A fter a rainy summer, the 21st of August was a very hot and Sunny day! A perfect day to go to the annual 'paardenhappening Zottegem', an event were all horse breeds were shown, complete with all kinds of activities, demonstrations, shops and nice food stands. The event always draws hundreds of people to the fair ground and is a great way to promote the Arabian horse breed. The previous year's this show was organized as a non-ecaho show but this year it made an upgrade to National Ecaho C-show. Perfectly organized by Paardenhappening Zottechem, in co-operation with Emmely Schelpe.

69 horses were entered, including some part-bred classes. Judges for these show were Mrs. Helen van Nes, Mr. Tony van der Auwera, Mr. Richard Pihlstrom and mr. Josy Everaers. The show started with the yearling fillies. Three entrees and all participated. Winner of this class was Juvita (WH Justice x Evita N) – bred and owned by G. Noël. 2nd in class was Scarletta-D (Eternity ibn Navaronne x Caprisa) – bred and owned by Dion Arabians.

Next up was a big class of yearling colts. Won easily by SMA Magic One (Psytadel x Majidah bint Pacha) – bred by SMA Arabians and owned by Al Zobair Stud, scoring the first 20 of the day for head and neck. Later on the day he also claimed the golden medal with the junior colts championships and was also announced 'best in show' at the end of the day!

On the 2nd place in this class with 4.5 points less was Mulsanne D (Ajman Moniscione x Classic Junah-D) – bred and owned by the combination Dion & B&B Arabians.

A beautiful group of 2 years old fillies were next to go. Won by the gorgeous Brazilian bred Stephana W (RFI Maktub x Spartana Ludfour) — bred by Agropecuaria Ludfour and owned by Al Jalawiyah Stud. This beautiful girl later conquered the golden medal in the junior female championships.

On the 2nd place was Rectors Carmelita (QR Marc x Catinia de Saile) – bred and owned by Rector Arabians. She later achieved the bronze medal in the junior female championship.

Next to go were the 2 years old colts, won by Kyano-L (Jhulyuss ibn Eternity x Nycha bint Shahir D) – bred and owned by Mr. Locquet. 2nd in class was Moby J (QR Marc x Mauhiba J) – bred and owned by Christine Jamar.

The 3 years old colts and fillies both had only one participant. The fillies won by Nebraska (Vivaldi Rach x Necessa) — bred and owned by DB Arabians. The colts won by D'Justin (WH Justice x ESM Kendalina) — bred and owned by the van den Nieuwenborg family, this colt later got a silver medal in the junior colts championships.

After these junior classes it was time for the part-breds, with only three participants.

On it went with the purebreds filly foals. Class winner and therefore also overall gold medal winner

was AM Angel Star (Glorius Apal x AM Psyada) – bred and owned by V & S D hondt D.

2nd placed was Antaya Samarah (Jhulyuss ibn Eternity-D x Sana el Fabel Ramses) – bred and owned by Anne Standaert.

The purebred colt foals also had, like the filly foals, only two participants. The winner who also claimed the silver medal was MR Ataullah (Dakota x Catinia de Saile) – bred and owned by Galle-Wynant.

2nd and Bronze medal winner was Magnums Dynamite-S (MCA Magnum Gold x AHC Sweet Dreams) – bred by Sixtus Arabians and owned by Burkas Vananroye.

After the lunch break it was time for the ridden classes, followed by the 4-6 years old mares. A nice class won by the big moving mare Suzanna (Ekstern Splendida). who scored 2x20for movement! Suzanna is bred and owned by DB Arabians. Later in the senior championships, this mare took the silver medal.

2nd in this class was El Khydyaraah AO (Om el Extreem x Nesj el Kyara) – bred and owned by Arabian Obsession.

After these girls it was time to see the boys! A big group of 4-6 years old stallions, won by Dakota (Psytadel x Ibara) — bred by Noel-Verhofstadt and owned by Galle-Lanckman. This stallion is also the sire of

the silver medal winner with the colt foals, MR Ataullah. Later in the championships, this stallion took the silver medal as well.

2nd in this class was Abbar (Salar x Abba) — bred by Bialka stud and owned by Suzanne Pattyn. In the senior male championships, this stallion later claimed the bronze medal.

Up next were the 7 years and older girls, with only two participans. Winner was Danuta (Ekstern x Dahna II) — bred by Eleonore Hussmann and owned by Christine Jamar. On the 2nd place and later bronze medal winner was A Emaan IL (Kamsin Rodan x TZG Westona) — bred by Achrak Arabians and owned by Arabian Obsession.

The 7 years and older stallions also had just two participans. Won Psymply Red DD (Psytadel x Monogrammed Lady) bred by Dirk Dejonckheere and owned by Phebe Serroels. He later achieved the gold medal in the senior male championships. On the 2nd place was Gloriet Psyche (Padrons Psyche x Glorietta) bred Stanislan Redestowicz and owned by Joyce Rosowski.

The show continued with the amateur classes. Winner of the amateur filly class was Estola Estopa (Psytadel x RL Masala Estopa) – bred and owned by Swatam Arabians and presented by Jesse Swaenepoel.

were up next, only one competitor so won by DM Black Taalin (Ex-Taladinn x Black Lady Tarifa) – bred by Deleau Magali and presented by his owner Hans Nussbaum.

Next up was the amateur class for senior mares, won by Sarai bint Navaronne-D (Ansata Sinan x Navaronne P) — bred and owned by Dion Arabians and presented by Evelyne van Loock. She also claimed the Amateur best in show title later on the day.

The last amateur class of the day was the amateur class for geldings. Won by AM Picasso (Shamael Apal x AM Rih Zara) – bred by Silverstar ATC and presented by the owner Lies vandenbussche.

The show continued with the always exciting liberty class. Convinsely won by SMS Pakloan (Warandes Pasha x Ainhoa Pashlika) – bred by B Smits and owned by Yentl Heremans.

Last to go was the gelding classes. The only class were offered price money by the class sponsor Anais el Arab. The lucky winner was Al Zafir de Croissart (Psytadel x Malia D) — Bred and owned by Focke-Dumont.

With this the first edition of the Ecaho c-show in Zottegem ended. A well organized show with a great atmosphere and a great addition to the Ecaho show calendar!
