The Nationals in Syria is a major event were for arabian horse breeders, owners and enthusiasts are looking for after long and terrible break of 7 years. These recent event in Damascus unfortunately lost some good breeders and horses during the war but luckily still many attend the the spectacle and it was just that....a spectacle. The arrival of officials was in Beirut(Lebanon) because still some difficulties to fly directly to Damascus. But everybody were enthusiastic to make a long way of some hours from Beirut to Damascus passing several military check points.

First day we visited old Damascus where is chaotic movement of friendly people of many religion taking place from early morning to the late night. A lot of shops, coffees, old market where you can find everything from spaces to handicraft to souvenirs. The life is never stop here in one of the oldest cities in the World.

We had an occasion to visit The Umayyad Mosque which is islamic most famous mosque. It is unique in its engineering, architecture & decoration, it is considered a school in building and architecture for the wold mosques. It was built by the

And on 06.10.1991 the faithful President Hafez Al-Asaad secret that the great Umayyad mosque at Damascus be restored and improved, as it always has been an Arab & Islamic treasure of civilisation & a bright gem of Damascus.

But lets come to show for reason all of arabian horse's lovers find themselves. The show arena nicely decorated with flowers and old horse saddles and decorations. It was only one judge Mr. Koenrad Dettallior from Belgium who judged the horses with 20 points system and 2 international DC's Mrs. Christina Keiser from Norway and Mr.Mateusz Leniewich Jaworski from Poland who did their job together with Syrian colleagues.

The show was divided in 2 days. The friday was dedicated to Arabian Syrian breed and all horses belong to very long breed in this country. The saturday was dedicated to mixed blood, with some horses imported from different countries.

First class begins with fillies born 2018 Amiret al Khair ll da Amir Al Fadi from Al Khair Stables took class Champion and second filly was Sandi al Zayam from Adam al Zayam breeder and owner al Zayam stables took Silver trophy.

Class 2 section B had 2 participants with following classification: Class Champion Zanoubieh Al fares da Waeel Al Kellawi from owner Mohammed A. Al Bezra and Second was Yasmeen A'asali from stables Zead Al Assail.

The third class of fillies of 2/3 years old had 3 contenders. Fist in the class with 89.5 points was given to Maya Bint Baher from Mouaz Al Mahayani, second Rand Al Fadi with 88.5 and third filly Samar Al Khair bred by Khair Stables took 84.5 points.

Immideately after these classes the Judge took his choice in the Fillies Championship with following results;

Gold Champion: Maya Bint Al Baher Silver Champion: Zanoubieh Al Fares Bronze Champin: Yasmeen A'asali

Immideately after we go to the Syrian bred colts. Class number 4 – yearling colt were 2 in the class. So the class winner was Sadnan from breeder abdallah Al Sadeh and second Omran J from Basil Jadaan Stables.

Class number 5 colts 1-3 years old rappresets by 6 junior colts: First place took Ward Al Zayam from Al Zayam and Amana Stables with 89.5 points, second Asheer from Riead Aouaidan with 89.9, 3th Nagem al Khair - al Khair Stables with 87.0, following by Kahhoul J, Nassar J and Jood Al Aadiyat.

Many young mares 4-6 years old took part in the class number 6. Fisrt place goes to beautiful Maset Ashour with 88.5 points, Second to Sham Al Zayam from famous stable of Al Zayam and Amana with 87.5 points, 3 place Shaqiat Al fourat with same score of the second mare 87.5. After following Afraa Al Zaym, Aydah J, Khair Al Fourat, Yasmin Al Khair, Mokhtarah SH, Sablet Al Agha and Dohmaa Al Sada.

Class 7 of mares from 7 to 9 years old consist of 10 participants. Class winner is beautiful Ghaida Al Khair from Al Khair Stables, second place was given to Durret Al Ghabraa the third to Souhail Al Sham with 87.5 points. After 3 mares following Hibat al Prince, Shams Al Khair, Khans Al Ghabraa, Bint Shamkhah, Samah Al Demeshqih and Hala Al Zaim.

Championship is going to be ready and the breeders and their friends and neigbours becoming nervous for it.

So after long evaluation Belgian Judge Mr, Koenrad Dettallior took his decision:

Gold Champiom Ghaiada Al Khair Silver Champion Durret Al Ghabraa Bronze Champion Maset Ashour

Next class of the treasure of Syrian Breed in the desert, class number 9. Seven stallion present in this class. Class winner is handsome stallion Omar Al Khayam bred and owned by Naji Shawi who took 90.00 points. Second following is Kanz Al Khair by Al Khair Stables with 88.00 points. Third is Taj Al Khair bred by the same stables with 87.5 and following stallions Sultan Al Badr, Saquer Al Khair, sorbets and Drea Al Gabraa.

Folowing class number 10 of stallions 10 years and older. Again 7 handsome stallions presents, proud of Syrian breed, The first class charismatic stallion is Mounter Al Jameel with high score of 91.00 points, Second place Mahboob Umro with 89.5 point and 3th Asaad Al Thani with 89.00. Following others like Omar Nasser, Adham Al Zayam, Basher Al Jameel and Meshbah Al Khair.

Championship of Syrian bred stallion was very exiting moment among all public present at the festival.

After this amazing day it was offered traditional Syrian food in special Syrian restaurant with life music and everybody enjoed this special evening.

Saturday was opening by national dancers and horse riders with the flags and Syrian Music. Mr. Basil Jadaan had a speech that everybody are pleased and happy to celebrate Today's 7th National Championship of Syria for the beauty of the Arabian Horse, which is honoured by organising the same: The Syrian Association has deep significance for the interest in culture, tradition and Arab horse values and as indicator of fragrant and glorious history blends out of the prosperous history. One of the highest goals of this Championship is consolidate the various aspects of our National Heritage and try to maintain and preserve the same to remain ever-present for the future generations. Saturday was the show for the "mix" arabian horses, not only syrian breed but the horse which were bought from Middle East and Europe and then successfully bred in this country. Class of fillies from 1-3 years old (5 participants) goes immediately to the Championship.

Also in the class we had 6 colts from 1 to 3 years old. And the Championship was decided like:

Three classes of beautiful mares. First of 6 young mares, Second 9 middle aged and last class with 7.

After we had 2 classes of the stallions first with 4 horses and second with 5 stallions in the class.

The last day of our stay we visited Saydana convent and church. Saldana is Syrian word. The first part Sayda means Lady and the second Naya means Our, the whole world means OUR LADY. The Convent si an Orthodox Establishment housing 50 nuns, presided by superior. Hundreds of Christiona Pilgrims visit this Sanctuary every year. It is built on a high and lovely hill dominating the Syrian village of Saydanaya and has a library enriched by valuable manuscripts, from which we can trace the period of the convent construction, which took place in about the year 547 A.D.

At the end everybody was fired but happy to visit such a beautiful country and amazing festival! Hope the show is growing or may be more shows can be organised during a year and we wish to Syrian Breeders only the PEACE in their country. See you for sure next year more numerous!.
