Australia and Mr. Luiz Rocco from Brasil. Prior to every class, a computer would randomly pick five judges to judge that particular class. For the championships, nine judges would take their vote. (Scott Benjamin did not judge the championships)

The show started with the junior classes. Many high class yearling fillies were entered so the class was divided in class A and class B. Nine beautiful fillies made their entrance. With the first four scoring above the 90 points! Winner of the class with 92.10 points was the typy Brazilian bred Delights Divah RB (Ajman Moniscione x Honeys Delight RB) – bred by Adriana Esprindola De Moura and owned by Al Sayed Stud from Saudi Arabia. Second in this class with 92 points was the beautiful MM Esplendida (RFI Farid x MM Eluise) – bred and owned by Mario Matt from Austria. Later in the championships, MM Esplendida convinced the judges to be the better one of both, claiming the Bronze medal in the final yearling championships!

The victory of the B section yearling fillies was won by the sister of Delight Diva RB. Also bred in Brazil by Adriana Esprindola De Moura, the brilliant Esperanzza al Ventur (FA El Shawan x Honeys Delight RB) took the lead with a total of 92.50 points! This filly was the Brazilian National champion in 2012 and continued her success by being named Gold Medal winner with the yearling fillies in Aachen for her current owner Athbah Stud from Saudi Arabia! This beautiful and flashy filly really took the lead by ease and I am sure we will hear much more about her in the future! Two beautiful fillies were competing for the second place. Both scoring 91 points, it was Najdiya al Zobair (Eden C x Najdah

al Zobair) who won the preference of the judges, leaving the striking D Shahla (Marajj x FT Shaella) at the third place. Najdiya al Zobair continued her success for her breeder Al Zobair stud and owner Al Zobara stud from Qatar, by also claiming the silver medal in the final yearling fillies championships.

An interesting collection of yearling colts were up next. Again divided in section A and B. Winner of the A-section with 91 points was the gorgeous big moving Antaris OS (RFI Farid x Justina) – bred and owned by Gestut Osterhof from Germany. Later in the championships, Antaris OS claimed the gold medal! Second in this class with 90.80 points was the Knocke Arabians Belgium bred and owned Equiborn KA (QR Marc x Espadrilla).

The B-section of the yearling colts counted seven participants with the beautiful and typey Prussia MI (Abha Qatar x Parada) claiming the class win with a total of 91.20 points. Bred by Ambition Investments and owned by HRH Prince Abdullah Bin Fahad Al Saud from Saudi Arabia this colt claimed the silver medal in the final championships, were he was tie with Kanz al Nasser, who got the same number of votes. In the end, Kanz al Nasser (WH Justice x Ftoon al Shaqab) of Al Nasser stud, Qatar received the bronze medal and the third place in the class with a total of 90.70 points. Second in the class with 90.90 points was the big moving Nashmi al Hawajer (Marajj x Maniba bint ibn Narav) – bred and owned by Al Hawajer stud from the UAE.

The show continued with the fillies aged two years old. In total 19 entries, divided in a section A and B. The A section was won with a total of 92.63 points by Valentino's Angel MI (DA Valentino x Always an Angel) – bred by Mulawa Arabians and owned by Al Mohamadia Stud from Saudi Arabia. Later in the championships, this filly claimed the bronze medal. Second in the class with a total of 91.25 points was El Siena (Hdb Sihr ibn Massai x El Aria) – bred and owned by ZPH Strusinianka from Poland. Scoring the same total of points but losing on movement was the third placed Nesj el Jude (Shanghai x Nesj el Shayna) – bred by Nesj Arabians and owned by NK Arabians from Jordan.

The section B of the two years old fillies was won with a massive 92.70 points by Perfinka (Esparto x Perfirka) – bred by Stado Ogierow Bialka and owned by Al Muawd Stud from Saudi Arabia. Later in the championships, she scored the same number of votes as the winner of the three years old

















fillies, Alfabia Akiabara (ZT Marwteyn x ZT Ludbectra). In the end it was Perfinka who got the gold medal, leaving the silver medal for Alfabia Akiabara! Second placed in the two years old fillies class with a total of 91.70 points was the typy AJ Asyad (Marwan al Shaqab x Aja Angelica) – bred and owned by Ajman Stud from the UAE.

As mentioned before, Alfabia Akiabara, bred by Alfabia Stud and owned by Halsdon Arabians from the UK, won the class of the three years old fillies with a total score of 91.70 points. Second in this class with a total of 91.50 points was Orfa d'Arab KA (QR Marc x Oso Axotica) – bred and owned by Knocke Arabians from Belgium.

Next to go was the class of two years old colts. A class were many were waiting for as some gorgeous future sires were presented. Clear winner of the class with a total of 92.50 points was the beautiful FA El Rasheem (FA el Shawan x Virtuosa MLR) – bred by Marlene Ann Rieder and owned

by the El Raheem Group and Dubai Arabian Horse stud from the UAE. Later in the final junior colt championships, El Rasheem claimed the silver medal. Second in this class with a total of 91.90 points was the huge chestnut colt AJ Mardan (Vervaldee x Felicia) – bred and owned by Ajman Stud from the UAE. Later in the championships, AJ Mardan claimed the bronze medal.

The class of the three years old colts was won with a massive score of 93.70 points by the popular and stunning EKS Alihandro (Marwan al Shaqab x OFW Psylhouette) – bred by Elkasum Arabians and owned by Athbah stud of Saudi Arabia. Scoring 20's in type, head and neck and movement, this stallion captivated judges and crowd and was named Gold medal junior stallion unanimoulsy! Second in the class with a total of 90.90 points was the big moving showstopper Profender KA (QR Marc x Palanga) – bred by Knocke Arabians and owned by Florentina Arabians from Belgium.







After the junior classes it was time for the seniors! No less than eleven Arabian mares aged four to six years old were entered. Ten of them scoring above the 90 points! Winner of the class was the gorgeous and charismatic Abilene PCF (Legacy of Fame x Breath of Spring PCF) – bred by PCF Arabians and owned by Azienda Agragia from Italy. This lady enjoyed showing herself to the public, scoring a total of 92.70 points! A same total as the second placed Zigi Zana (QR Marc x Zagrobla) –bred and owned by Janow Podlaski from Poland, who lost the class win on type.

Another huge class of twelve mares aged seven to ten years old was up next. The crème de la crème of Arabian breeding with almost all scoring above the 90 points with the Top five of this class all sired by Gazal al Shaqab! Winner of the class with a total of 93.90 points and later the Unanimous gold medal winner in the final senior mare championships was Emandoria (Gazal al Shaqab x Emanda) – bred by Michalow Stud and owned by Ajman Stud from the UAE, scoring full twenties for head and neck! Second in this spectacular class with 93.40 points was Pistoria (Gazal al Shaqab x Palmira) - bred and owned by Michalow Stud from Poland, scoring almost full twenties on movement! Later in the championship, Pistoria received the bronze medal with the senior mares! Third in this spectacular class with 92.90 points was Etnologia (Gazal al Shaqab x Etalanta) – bred by Janow Podlaski and owned by Halsdon Arabians from the UK. Later in the championships, Etnologia received the silver medal with the senior mares!

Last but not least were the senior mares aged eleven years and older. Only four participants but again of good quality. Winner of the class with 92.40 points was Emira (Laheeb x Embra) – bred by Michalow Stud and owned by Ajman Stud from the UAE. At the second place with 91.90 points was SF Shaklina (Sanadik el Shaklan x ZT Sharuby) – bred by Natalia Kuphal de Mato and co-owned by Johanna Ullstrom from Belgium.

After the exciting mare classes it was time for the spectacular young stallions in the age of four to six years old! Snoring stallions showing off their bold movement and incredible type entered the arena. Winner of the class with 93.40 points and later the gold medal winner was Abha Qatar (Marwan al Shaqab x ZT Ludjkalba) – bred by Ses

Planes and owned by Al Mohamadia Stud from Saudi Arabia. Second in this class with 92.80 points and later silver medal winner with the senior stallions was the typy Shanghai EA (WH Justice x Salymah) – bred by Equus Arabians and owned by Asayel Stud from Kuwait.

Next to go were the stallions aged seven to ten years old. Big moving stallions entered the arena. Full of power and charisma. With a total of 92.80 points, the snow white stallion Palentino (Pesal x Palmeta) took a clear lead in the class, scoring 20's on both type and movement. Palentino is bred and owned by Janow Podlaski from Poland. Later in the championships, Palentino was awarded with the bronze medal! Second in the class with 92.10 points was Kabzstad (Poganin x Kwestura) – bred and owned by Michalow Stud from Poland.

Last but not least was the class of the senior stallions, aged eleven years and older. Five participants, with the first three scoring very close in points. Winner of the class with 92 points was Esparto (Ekstern x Ekspozycja) – bred and owned by Michalow Stud from Poland. Second in this class was Poganin (Laheeb x Pohulanka) – the sire of Kabzstad, who was placed second in the previous class. Poganin is bred and owned by Janow Podlaski Stud in Poland.

During the All nations cup, the devastating news of the passing of Sven Lanslots was announced to the public. A sad tragedy and we wish his wife Sofie Verhaegen and their children a lot of strength during this difficult period! The Arabian horse world lost a great horse man!

As every year, the All Nations Cup Aachen has been a meeting point for Arabian horse lovers, the ideal opportunity to choose your breeding stallion for the next breeding season and of course to enjoy the great atmosphere and high quality horses that this show always provides. The highlight of the season and the ultimate try-out before the World championships in Paris.

This year, the All Nations Cup in Aachen was again the host for the Arabian Futurity Europe, held on Saturday after the normal classes. The Arabian Futurity Europe is an initiative for breeders of Arabian Horses in Europe. Founders and members of the Arabian Futurity Europe Group are James Swaenepoel (Belgium) and Karl-Heinz Stöckle (Germany) in cooperation with Gregor Aymar (Germany) and Ward Bemong (Belgium).

Goal of the concept is to give a new impulse to Arabian Horse Breeding and Arabian Horse Events in Europe. With an excellent selection of Europe's highest quality Breeding Stallions, they created the opportunity to buy one of these breedings in an open Auction and automatically enlist to compete with the horse, born out of this breeding, in a foal and yearling Futurity competition. A Futurity competition with an interesting amount of prize money for both the breeder of the foal as also for the stallion owner. It is also possible to participate with a foal which breeding has not been bought in the auction but nominated before birth and with a foal nominated after birth. In all cases, the sires of the foals need to be listed within the Arabian Futurity. A different amount of price money is given to each category.

In the foal futurity, ten filly foals were entered. Winner of the class was Wantasia (Juwel OS x Wanila) - bred and owned by Husted Arabians from Denmark. Completing the elite top five were Maryse OS (Marajj x Shak Shakira) - bred and owned by Gestut Osterhof from Germany, Forelocks Veronique (Psytadel x Vekaisa F) – bred and owned by Forelocks Arabians from The Netherlands, Katelyn Joy (Psytadel x Siegerin NY) – bred and owned by Joy Horses from Belgium and WA Venuz Apal (Glorius Apal x ZA Zyna) - bred and owned by Caroline Hendryckx from Belgium.

Another ten colts were entered for the foal futurity. Top Five Stud from the UAE, Buio Buio (Kahil al Shaqab x Pustinia el arab) – bred and owned by Elisabetha Calderai from Italy and Azerbeidjan (WH Justice x Euphoria) - bred and owned by the Swaenepoel family from Belgium.

was Shahbander al Muawd (Stival x V Exotic Enchantress) - bred and owned by Al Muawd Stud from Saudi Arabia, Inspired Asim (Ajman Moniscione x Natalia) - bred and owned by the Schick family from Germany, AJ Laft (Ajman Moniscione x Lutfina AA) – bred and owned by Ajman

After the classes, both filly and colt foals competed for the final

Top five and championship ribbons. Unanimous champion foal was Shahbander al Muawd. Reserve Champion was Forelocks Veronique. The Bronze medal was given to Maryse OS, leaving a fourth place to Wantasia and a fifth place for Buio Buio.

The yearlings counted eleven fillies. All of superb quality. Among the top five were Ajmaniah OS (Ajman Moniscione x AB Nastrapsy) – bred by Gestut Osterhof and owned by Ajman Stud from the UAE, Nourah Athbah (Aja Justified x Disputa FA) - bred and owned by Athbah stud from Saudi Arabia, Lady Ajmanya D (Ajman Moniscione x Khabala) - bred by Dion Arabians and owned by Al Baydaa Stud from Egypt, Latifa Athbah (Aja Justified x Ermina) – bred and owned by Athbah Stud from Saudi Arabia and MS Mary Lou (WH Justice x Bajah Badiya) – bred and owned by the Malorny-Scherle family from Germany.

Another big class of yearling colts was up next. Young boys already full of themselves and at the start of their show career. Among the top five were: Primeval Kossack (Stival x Pribaltika) – bred and owned by the Kossack Stud from The Netherlands, Ricardo DD (Psytadel x Monogrammed Lady) - bred and owned by DD Arabians from Belgium, Medor Moniscione (Ajman Moniscione x Medea Moniscione) - bred and owned by Giancarlo Buzzi from Italy, ASE Faraaj (RFI Farid x ASE Bisiriya Hlayyil) - bred and owned by Arabian Stud Europe from The Netherlands and Nesj el Machiatto (Ajman Moniscione x Nesj el Khimala) – bred by Nesj Arabians and owned by Al Mohamadia Stud from Saudi Arabia.

The finale of the futurity yearlings choose Ajmaniah OS as the champion. Reserve Champion was Ricardo DD, leaving the bronze medal for Primeval Kossack. At the fourth position was Latifa Athbah. The fifth position was tie between Lady Ajmanya D and ASE Faraaj. In the end the vote went to Lady Ajmanya.

The Arabian Futurity is a good initiative. For me it would have been more fair to make separate classes for the foals born out of the auction breedings, foals who are nominated before birth and foals nominated after birth. For this, more breeders should participate at the show. The next breeding auction will be in February 2014. Stay tuned, nominate your stallion and unborn foal and participate in next year's Arabian *Futurity Europe!* □
