**T**he fourth edition of the Al Khaleidiah International Arabian Horse Festival took place from 23rd to 28th January in Tebrek, 60 km from Riyadh in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The venue for the Festival was the private facility of HRH Prince Khaled bin Sultan bin Abdul Aziz Al Saud, Al Khaleidiah Farm.

The atmosphere for the festival was cheerful yet tranquil, owing to the relaxed setting of Al Khaleidiah Farm, an oasis in the Saudi Arabian desert. The organization was impeccable, however to give you a better idea of the event I would like to give you some numbers: approximately 300 people started working several weeks preparing to welcome everyone to the already existing venues and to prepare for the 250 visiting horses competing in the show, the 66 horses for auction, the 30 horses participating in the endurance race and the 101 thoroughbreds taking part in the gallop races. Furthermore, 60 people had been invited from all over the world and were hosted in hotels, including the Judges and the staff of the different disciplines mentioned above. The hospitality of His Royal Highness was incredible: there was a shuttle from the airport and the hotels and, for every single need, a person was on hand and available.

The awards

The Festival took place over six days. The first day was dedicated to endurance: a tough 120 km CEI\*\* race in the surrounding desert. The organization of this race was very well taken care of, especially all veterinary matters: the health and care of the horses were the order of the day.

This race was organized by the Vice President of the Equestrian Federation of Saudi Arabia: H.H. Prince Abdullah Bin Fahd Bin Abdullah Al Saud. Mrs. Melanie Mannix (also organizer of the Al Khalediah Arabian Horse Festival), Mr. Khaled Alotaibi and Dr. Anas Hassan were also members of the Committee organizing the race.

The veterinary committee consisted of Dr. Yasein Muatamary, Dr. Zabid Rafiq, Dr. Ibrahim Alhassan, Dr. Asharaf Aloula, Dr. Jjanapura Thejasui, Dr. Abdulrahman Altalafba, Dr. Khaled Alyabhan, Dr. Tawfiq Almehsen and Dr. Omar Alibrahim. The team of 10 Judges was formed by Mr. Mohammed Aladhab, Mr. Khaled Alotaibi, Mr. Ronny Vosch, Mr. Sundar Rethinavel, Mr. Ahmed Badawi, Mr. Abdulkareim Alnasri, Mr. Bassam Alanizi, Mr. Hamdan Albamdan, Mr. Ibrahim Asiri and Mr. Mohammed Allhaidan. All committees included representatives of many different countries from around the globe.

The competitors left the start line on 23rd January at 06.00. The climate was mild and just perfect for such a tough race. The first competitor crossed the finish line at 14.07: Mr. Hamo Al Shamree on Fredoms Grace; the second place was taken by Mr. Abdul Arhman Al Huoas on Shaibum, while third place went to Mr. Fahad M Alwasedae on Sheikh Albadu.

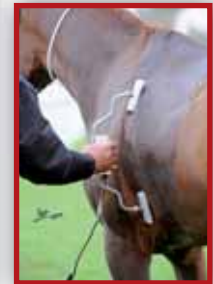

# AUCTION

The next day was an important appointment for the Saudi breeders: the Al Khalediah Auction. This was important for many reasons. Firstly, it was spectacular for us as guests to attend and see, secondly it was a great opportunity for big and small breeders to purchase a horse from a Stud like Al Khalediah, and thirdly it was an opportunity to see and understand the different 'crossings' and production of the stallions at Stud. Of the 66 horses available for auction, 26 were sold for a total of 1.547,000 Saudi Riyal. The best offer was of 300,000 Riyal for a beautiful 2008 filly "ALYAA AL KHALEDIAH" (F. Shamaal X Authentic Dahna). Our congratulations to the new owner, and to all those who had the luck and the opportunity to take home one of the beautiful horses from Al Khalediah.
