3rd All-Polish Arabian Horse Championships Radom 2018, Poland

At the beginning of July for the third time a very special show took place in Poland. The fact that the organiser, Mr. Stanisław Redestowicz, is one of Polish private breeders and the whole event is sponsored by the non-Arabian horse industry companies only, makes that show quite unique in the scene. Its also worth to mention that all top 5 class winners as well as champions of Radom show get a prize money as well. This year the event was accompanied for the first time with the auction of selected private bred and own Polish mares and fillies with top quality pedigrees.

Friday evening welcomed the participants at local Radom airport area with warm close to 30C temperature that let the people to enjoy a pre-show evening by the showground.

Saturday – the day of classes competition surprised everyone with around 15C degrees. Hopefully the third edition as well as the previous ones were perfectly organised so the cool weather was compensated successfully with warm atmosphere and hospitality of the organisers.

Junior classes were all well represented in the number of horses (minimum 7 each class) from private as well as from state studs and all championship qualified ones both from fillies and colts classes were scored over 90 points. Championship were run since Sunday morning and judged respectively by the panel: Christine Jamar-Deemerseman (Belgium), Renata Schibler (Switzerland), Murilo Kammer (Brazil) and Razi Al Sulaiman (Kuwait). Yearling fillies were the biggest age group of the show, divided into 2 sections and so they had their separate Yearling Fillies Championship won unanimously by El Gotta by Ascot DD from Michalow Stud, followed by Chaos Nefretete by Psyche Keret from Chrcynno Palace Stud and Diodora by Zeus EA bred and own by Petroniusz Frejlich. Both Silver and Bronze medal fillies got the same number of votes from the judges so the highest total score of Chaos Nefretete gave her the primary position in that championship.

Junior Fillies finals was another victory of Chrcynno Palace Stud – this time with gold medal for Gaja Eunika by Kanz Albidayer, followed by another Ascot DD daughter – Tacjana from Janow Podlaski Stud and bronze medal winner – Excalibria by Excalibur bred and own by Zalia Arabians.

Junior Males gold medal winner was also selected unanimously by all the judges and it was Empower by WH Justice bred by Falborek Arabians, while silver medal went to beautiful great mover Belmari by El Omari from Malopolska Hodowla Roslin Sp. Z o.o. (Bialka Stud), and bronze was El Valentino by Excalibur – bred and own by Wojciech Parczewski.

Senior mares classes and championships at Polish shows are always pleasant to watch and it seems that jury also enjoy to judge them as Senior Mare Champion was again selected unanimously and the title went to Wildona by Shanghai EA and out of Wilda – who is one of the brightest stars of Janow Podlaski Auction in Poland this year. Silver medal went to great moving Adelita by Gazal Al Shaqab from Janow Podlaski Stud and bronze was another medal for Chrcynno Palace Stud and their entitled Echo Aurora by Eternity Ibn Navarrone – D.

Kabil Al Shaqab was a sire for another champion too – Gold Medal Senior Stallion that was Pitawal from Janow Podlaski. Silver was his stable mate – Alert by Piaff successful sire in Poland and abroad. Bronze medal went to royally bred Złoty Medal by QR Marc and out of champion producing Złota Orda by Pesal from Michalow Stud.

After the auction that was accompanied by the elegant banquet where almost half of the mares and fillies were sold to Poland and abroad the 3rd All Polish Arabian Horse Show in Radom ended up in a friendly atmosphere of fair play that the participants and spectators mostly enjoyed.
