ENDURANCE BREEDERS FINALS

The Friday started with the breeders cup final for endurance horses. Here the horses where evaluated on confirmation, legs and movement in liberty.

Best endurance potential yearling with 81.67 points was Meikann Teoulere (Gigolo de Venelles x Phelkane de Lamothe), bred and owned by Karine Feral. Winner of the yearling class fillies with 80.28 points was Sayyida Hourcadet (Djahm al Mounjoye x Seydnaya de Nautiac) – bred by Virginie Trapp and owned by Remy Hourcadet. The colts and geldings two years old class was won with 80.21 points by Lynn de Bozouls (Muguet de Pascade x Feelynn de Bozouls) - bred and owned by Mezagri SARL. The class of the two years old fillies with 81.53 points was L'Egerie de Cordelle (Djevar de Graves x Tooyou de Gargassan) – bred and owned by Pascale Piazzalunga. A large class of colts and geldings of three years old was won with ease with 82.36 points by Kachou du Vialaret (Modem x Karalalai Larzac) Bred by Audrey Andre and owned by Earl du Vialaret. The last class was the class of fillies aged three years old. Winner with the big score of 85.56 points was Kamila de Nauzes (Cyrano C x Qaly de Gargassan) bred and owned by Nicolas Dayde.

FRENCH NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

On Saturday the show continued with the French National Championships. Judges for this event were Mrs Renata Schibler, Mrs Kathleen Ohlsson, Mr Medhat Gaber and Mr Regis Huet. First up were the yearling fillies. A nice class with young females. Winner of the class with 91.19 points and later Gold medal champion was Agmal Psytara (Aj Nawash x Agmal Psyrensia) — bred by Agmal Arabians and owned by Vigil Alejandro. Second in this class with 90.81 points and silver medal champion was Kilika de Nautiac (Jahili de Nautiac x Chadina de Nautiac) — bred by Rachel Bourrassé and owned by Haras de Nautiac.

The second class of yearling fillies had the pretty Rayanna des Aubues (FM Amir al Baydaa x Nirvana des Aubues) as winner. With 90 points, this filly, bred and owned by Haras de la Chataigniere, won her class and later she claimed in the bronze medal in the yearling championships. 2nd in this class with 89.69 points was the balanced Miss Gill du Tsia (Tchaata Iniziato x Mystic Angel) – bred, owned and shown by Tifany Salierno.

Off it went with the class of the two years old fillies. The first group had Bizia de Nautiac (Ajib de Nautiac x Makeda de Nautiac) as their winner with a total of 91.06 points. Later in the junior championships, she got the silver medal. 2nd in the class with 90.69 points and later bronze medal winner was the big moving filly Poema Paladia (Paladid x Psyche Lejla) – bred and owned by Miroslaw Rogowski.

The second group of fillies had some nice young fillies. Winner with 90.88 points was Angelia JJ (AJ Nawash x Athena SA) – bred and owned by Johanna Ullström. Second in this class with 89.44 points and later gold medal winner was the very pretty Hizia JJ (Maximilian x Harmonia JJ) – bred and owned by Jacky Simon.

The class of three years old had only one participant. The lovely Shah Asia (Namous al SHahania x Shah Arousa) – bred aby Sardar Afkhami and owned by SCEA de Rouzieres.

The senior mare class of mares aged 4-6 years old was led with 91.94 points by JA Jazzia (Montana Firenze x JA Falaene) bred and owned by Samual Grosjean. Second with 89.19 points was the big moving Hawa abint Khasib (AJ Khasib x So Fashion) bred and owned by Evelyne Eschbach.

The show continued with the mares aged 7 years and older. Some gorgeous mares made their entrance. Two beautiful flee-bitten mares got the lead. The big moving Tamara LL (Gris el Jamaal x Sweet Alladina), bred by Luciana Levy and leased by Arctictern SCEA, scored multiple 20's on head and with a total score of 92.25 points, she took the lead in this class. The second place with 91.81 points was for the fantastic flee-bitten Ruscana de Fontanel (Mhekir de Nautiac x Piloiska) – bred and owned by Serge Cluchier. Later in the championships, she took the silver medal! Third in this class was another very pretty jewel. Labeebah Albidayer (Shanghai EA x Falcons Lovesong), bred and owned by Sheikh Mohammed bin Saud Alqasimi, scored a

total of 90.56 points and later took the bronze medal in the senior mare championships. She also got the special trophy for best movement female!

The second group of mares aged 7 years and older was won with 91.50 points by the big moving Najmah Albidayer (Kanz al Bidayer x Nesje l Khimala) — bred and owned by Sheikh Mohammed bin Saud Alqasimi. Second with 90.94 points was Talilah al Raix (Volkov al Raix x Harmattan Thalya) — bred and owned by Jean Michel Franceries.

The show continued with the broodmare class. Here was a mare that left an incredible impression. She came, she conquered. The fleebitten gorgeous Haifa al Adeyat (EKS Alihandro x HP Martina), bred, owned and shown by Mathieu Miloux, came in dancing, with her beautiful colt at her side. She scored multiple 20's on type and head and convincedly took not only the lead in the class with a massive 93.19 points, but also claimed the Gold medal in the senior mare championships. That she is also a great broodmare, she proved by her colt Pablo, who went on to win the gold medal with the foals! Later on at the show, this mare also won the Best in show female title!

Second in the class of broodmares was SH Cyrene (Namous al Shahania x SH Canila) bred by Santiago Serrano and owned by SH Iberic Arabians, with a total score of 90 points. Later in the filly foal championships, her filly SH Camila by Rasheem (by Rasheem Alibidayer) took the Gold medal.

The silver medal with the filly foals went to Shaina JJ (AJ Nawash x Shakara) — bred and owned by Nathalie Gerard. Bronze medal champion was Hera de Gacia (Lazeez al Shahania x Satenia) — bred and owned by Sarah Combette. Next to go where the colt foals. Beautiful cute colts paraded through the arena. The Gold medal went to the extremely showy Pablo MM (Jewel RC x Haifa al Adeyat), bred, owned and shown by Mathieu Miloux. This colt just couldn't get his tail down and kept on dancing. Silver in this class was for SH Fakhir (Rasheem al Bidayer x Fitoon Albidayer) — bred and owned by SH Iberic Arabians. Bronze was for Zeur de Gacia (Lazeez al Shahania x Toskania) — bred and owned by Sarah Combette.

The show continued with some beautiful geldings. Gold medal winner was the big moving J'Aime MM (Jewel RC x Hana'a RC) bred by Mathieu Miloux and owned by Adeline Gergaud. Silver medal champion was Tyron al Raix (SMA Magic One x Talilah al Raix) — bred by Jean Michel Franceries and owned by Pascaline Lepoutre. Bronze medal was for Emiliano JJ (Sharahm x Elysia) bred and owned by Johanna Ullström.

The show continued with a great class of yearling colts. All showy and ready to start their career in the showring. Big winner of the class with 92.19 points was the gorgeous, big moving colt Jowel MM (Jewel RC x Haifa de Adeyat) – the full brother of the Gold medal champion of the colt foals. Jowel, bred, owned and shown by Mathieu Miloux, also claimed the gold medal in the yearling championships.

Second in this class with 90.88 points was the pretty BP El Eazar Vittorio (LF Aarmaan Vittorio x GG Scherapee) – bred by Brigitta Jansenberger and owned by Charlotte Cornil. Later in the championships, this colt got the silver medal.

The second group of yearlings was led by JA Mirajj (Avatar AT x Spirit Asma) – bred and owned by Samual Grosjean. Second with 89.75 points and surprisely Bronze medal winner in the final yearling championships was JA Malek (IBN Farid x JA Falaene) bred and owned by Samual Grosjean.

After this group it was time for the junior boys! The temperature has raised to a 33c. Not only the horses, but also the handlers and judges had a tough time in the full sun. 2 years old Hyllos Domitia (Heracles Domitia x GF Kavadis), bred by Domitia Farms, Flavie Allman and owned by Patrice Attard, won his class by 90.88 points and later took the silver medal in the final junior championships. Second in this class with 89.38 points was Dhuisy Konquerant (King Arthur EA x Bibie de Narthoux) – bred by Jean Philippe Bister and owned by Elise Dubois.

The class of three years old had only two participants. Winner with 91.69 points and later gold medal champion with the junior colts was Dionysos de Nautiac (Wadee al Shaqab x Cesaria de Nautiac) — bred and owned by Rachel Bourrasse. Second in this class with 89.81 points and bronze medal champion was Eureka EA (Empire x Cheronea) —

bred by Equus Arabians and owned by Genevieve Bister.

The show continued with a great class of stallions aged 4-6 years old. Clear winner with 92.31 points was the big moving Jalwan albidayer (Emerald J x Alba EA) – bred and owned by Sheikh Mohammed bin Saud Alqasimi. Later in the senior championships, Jalwan took the silver medal. Second in this class with 91.44 points was Faaris AM (FA el Rasheem x Abha Palma) – bred by Al Mohamadia Stud and owned by Stephanie Touzet.

The second class of stallions aged 4-6 years was won by Heracles Domitia (Styx Kalliste x HG Sweet Fantasy) – bred and owned by Domitia Farms, Flavie Allman, with a total score of 91.50 points. Later in the championships, this stallion received the bronze medal. Second in this class with 90.19 points was Sultan di Mar (Dominic M x Odissea di Mar) – bred by Haras di Mar and owned by Helene Leuridan.

The last class of stallions was for the 7 years and older stallions. Gold medal champion was Hermes (EKS Alihandro x Sanadina) — bred by Al Rashediah Stud and in leasing to RJ Arabians. With a score of 92.81 points, Hermes also took the Gold medal in the final championships and was named Best in show male. Second in this class with 91.69 points was Shah Mahour (Emerald J x Shah Maliha) — bred and owned by Shah Arabians. This big moving stallion also received the award for Best movement male!







EGYPTIAN EVENT EUROPE CHAMPIONSHIPS

In the afternoon it was time for the Egyptian Event Europe—the European Championships of the Pyramid Society Europe. One of the best Straight Egyptians in the world came to compete for the medals! Judges for this event were Mrs Renata Schibler, Mr Mohamed Badrawy, Mr. Marc Veray, Mr. Fausto Scanzi and Mr. Santiago Fornieles.

First class was dedicated to the yearling fillies. The incredible beautiful and big moving filly Lateen Aldanat, scored straight 20s on head and with a score of 92.38 points, she took the lead in the class. Bred and owned by Al Danat Stud from Kuwait. Second in this class with 91.38 points was Sulyna el Ryad (Shaeen AA x Nunzia GCA) bred and owned by Rosa lo Iacono from Italy. This filly was also awarded with the special trophy of Best European junior female.

Third with 89.31 points was Mamlakat al Rashediah (Naseem al Rashidiah x Mesauda al Rashediah) — bred and owned by Abdoulrahman Aljasmi. Because this was the only yearling filly class, the top three was automatically named Gold, Silver and Bronze.

The show continued with the fillies aged two years old. Only

one participant in this class. The typey Madeenah Halima (Madheen el Masr x GWS Mayyadah), bred and owned by Ponnath Arabians from Germany. Later in the junior championships, she took the bronze medal.

The class of three years old fillies was won with 92.63 points by Hosniyah al Arab (Asfoor al Waab x Reem al Arab) — bred and owned by Sheikha Sarah Farhad al Sabeh from Kuwait. Later in the championships, this filly took the gold medal. 2nd with 91.38 points and silver medal champion was Shahira al Rashediah (Naseem al Rashediah x Classic Sharina C) — bred and owned by Abdoulrahman Aljasmi from Bahrain.

The show continued with the mares aged 4-6 years old. A nice class with some beautiful mares. Winner with 92.94 points and later Silver medal senior champion mare was Ayah al Fala (Naseem al Rashediah x Zumorroda al Waab) — bred and owned by Al Fala Stud from Saudi Arabia. This mare also received the special trophy for Best head female!

Second with 91.31 points was Dana al Rashediah (Jamil al Rayyan x Maleeha al Rashediah) – bred and owned by Abdoulrahman Aljasmi from Bahrain. Third in the class and

later named Best female French horse was Kamila TT (Mas Bilal x CFL Miss Dior) – bred by Siard Arabians and owned by Michel Pignet, with a score of 90.81 points.

A super class of 7 years and older mare class was up next. Fantastic mares dancing through the arena. Clear winner with 93.19 points was the stunning D Afaf (Frasera Mashar x ESA Arieanna) – bred and owned by Dubai Arabian horse stud from the UAE. This mare scored full 20's on type. Later in the senior mare championships, she claimed the gold medal. Afaf also won the Best in show female title.

Second in this class with 91.84 points and later bronze medal winner was the big moving Questurat al Fawaz (Al Raheb AA x HV Ramses Mashallah) – bred by Kfar Arabe and owned by Hanaya Stud from Switzerland. Later this mare received the special award for Best European senior female.

The second group of senior mares aged 7 years and older was also fantastic to watch. Winner with 92.10 points was the big moving mare Nadirah al Rashediah (ZT Faaiq x NK Naeema) — bred an owned by Abdoulrahman Aljasmi from Bahrain. This mares scored 20's on both type and movement

and was awarded with the Best movement female trophy. Second in this class with 91.44 points was FH Sharuby Rose (Shaheen al Waab x Candela Rose) — bred by Franklin Holloman and owned by Al Jood Stud from Qatar.

The show continued with the filly foal class. Winner of the gold medal was Nyma bint Nakeeb (Al Nakeeb AA x Hamra bint Saqqarah) — bred and owned by Sebastien Brun. Silver medal champion was Nahla bin Majd (Frasera al Majd x Saqqarah bint Shahnan) also bred and owned by Sebastian Brun from France. Bronze medal winner was Mahbouba bint Dalia (Kholkhaz du Soleil x Baba Dalia) bred and owned by OZ Arabians from France.

Next to go was the class of the 2 years old colts. Winner with 92.13 points and later Gold medal winner was Sofian al Baydaa (Fady al Baydaa x Salma al Baydaa) — bred and owned by Al Baydaa farm from Egypt. Second in the class with 91.88 points and later silver medal champion was Nader al Ghanayim (Naseem al Rashediah x Al Jawhara al Danat) — bred by Ayad Abdulmohsen and owned by Al Ghanayim Stud from Kuwait.

The three years old colt class was won with 90.75 points by

Malik al Rashediah (DF Malik Jamil x DF Kamilah) — bred and owned by Al Rashediah Stud from Bahrain. This colt also received the bronze medal in the championships. Second in this class with 89.94 points was Hanaya Rahil (Al Raheb AA x F Jannah) — bred by Hanaya Stud and owned by Oz Arabians from France. This colt also received the special trophy for best European junior male.

The 4-6 years old stallion class had two placed horses. Winner with 91.50 points and later bronze medal champion was Farund al Remas (Egaab al Rayyan x Hasina al Zobair) – bred and owned by Arkan Malik Hammood al Kubaisi from the UAE. Second in this class with 89.88 points was Raasim Acnaibac (Bassim AA x CF Rajha) – bred by Gaetan Bidault and owned by Alessandro Rota from Italy.

Last class of the Straight Egyptians was the one of the senior stallions aged 7 years and older. Winner with 92.88 points and later Gold medal winner was Safeer al Wadi (Majd al Rayyan x Shawq al Zobair) – bred and owned by Hamad bin Awad bin Ali bin Quarayah from Saudi Arabia. This stallion also won the Best movement male trophy an the trophy for Best in show male.

Second in this class with 91.63 points was Nadeer al Rashediah (ZT Faaiq x NK Nadine) — bred and owned by Al Rashediah stud from Bahrain. Later in the championships, this stallion won the silver medal. Third in this class with 90.25 points was Najhar du Siard (CFL Hajar x CF Jadore) — bred by Claud Collet and owned by Valene Aubron from France. This stallion was awarded with the Best male French horse trophy and the best European senior male trophy.

Breeders Evening

On Saturday evening, a great breeders' party was organized by the organizers of the show, with 350 people present in the VIP area and more than 400 people from the city of Vichy who came to see the show, a real success. With food, music, drinks and fun and a great show by Benoit and Charly Soumille. A presentation of special trophies took place after the equestrian show at night with Trophy and Champagne, a nice surprise for the breeders. The party went on until the early hours but the next morning, all where present for the last show of the weekend, The international C-show!

International C-show

The international show started with a large yearling filly class. Gorgeous young fillies at the start of their career. The first three fillies scored very close together. In the end it was the very showy and refined Karma al Shiraa (RFI Unique x Eralda) bred and owned by Al Shiraa Stables from Abu Dhabi, who took the first position with a total score of 92.56 points. She scored full 20s on head and received the trophy for Best head female! Second in this class with 92.25 points was another very pretty girl, scoring multiple 20s on head as well. Ero's Davina (Namous al Shahania x Ero's Romantique, bred by the van Duijvenbode Family and owned by Danubius Arabians from Romania. Third in this class with 92.19 points was the big moving D Methayel (S Sheimaz x D Judi) bred and owned by Dubai Stud from the UAE. Because this was the only yearling filly class, the top three were automatically named Gold, Silver and Bronze.

Two classes of two years old fillies were up next. Winner with 92 points was Miah Martina Ashiraf (Ajman Moniscione x Sophie MCA) – bred by Emanuela Scaramella

and owned by Azez Arabians from Israel. Later this filly took the bronze medal. Second in this class with 91.75 points was Lylia EA (Shanghai EA x Lyria EA) – bred by Equus Arabians and owned by Tamarix Arabian Stud from Spain. At the third position with 91.31 points was the exotic Bahia UB (ASE Farhan x Shah Maana) – bred and owned by L'Ecurie Suisse from Swinterzland.

The second group of 2-years old fillies was won with 92.81 points by Jheselle al Shiraa (RFI Farid x Eralda) - bred and owned by Al Shiraa Stables from Abu Dhabi. Second in this class with 91.50 points was the pretty big moving filly Maraya Samjad (AJ Elaf x AJ Estrella) – bred and owned by Samjad Stud from Lebanon.

The show continued with the class of three years old fillies. Scoring 92.69 points was Iralda al Shiraa (FA el Rasheem x Eralda) - bred and owned by Al Shiraa Stables from Abu Dhabi. This filly got the silver medal in the final junior championships. Second in this class was her stable mate Irvinna al Shiraa (AJ Elaf x Nesj el Miss Kanzi) who later took the Gold medal in the final championships.

Next to go was a beautiful class of 4-6 years old mares. Winner of the class with 92.31 points was the beautiful Agmal Sharah (Sharahm x Melina el Madan), scoring multiple 20s on type and movement. This mare, bred and owned by Agmal Arabians was later awarded with the Best European female award and the award for the best French female. Second in this class with 92 points was the very pretty Estrella Meia Lua (HP Ali x Ellara el Ludjin) — bred by Haras Meia Lua and owned by Al Jood stud from Qatar.

The second class of 4-6 years old mares was won by the amazing big moving mare D Jamayel (FA el Rasheem x D Jareen) – bred by Dubai Arabian Horse Stud and owned by Al Shiraa Stables from Abu Dhabi. This mare scored multiple 20s on type, head and neck and full 20s for movement! She received not only the Gold medal in the senior mare championships, but was also named Best in show female and got awarded with the best movement female trophy. Second in this class with 91.75 points was Asayel al Zaid (Equator x Jouwaida MP) bred and owned by Al Zayed Stud from Saudi Arabia.

Two classes of 7 years and older mares where up next. The

first group had a lot of absents and only one mare showed. The big moving La Dolce Dea (Wadee al Shaqab x Col Carisma) - bred by Antonio Fontana and owned by Al Shiraa Stables from Abu Dhabi scored a total of 92.13 points. The second group of mares had only three participants. Winner with a massive score of 93.06 points was the ultra pretty Elizia Alfabia (ZT Magnofantasy x Alfabia Gaia) – byred by Alfabia Stud and owned by Samjad Stud from Lebanon. This mare scored multiple 20s on type and movement and was later named bronze medal senior champion mare. Second in this class was the big moving mare D Jawaher (FA el Rasheem x D Noor) - bred and owned by Dubai Arabian Horse stud from the UAE. This mare also scored 20's on type and movement and had an overall score of 92.75 points. Later in the championships, she beat Elizia, by becoming the Silver medal champion.

The show continued with the yearling colts. Only two participants in this class so both colts got automatically Gold and silver champion. Winner of the class with 92.25 points was the very showy AB Nader (Cyclon OS x Nefertarji) b red by Albabtain and owned by Abhaa Arabians from Kuwait. Second in this class with 90.31

points was BP Elezar Vittorio (Exagon OS x Sultana AM) bred and owned by Al Mohamadia Stud from Saudi Arabia.

Next to go was the class of the two years old colts. As there was no class of three years old colts, the first three places horses automatically got the Gold, Silver and Bronze medal. Winner of the class with 91.50 points was Adeeb Samjad (Shanghai EA x A Touch of Magic) bred and owned by Samjad Stud from Kuwait. Second with 90 points was Maxiaan (LF Aarmaan Vittorio x Marni) bred by Sax Arabians and owned by Xie Renzhau from China. Third with 89.56 points was Monroe (LF Aarmaan Vittorio x Monira) bred by Sax Arabians and owned by Xie Renzhau from China.

The show continued with the 4-6 years old stallions. Winner with 92.56 points and multiple 20s on type, head and movement was the big moving Mahasin de Cartherey (Radjah de Cartherey x Wadi'ha de Cartherey) bred and owned by the Catherey Arabians from France. Later in the championships, this stallion took the Silver medal. He also received the trophy for the Best European male. Second in this class with 92.13 points was the beautiful big moving

Rasheem Albidayer (FA el Rasheem x Manal Albidayer) – bred by Albidayer Stud and owned by SH Iberic Arabians from France. This stallion with his soft friendly eyes took the bronze medal and was also name Best French male.

The class of senior stallions aged 7 years and older had only one participant but it is fair to say, this one stall the show! With his extreme movement, attitude and class, he scored a total 93.63 points with straight 20s on type and movement! D Kaheel (FA el Rasheem x D Muwadah) – bred by Dubai Arabian Horse stud and owned by Abhaa Arabians from Italy, came saw and conquered and took not only the Gold medal in the final championships, but also took the Best movement male trophy and the Best in show male title!

With this last class, the International C show and the Arabian Horse Festival in Vichy came to an end. A well organized show, with great people, a great atmosphere and a super facility for the horses. Really one to put back on the calendar next year!
