
THE 2019 ARABIAN BREEDERS

The judges' pick for Gold Champion was Aria Venetian Lace, a daughter of World Champion EKS Alihandro and out of the U.S. National Champion mare, Beijings Velvet. 



In addition to his ABWC title, *Sultan GK was the 2019 Scottsdale Champion Stallion. He was presented to his wins by Andrew Sellman.



The ABWC Bronze Champion Senior Stallion, Equiborn K.A., is a proven international champion. He is a son of World Champion Stallion, QR Marc, by *Marwan Al Shaqab. Equiborn K.A. is out of the Polish mare Espadrilla, bred by Michalow State Stud, a daughter of Monogramm and Emanacja, a daughter of Eukaliptus. Equiborn K.A. was bred by Paul Gheysens of Knocke Arabians of Belgium and was presented to his American title by David Boggs.
