Ithough 2014 was for the most part a difficult year for Israel and many of her neighbours, this didn't stop the annual case of 'Egyptian fever' that brought over 130 beautiful horses from participating in a wonderful, but rather hastily organized Egyptian Event – Israel. The show was managed brilliantly by the crack show committee of our local Arab Horse Society and scheduled just before – and back to back – to our own annual national show. It was held over two days at the tried and true northern venue of Kibbutz Alonim.

The entrees came from every corner of Israel and the PA and strutted their stuff before three European judges, including Mrs. Ann Norden of Sweden, Mr. Cristian Moschini of Italy, and Mrs. Irina Stigler of Russia. Although the show was held mid-week on what were typically work days for most people, the stands steadily filled as each day progressed.

As usual, we were joined by several visitors from abroad, including one "regular" – veteran Arabian handler and judge Raymond Mazzei of Furioso Farms in California. Over the past decade Mazzei has found himself in Israel just about every year and is very familiar with our horses.

"I am always looking for something different and interesting that can meet the needs of breeders in the States," he explains. "Israel has very good Arabian horses, and especially excellent straight Egyptians. These are often bred just differently enough than the popular lines found today in other parts of the world to make them extremely valuable. In my experience, Israeli horses often have just what American and European breeders need to move their programs forward."

Al Ayal AA (\*Al Ayad x \*The Vision HG) emerged as a major force at this year's Event, by siring the Gold and Silver Medal winners of the Futurity Colts and Fillies sections, as well as the Gold and Silver Medal winners of the Yearling Colts section.

Another six medal winners were sired by the recently deceased \*Nader Al Jamal (Ansata Sinan x Savannah CC) who has left a stellar legacy in Israel.

I would like to note that many of Israel's finest straight Egyptians competed this year at our National Championships, rather than at the Event, and acquitted themselves beautifully by bringing home six championship titles.

As always the show was fun, educational, and rewarding and the high quality of the horses did us proud.  $\Box$

# **ISRAEL** 34<sup>TH</sup> NATIONAL ARABIAN SHOW

early two hundred horses competed at Israel's 34th annual National Championship Show, which spanned over the two and one-half days that bridged the end of October with the start of November 2014.

It was a first for Israel that the judging panel included a total of six guest judges: Mr. Doug Dahmen of the USA, Mr. Ferdinand Huemer of Austria, Mr. Jaroslav Lacina of the Czech Republic, Mrs. Marianne Tengstedt of Denmark, Mrs. Renata Schibler of Switzerland, and Mr. Richard Pihlstrom of France. Willi Luder of Italy was slated to be Ringmaster, but was unexpectedly indisposed, and replaced by the genial Christian Moschini of Italy who was in Israel to judge at our Egyptian Event.

For the first time ever inclement weather became an important component at our show, which had to be temporarily put on hold both on Friday and Saturday as strong rains and gusty winds took control. Luckily for us spectators, the tents and awnings thoughtfully provided by our show committee to protect us against the elements were more than adequate, and all of us

waited patiently and none the worse for wear for the weather to clear enough for the show to carry on. The rains left the arena footing with much to be desired, making it, to say the least, a very novel experience for many of our local horses. The hardworking handlers compensated beautifully and, despite theses challenges, both they and their charges acquitted themselves well.

The stands were mostly packed throughout despite the threatening weather and the audience most enthusiastic, and as always, quite vocal about their opinions. The enthusiasm for certain favorites often reached such a feverish pitch that the noise was absolutely unbearable, making it impossible to follow the loudspeaker announcements. But this is 'par for the course' and simply local color -- part of the price we pay for the extraordinary popularity of Arabian horses with the Israeli public.

The horses were all of exceptionally high quality. The great majority were Israeli-breds, but there were a growing number of imported show horses and a noticeable increase in horses foaled locally but sired by popular international sires from abroad.

One especially welcomed competitor was the unforgettable Belgium-bred and owned world champion, \*Eternity Ibn Navarone, who is currently standing in Israel. It was a rare privilege to watch this 17-year old ethereal beauty captivate both judges and spectators alike and bring home the titles of High Point Horse and the Bronze Medal in the Stallions section.

The Israeli-bred horses shone as well and certainly captured their fair share of medals. One of our many foreign guests, the
