

4th All-Polish Arabian Horse Championships Radom 2019, Poland

On the 29 – 30th of June a very special show took place in Poland – All-Polish Horse Championship in Radom. The show made its debut in year 2016 on the outskirts of Radom, on the premises of the Radom Aeroclub (Piastów grass airfield) and was succesfully held every year. Also this year the All-Polish Arabian Horse Championship Radom succesfully took place for the fourth time. The event lasted for 2 days during which Polish horses of very high quality were showed to the gathered audience and to the world. A total of 89 horses were entered, with 81 making their way to the show ground.

In Radom there were money prizes for breeders. Total amount of prizes was 103.900 PLN net. The main prize - Best in Show – despite being prestigious as the Trophy of the President of Radom, Mr. Radosław Witkowski, under whose patronage the show took place, was also pleasant financially with the amount of 15 thousand PLN (around 3500 EUR). The gold Championship medalists won 5 thousand PLN each, the silver medalists – 3 thousand PLN each and the bronze medalists – 1 thousand PLN each. A class win resulted in prize of 1,200 PLN, second place in prize of 800 PLN and third to fifth earned prize of 400 PLN. Higher prizes were allotted for a foal class where the prize for the first place was 2,000 PLN, for the second place 1,500 PLN and 1000 PLN for the third place. Also the prize money of 800 PLN was guaranteed to each of all foals competing in the foal class. Also the laureates did not have to wait long to cash their symbolic cheques – they were as always realised straight away in the show's office.

The weather on saturday (the first day of the show) gave everyone a warm welcome with around 25 C degrees. And this day started with classes competition.

All classes were very well represented by the horses from private as well as from state studs. Horses during the show were judged by the panel: Koenraad Detailleur (Belgium), Helen Hennekens-van Nes (Belgium), Faustino Scanzi (Italy) and Medhat Gaber (Egypt).

The categories of yearling fillies, the 2 year fillies, yearling colts and 4-6 year old mares enjoyed great popularity during entry time so each of them were divided into two classes.

The winner of the first yearling fillies class was El Romantica (QR Marc – Etiffani/Justify) - bred and owned by Mr Wojciech Parczewski, followed by Basilia (Pogrom-Binduga/Kahil Al Shaqab) – bred and owned by Janów Podlaski

State Stud (second place) and Eskahila (Kahil al Shaqab – Espanera/Kabsztad) bred and owned by Mr Piotr Podgórny (third place).

The winner of the second yearling fillies class was Amirata (EKS Alihandro – Alhasa/Ganges) bred and owned by Janów Podlaski State Stud, followed by Wieża Gwiazd (Emerald J – Wieża Radości/Psytadel) bred and owned by Mr Józef Pietrzak (second place) and Ishara (Shamal Al Khalediah – Ilionora MAF/Abha Mahdi) bred and owned by Mr Idris Hassan.

The winner of the first class of 2 year old fillies was Echo Asteria (Psyche Keret – Echo Aurora/Ethernity IBN Navarrone-D) bred and owned by SK Chrcynno-Pałac Mr Krzysztof Poszepczyński. Also the first "20" for type during this year 's Radom show was received by Echo Asteria. The second place in this class belongs to Diodora (Zeus EA – Druchna/Ensenator) bred and owned by Mr Petroniusz Frejlich and the third place to Wieża Tajemnic (Ascot DD – Wieża Marzeń/Ekstern) bred and owned by Michałów State Stud.

The second class of 2 year old fillies was won by El Bellisima (Ascot DD – Ekliptyka/Ekstern) bred and owned by Michałów State Stud, who was followed by Wan Diamena (Ascot DD-Warejka/Piaff) bred and owned by Mr Jerzy Chrapkowski (second place) and Pila (Abyad AA – Piba/Gazal Al Shaqab) bred and owned by Janów State Stud (third place).

The winner of the 3 year old fillies class was Parantella (Kahil Al Shaqab – Palanga/Ekstern) bred and owned by Michałów State Stud, followed by the second place – Kalifornia (Kahil Al Shaqab – Karbona/Ekstern bred and owned by Mr Krzysztof Falba, and on the third place - Estelda (Emerald J – Eksterna/Ekstern) bred and owned by Mr Krzysztof Goździalski, the breeder of the famous mare Eralda.







The winner of the first class of yearling colts was Star Farid (RFI Farid – EKS Star Of Africa/Marwan Al Shaqab) bred and owned by Mr Wojciech Parczewski, second place was awarded to Wolare (RFI Farid – Wieża Marii/El Omari) also bred and owned by Mr Parczewski. On the third place was Passar (Atius O – Perkilla/Al Maraam) bred and owned by SK Dębno Adam Lachera.

The second class of yearling colts had Estorius F (Fa El rasheem – Estama/EKS Alihandro) as winner, who is bred and owned by Falborek Arabians Stud. The second place was taken by Freyson (E.S. Harir – Future/Kahil al Shaqab) bred and owned by Mr Andrzej Wójtowicz, followed by Pentarion (Medalion – Pernata/LVA Maximus) bred by Białka State Stud owned by Małopolska Hodowla Roślin Sp. z o.o.

The winner of the 2 year old colts class was Erantis (Ascot DD – Eugara/Om El Bellissimo) bred and owned by Janów Podlaski State Stud, followed by Parillus (Ascot DD – Parilla/Enzo) bred by Białka State Stud, owned by Małopolska Hodowla Roślin Sp. z o.o. (second place) and Prince PA (Eden C – Palatina/QR Marc) bred by PPH Parys SK Dąbrówka owned by PPH Parys (third place).

The class of 3 year old colts was dominated by two colts – Chaos Uriel (Psyche Keret – Chaos Persefona/Poganin) bred and owned by SK Chrcynno-Pałac Mr Krzysztof Poszepczyński on the first place and Egaj (Ekstroniusz – El-Europa/Celsjusz)

bred by Stajnia Pałacowa M. Nowińska & K. Opoka and owned by Mr Karol Opoka on the second place.

In the both classes of 4-6 year old mares we could also see many beautiful mares from which Pregola (Vitorio TO – Perespa/Enzo) won the first place, followed by Beira (Pogrom – Berenika/Eden C) both bred and owned by Janów Podlaski State Stud. The third place was won by Wanilia Sky (Espimar – Wabia/Al Lahaab) bred and owned by Mr Krzysztof Goździalski. Also the first place was achieved by Parmania (Kahil Al Shaqab – Parmana/Al Maraam) bred and owned by Michałów State Stud, who was followed on the second place by Future (Kahil Al Shaqab – Fortycja/Pegasus) bred and owned by Mr Andrzej Wójtowicz, and by El Larinera (Empire -El Emeera/Ekstern) bred and owned by Michałów State Stud.

The class of mares of 7 years and over was won by Lawinia (Ekstern – Luanda/Emigrant) bred and owned by Michałów State Stud as the first, Elliseina (Galba-Ellisara/Laheeb) bred by Michałów State Stud and owned by Polska AKF Sp. z o.o. as the second and Psyche Victoria (Ekstern – Pallas-Atena/Ecaho) bred and owned by SK Chrcynno-Pałac Mr Krzysztof Poszepczyński as the third best horse in this class.

The class of 4-6 year old stallions was won by El Shaad (FA El Shawan – El Estrada/Justify) bred by Mrs and Mr Małgorzata and Józef Pietrzak, owned by SK Dębno Adam













Lachera, followed by El Wiktorio (Eternal – Elwiktoria/ Ekstern) bred and owned by Mr Petroniusz Frejlich on the second place and by Dastan (Equator – Dama Pik/Enzo) bred and owned by Michałów State Stud od the third place.

The last of the classes held on saturday was the class od stallions od 7 years and over in which the first place was taken by Empire (Enzo – Emira/Laheeb), the second place by Złoty Medal (QR Marc – Złota Orda/Pesal) both bred and owned by Michałów State Stud. The third place in this interesting class was taken by Najm Al Khalediah (ZT Maghossny – Nada Al Khalidiah/ Abha Ifni) bred by Primastella Arabians, owned by Mrs Agnieszka Maślanka.

Sunday - as the second day of the show - was the day of the championships, where the most beautiful of the horses participating in the event, competed for the gold, silver and bronze medals.

In the Junior Female Championship the gold medal went to Echo Asteria (Psyche Keret – Echo Aurora/Ethernity IBN Navarrone-D) bred and owned by SK Chrcynno-Pałac Mr Krzysztof Poszepczyński, silver medal to El Bellisima (Ascot DD – Ekliptyka/Ekstern) bred and owned by Michałów State Stud and bronze medal to Diodora (Zeus EA – Druchna/ Ensenator) bred and owned by Mr Petroniusz Frejlich.

In the Junior Male Championship the gold medal went to

Erantis (Ascot DD - Eugara/Om El Bellissimo) bred and owned by Janów Podlaski State Stud, silver medal to Star Farid (RFI Farid – EKS Star Of Africa/Marwan Al Shaqab) bred and owned by Mr Wojciech Parczewski and bronze medal to Parillus (Ascot DD - Parilla/Enzo) bred by Białka State Stud, owned by Małopolska Hodowla Roślin Sp. z o.o.

In the Senior Female Championship the gold medal went to Lawinia (Ekstern – Luanda/Emigrant) bred and owned by Michałów State Stud, silver medal to Parmania (Kahil Al Shaqab - Parmana/Al Maraam) also bred and owned by Michałów State Stud and bronze medal to Elliseina (Galba-Ellisara/Lacheeb) bred by Michałów State Stud and owned by Polska AKF Sp. z o.o.

In the Senior Male Championship the gold medal went to Empire (Enzo – Emira/Laheeb) bred and owned by Michałów State Stud, silver medal to El Shaad (FA El Shawan - El Estrada/Justify) bred by Mrs and Mr Małgorzata and Józef Pietrzak, owned by SK Debno Adam Lachera and bronze medal to Złoty Medal (QR Marc – Złota Orda/Pesal) also bred and owned by Michałów State Stud.

Finaly the title of the Best in Show was awarded to Echo Asteria bred and owned bred by SK Chrcynno Pałac - Mr Krzysztof Poszepczyński.

Also on sunday the class of foals and Foals Championship







took place (sponsored by the European Breeders Trust), during which four foals were presented. The best of them were Elprima (Wadee Al Shaqab – Elethia KA/QR Marc) bred and owned by G.R. Paweł Redestowicz (first place and gold medal), Bogini Kahila PA (Kahil Al Shaqab – Black Rose/Abyad AA) bred by PPH Parys SK Dąbrówka and owned by PPH Parys (second place and silver medal) and Potencja (Eternal – Pentoria/El Omari) bred and owned by Mrs Alicja Najmowicz.

The fourth edition of the Radom Championship - just like all the previous editions - was very well organised and great

atmosphere was felt thanks to the hospitality of the organisers. During the two days of the show the audience not only could admire the beauty of arabian horses but also artistic shows of La Pattat Dutka & Franczak Horse Show and air shows performed by Mr Robert Kowalik – Polish Champion and Bronze European Medalist in airplane acrobatics.

After the Championships – for the second time in the history of All-Polish Arabian Horse Championship in Radom – a Summer Sale Auction was held. It was the polish private studs auction during which 22 horses were offered for the auction. The highest price offered for the horse was 26.000 EUR.


