The 11th edition of AHO Arabian horse events will go back to the place in Chantilly where it all started 6 years ago!

Indeed, a new partnership between the Arabian Horse Organization (AHO) and the Domaine of Chantilly was established to put this edition under colours of passion and friendship that it deserves.

The charming Chantilly's showground surrounded by the Castle and the Grand Stables will be hosting again two important Arabian horse events of the 2019 show calendar: the famous AHO Breeders' Championship Europe and the AHO World Cup.

While the Breeders' Championship is a show only open to European breeders, the AHO World Cup is an open international event. The qualifying classes for the World Cup are scheduled for the 2nd of August, for the Breeders' Championship on the 3rd of August and all Championships will take place on Sunday, 4th of August.

Both shows are organized by the Arabian Horse Organization (AHO) which is working hard to offer everyone a great show and the breeders and owners

the big opportunity to win the championship titles as well as a rich prize money: Top 7 in class receives 1.000 Euro each and the best handler and best breeder go homewith each 5.000 Euro (Prizemoney in the AHO Breeders' Championship only). In previous years, AHO welcomed over 100 European and international breeders competing in the AHO Breeders' Championship Europe and AHO World Cup.

The AHO, the organization of Arabian countries for the Arabian horses, was founded in 2010. Its founding members among others are: Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates, Egypt, Morocco and Tunisia. The organization is driven by a spirit of partnership aiming to support the breeders of purebred Arabian horses. AHO sees itself in the "service of the breeders" and is reaching out to the breeders in order to expand information and expertise among countries. The organization is open to actions and proposals that benefit the Arabian horse and its breeding and strengthen its representation all over the world. The Arabian Horse Organization is supporting national



societies and international organizations that encourage the Arabian horse and its activities.

Chantilly, as always, is offering many attractions: the Castle of Chantilly that is open to everybody who wants to visit it. The Musée Condé, one of the finest art galleries in France hosted inside the Castle, and the Living Museum of the Horse dedicated to equine art and culture and housed in the Grand Stables of the Castle, are two of the many "must-sees" in Chantilly, a little town where calm and peacefulness are the master words in spite of being close to the capital of France, Paris.

AHO has some more surprises for you – save the date on the 2nd of August (evening)!

The hotel chosen by AHO to host the guests is again the Auberge du Jeu de Paume, Relais & Châteaux, the very expression of fine French living, an unique luxury hotel steeped in history and cultural heritage, just in front of the showground.

The entries for both shows will be open from 14th of June to 5th of July 2019.

AHO WORLD CUP & AHO BREEDERS' CHAMPIONSHIP EUROPE (2-4 AUGUST 2019)

Conditions of Entry – AHO World Cup 2019

The AHO World Cup in Chantilly, organized by the AHO is open to any purebred Arabian horse fulfilling the following conditions:

- a. Be registered in a studbook recognized by WAHO
- b. All horses (only exception is yearlings) should have qualified in one of the following ways in 2018 or 2019:
 - a. 1st to 5th at any AHO Show
 - b. 1st to 5th at an ECAHO Title, A, B Show or National Championship (or equivalent shows)
 - c. 1st to 5th at the Dubai International Show
 - d. 1st to 5th at the Abu Dhabi International Show
 - e. 1st to 3rd at an ECAHO C National, C International or C European Show (or equivalent shows)
 - f. 1st to 3rd at a Specific Origin Show (or equivalent shows)
 - g. 1st to 3rd at the US Las Vegas or Scottsdale Show
 - h. Horses that obtain this qualification after the closing date of entry must show the qualification by 31st of July 2019, otherwise the horse will be rejected from the show and no entry fees will be refunded.
- c. All handlers must have a valid ECAHO Handler permit to show the horses.

Conditions of Entry – AHO Breeders' Championship EUROPE 2019

The AHO Breeders' Championship Europe in Chantilly, organized by AHO is open to any purebred Arabian horse fulfilling the following conditions:

- a. Be owned by a European breeder (European Nationality)
- b. Be born in Europe
- c. Be registered in a studbook recognized by WAHO
- d. Be entirely owned by the breeder and the horse has never been sold or leased (as stated in the passport).
If horses competed previously under the name other than the breeder, the horse is subject to be disqualified and no entry fees will be refunded.
- e. Has not been a gold, silver or bronze champion in any Title Show during 2017, 2018 or 2019. Has not been a gold champion in any A-Show during 2017, 2018 or 2019.
Has not been a gold champion at the Breeders' European Championship in Chantilly 2018. Only exception is if a yearling horse becomes a junior, or a junior horse becomes a senior.
- f. All entered horses must be shown in an ECAHO B or C Show in 2018 or 2019. Only exception is a yearling horse. Horses that obtain this qualification after the closing date of entry must show the qualification by 31st of July 2019, otherwise the horse will be rejected from the show and no entry fees will be refunded.
- g. All handlers must have a valid ECAHO Handler permit to show the horses.
