merald Trophy 11 European C show held on the 4 th of july 2015. This show was judged by Mrs Ann Green (UK) Mrs Janice Mc Crea (USA) and Mr Josy Everars (B)

Ridden judged were Mrs.Nadine Koo (NL) and Mr.Gijs Eggink (B). The show was organized by Kay and Helen Hennekens-van Nes with a great team of officials behind them. The European C show allowes European breeders and owners to start their horses without having to compete up against lots of horses from the middle east. The quality of the entries was very high and the number of entries was good.

It was a very hot and sunny day with high temperatures up to 35 gr celcius which made it for some competitors impossible to come and compete. Unfortunatly the British entered horses could not come due to strikes in the ports in Dover and Calais.

For the judges it was a long day because the C show was followed by the International Part bred and Anglo classes and the International Amateur show sponsored by Al Jassimya Farm from Qatar. They gave away 6 tickets for the 6 best Amateur handlers to go to The World Championship show in Paris in November so the number of entries in this show was also very good. Lots of young and promising handlers to start their horses.

The European c show started with the yearling fillies. Winner in this class was Avalon Nehirah with 40,17 pnts by Aria tresor bred by Sandrine Hervieu and owned by he Nehirah Partnership. She was followed by El D'Johara OA by Emerald J with 40 pnts. Bre and owned by Arabian Obsession.

The two yr old filly class was won by Zlota Odessa by Eden c with 40,5 pnts bred and owned by Lutetia Arabians from France. Second was ASE Sayuri by Fadi Al Shaqab with 39,33 pts. Bred by Arabian Stud Europe and owned by Mrs. Paula Bohmer from NL.

The 3 yr old filly class was won by Cap Bianca by Shanghai EA with 42,17 pnts bred in Spain by Ganaderia Pedro Carriedo and owned by Emilio Carriedo Palacia also from Spain. Lovely filly with a very pretty face and good movements. Second in this class with 39,17 pnts the lovely filly Raina Aisha by Abha Peshawar bred and owned by Raina Arabians from Belgium.

The next class was the filly foal class which was won by TZ Joumirah with 40,83 pnts by Kanz Al Nasser bred and owned by Zacarya and Tineke Aznag–Tosseyn from Belgium.

Second in this class was the filly Shangri-La by SL Rio with 40,50 bred and owned by the family Demeulemeester from Belgium. The colt foal class was in next and was won by Mr.Matthiz E with 39,67 pnts by Espressivo bred and owned by family Rudy Galle-Wynant. Followed by CBA Khashmir El Haleem with 38,83 pnts by Haleem al Safi bred and owned by Bouche Arabians from Germany. The foal classes were followed by the foal championships because of the hot weather so the baby's did not have to wait the whole day for their final class. Gold Medal winner was the filly foal TZ Joumirah, Silver Medal Winner was the colt foal CBA Khashmir El Haleem and Bronze medal winner was the filly foal Shangri-La.

The ridden classes took part in a big dressage arena on the other side of the facility.

Mare and Gelding class was won by the bay gelding Menoor by Menes. Bred by Jeroen Vissers and owned by Kim Kramer. The stallion class was won by MM Sergio by WH Justice bred by Mario Matt Arabians from Austria and owned by Flaxman Arabians ridden by Kelsey den Exter.

Yearling colt class was split in two. Class A was won by R'Adjah de Catherey with 41.17 pnts. He is by World Champion Qr Marc and bred by Chantal Rigat and owned by De Catherey Arabians from France. Second in this class was Forever Davencio with 41 pnts

By Aja Angelo bred and owned by Forever arabians from the UK.

Class B was won by E.S.Ajoub with 40.5 pnts. He is by Murana's Jassehr and bred by Murana Stud from Germany and owned by E.S.Arabians.

Second was the lovely white colt Tremor JJ with 40,5 pnts. He is by WH Justice and bred and owned by Johanna Ullstrom from Belgium.

Two year old colt class was won by Atlantycc by Eternity Ibn Navaronne D bred by NV van Hee and owned by Detrimmo NV from Belgium. He scored 41,17 pnts.

Second in his class was Kas Gigi L'amoroso with 40,5 pnts by Ajman Moniscione. Bred and owned by Wenche Roefs from Belgium.

The next class was the Senior Mare class 4 – 6 yrs old.

Won by the lovely liver chestnut mare Althea by Ajman Moniscione with 41,33 pnts. Bred in Italy by Pietro Infusino and owned by Brugman Arabians from Belgium.

Second in this class was Cadanz Djamilah by Aja Justified with 39,17 pnts. Owned and Bred by Marie-Louise Strijbos-Puts from Holland.

Class of 11 yrs and older mares was won by Dama Kier a lovely bay mare bred by Michalow State Stud from Poland and owned by Lutetia Arabians from France with a score of 40,83 pnts. She scored two 10 for movements.

She was followed by the lovely chestnut mare Estarda by Ekstern with 40,67 pnts bred and owned by Peter Wilms from Belgium.

Stallions 4 – 6 yrs old was won by the impressive stallion Newton KA with 42,17 pnts. He is by Qr Marc and owned and bred by Knocke Arabians from Belgium. Newton KA was lateron named Best Belgian Bred horse of the show. Second behind Newton was Manmlakee by DF Malik Jamil with 40,17 pnts. Owned and bred by State stud Marbach from Germany. The 7 yrs and older stallion class was won by a trotting machine named Amoroso de Salvadora. An older Pure Spanish bred stallion by Arabian Beauty. Bred by Major P.Maxwell from UK and owned by Mrs. Suzanna Hayward from France. Amoroso scored 42 pnts with 3 x 10 pnts for movements. Second in this class was AR Fayyim by Valerio ibn Eternity bred by I.Lopez and owned by M.v. Heiningen from Holland with 41,17 pnts.

International Amateur classes. The horses in these classes are judged with the normal scoring system of type, head and neck, body and topline, legs and movements but they also receive a score for presenting the horse and this score is called Harmony.

Lots of young presenters at start with many nice horses. There were tickets to be won by the first five best handlers of the show. Foal class was won by As Nadirah by Ag Al Shatan with 36,8 pnts bred and owned by Al Sharif Arabians.

Junior Filly class was won by Kenna EB with 40,28 pnts She is by Caravagio bred by Elcio Brigatto and owned by Eriska Arabians. Second in this clas was Flaxman's Medina by Black Diamond lda with 40,1 pnts. Bred and owned by Flaxman Arabians Belgium.

Junior Colt class was won by Fa Mikhail with 40 pnts. He is also by Black Diamond lda and bred and owned by Flaxman Arabians. Second in this class was Tremor JJ by Wh Justice with 39,58 pnts. Bred and owned by Johanna Ullstrom from Belgium.

Senior mare class was a very big class with lovely mares and good scores.

Won by RWL Odessa Estopa with 40,42 pnts she is by Om el Abadan. Bred in Australia by RWL Arabians and owned by Flaxman arabians. Second in this class was Bint Shaila

With 39,86 pnts. She is by Jaro d'eversam and was bred in Denmark by Mrs.Marianne Tengstedt. Owned by Ils van Dun.

Senior stallion class was won by TH Amal with 38,61 pnts. Bred by Phillipe Hosay and owned by Jessy Loockx and Dorien van Damme. Second in this class was Akinice by WH Justice with 38,33 pnts. Bred and owned by Antoine de Cuyper.

Senior Gelding class was won by another trotting machine Postar. He scored 41,25 pnts. He is by Om el Bellisimo and was bred in Poland by Janow Podlaski. Owned by Flaxman Arabians. Second in this class the lovely bay gelding Psynselino by Borsalino K with 41,25 pnts. Bred and owned by Agmal Arabians.

In the Amateur show there is also an Overqualified class for horses which have already won something in another show. There were many nice entries in this class.

It was won by snow white Dorsenia by Kabsztad with 41,67 pnts. Bred in Poland by Michalow State stud and owned by Flaxman Arabians. Second to her was Oliver JJ by Sharahm. With 40,3 pnts. Bred by Johanna Ullstrom and owned by Rebecca Uggeldahl.

Best in Show Amateur: Postar presented by Marwen Ben Nasser.

INTERNATIONAL B-SHOW EMERALD

he heat of the desert blew over to Europe, with temperatures up to 40 degrees celcius, it was very hot at the 11th Emerald Trophy – organized by the van Nes family from Belgium. Judges for this event were Mrs. Eberhardt, Mrs. Stojanowska, Mr. Dahmen and Mr. Bialobok.

First class to start was the one of the geldings. Although

the heat was already on, Cadanz Badir (Gilly J x Bess Chandirah) – bred and owned by the Strijbos family from Holland, managed to score a 20 in movement and took the class win with a total of 89.5 points. Scoring the same total of points but less on type was Giacomo (EKS Alihandro x MA Bint Azadik) – bred and owned by Athbah Stud from Saudi Arabia.



There were many yearlingfillies entered, so the class was divided in two sections. The first one had some fantastic fillies, all scoring very close to eachother. The first and second placed horse scored the exact same total of 90.5 points, but due to more points in type, the very pretty Babilonia (Om el Shahmaan x Marisha Apal) – bred by Swatam Arabians and owned by Ferrer Shah Farms, took the lead. Later in the final yearling championships, she took the Gold medal. Second in this class was Naksatra (Nader al Shaqab x Just Diva) – bred by the Sawant family and owned by the Arabian Farms SA from Belgium.

The second group of yearling fillies was won with 90.5 points by the typy MM Niyama (WH Justice x Nautis el Perseus) – bred and owned by Mario Matt Arabians from Austria. Later in the championships, she took the silver medal. Second in this class with 90.38 points and later Bronze medal champion was CL Khamilah (Magic Magnifique x Khidaarah) – bred and owned by Charlotte Lewenhaupt from Sweden.

Next to go were the fillies aged two years old. Big winner of this class with 91.88 points and later winning the Gold in the final junior filly championships was Bint Hazy al Khalediah (El Palacio x Hazy al Khalediah) – bred and owned by Al Khalediah Stables from Saudi Arabia. Second was the pretty Paris J (Emerald J x Palabra) – bred and owned by Jadam Arabians from Belgium. She also took the bronze medal in the final championships.

Only two participants in the three years old fillies class. The Brazilian bred HK Jojo RLC, sired by the recently deceased HK Keav Power and out of Mi Querida HCF – bred by the Schmidt family and owned by Al Arab Stud, Saudi

Arabia – took the lead with a total of 90.33 points. Later in the championships she achieved the Silver medal. Second with 89.67 points was Perdzia (Kabsztad x Perga) – bred by Michalow Stud and owned by Waldemar from Poland. The most adorable class of the day was up next. Beautiful foals parading through the arena with their mums. The heat was strong and many foals were wisely left at home. The ones that did enter the arena, made a great impression. With the filly foals, HDM Maria Apal (RFI Farid x WW Imania Apal) – bred and owned by Haras del Mar from France – scored a massive total of 92.25, including many deserved 20's on type and head & neck. This filly also took the Gold in the supreme foal championships as well as the Best in show title! A big promise for the future! Second in this class with 90.5 points was Bint el Shahmaan (Om el Shahmaan x Euphoria) – bred by Swatam Arabians and owned by Ferrer Shah Farms. This filly took the bronze medal in the supreme foal championships.

The colts foals had three participants. Winner with 91.50 points and later silver medal champion was A Wise Guy of Kossack (Bystival Kossack x A Lady of Kossack) – bred by the Kossack Stud and owned by Ferrer Shah Farms. Second in this class with 89 points was F&M Kaisar (Kaisson x Arapka Kossack) – bred by F&M Arabians and owned by Mercuur Arabians from The Netherlands.

Five beautiful yearling colts filled the next class. Zeus EA (Shanghai x Essence of Marwan) – bred and owned by Equus Arabians from Spain- took the lead with a total of 91.13 points. This ultra typy colt also took the silver medal in the final championships – where he was tie with the champion, but lost the gold as his total of points was less



in the class. Second with the yearling colts with a total of 91 points was Zayed al Khalediah (Jareer al Khalediah x Marakita) – bred and owned by the Al Khalediah Stables from Saudi Arabia.

The two years old colt class was won with 92.13 points by the beautiful Shiraz de Lafon (Shanghai EA x Diacira de Lafon) – bred by Haras de Lafon and owned by Jadem Arabians from Belgium. Later in the championships, this colt took the Gold medal. Second in this class with 90.88 points and later Bronze champion was Cetulion (Kahil al Shaqab x Cetula) – bred and owned by Waldemar from Poland

The three years old colts had only one participant; Shadi al Khalediah (F Shamaal x Layan al Khalediah) – bred and owned by Al Khalediah Stables from Saudi Arabia- scored a total of 91.88 points.

By the time the 4-6 years old mares was ready to start, a nice breeze came up that resulted in a very strong wind, making the temperature finally drop a few degrees. Not for long as the 4-6 years old mares knew how to turn the heat back up with their stunning beauty and flying movement. Isadora Joy (Magnum Psyche x Silk Melody) – scored multiple 20s on type and head & neck, getting a total of 92 points for her breeder Joy Horses and owned Ferrer Shah Farms. In the final championships she took the Gold medal and was also named "Best Belgium bred horse". Second with 91.25 points and later silver medal champion was the big moving Magnums Tulip (QR Marc x FS Magnums Madonna) – bred and owned by Knocke Arabians from Belgium.

The next class, mares aged seven years and older, had three participants. Winner with 90.63 points was Fahera (TS Apolo x Epy) – bred by Lo Giudice Vito and owned by David Pujalt. She also took the bronze medal in the

final championships. Second in this class with 90 points was Suzanna (Ekstern x Splendida) – bred by DB Arabians and owned by Agmal Arabians from Belgium.

The stallion class 4-6 years old had only two participants. The big moving machine BV Pigmalion (WH Justice x Factura) – bred and owned by Bautista Arabians from Spain-scored three 20s on movement and also won the silver medal in the final championships. Second with 90.63 points and later bronze champion was Shamal al Khalediah (Padrons Immage x Faaina) – bred and owned by Al Khalediah Stables from Saudi Arabia.

A very interesting and exciting class of stallions aged 7-10 years old was up next. PA Paschal (Om el Shahmaan x Paris to Rome) – bred by the Chisholm Family and owned by AlSayed Stud from Saudi Arabia – won the class with 91.13 points and took the Gold medal in the final championships. Leaving the second place for the big moving RFI Farid (RFI Maktub x RFI Fayara el Shiraz) – bred by Rodrigo Forte and owned by Al Hawayer Stud from the UAE – who scored a surprisely low score of 90.13 points – as he was the favorite to many. The last class of the day was the class of stallions aged

France – scored a total of 89 points.

It was a nice edition of the always so well organized Emerald Trophy. Interesting horses and a great atmosphere!
