The beautiful capital city of Santiago hosted the Chilean National between May 8 and 9—featuring 79 animals from 35 different breeders. Always very poised and limber, the exuberant Chilean horses were judged by American Greg Gallún and Brazilians Leopoldo Coutinho and Rodrigo Forte.

All three of this year's Stallion Champions come from Brazilian breeding backgrounds. The Gold Stallion Champion, Jazeer De Wiek, was voted in a unanimous decision. He is the son of Polish Debowiec by Monogramm, currently one of the sires of the Dubai Arabian Horse Stud. The Champion's mother is Brazilian Josephine El Jamaal, daughter of Ali Jamaal, bred at Haras Meia Lua. Jazeer De Wiek was the Brazilian National Colt in 2011 and the Champion Young Stallion in 2012. Last year, he was imported to Chile by the Haras Panquehue, owned by the Bulnes family, and the Haras Águas Claras, owned by the Chadwick family. The Silver Champion was the stallion HSM Atharid, son of Brazilian Dayran HCF, bred at Haras Capim Fino. He is son of Legacy of Fame, the American, Brazilian and Argentinean National

Champion. The Bronze Champion, HP Al Fayed, was bred by the Bulnes at Haras Panquehue and is the son of Brazilian Johann El Jamaal.

The Mares Championships are already known in Chilean rings. They earned successive Chilean National awards in previous years. The Gold Champion mare was Brahma, daughter of LC Farid — one of the country's most important sires — and Bey Shah sire line. She is out of Brazilian Sweet Softness by USA National Champion Almaden. Brahma is owned by Haras Panquehue and Quitralman. The Silver Champion was LL Shaella, daughter of Italian Shael Dream Desert, which is also the father of the famous mare of the same name, FT Shaella, currently at the Dubai Arabian Stud. LL Shaella was bred at Haras La Laguna by Alfredo Hasbún. The Bronze Champion was HP Polaca by Hafati Express, grandson of Bey Shah through RSD Dark Victory from Haras Panquehue.

The Young Stallion Championship, which the Chileans call Jr. Colt (24 to 48 months), went to HSA Malik, son

of the American National Champion OFW Magic Wan by Marwan Al Shaqab. The mother of the Gold Champion Malik, CA Magnum Psycsta, was imported from the U.S. by Haras Santa Ana, owned by Elizabeth Kassis. She is the granddaughter of Magnum Psyche out of Magnums Crown BF. HP Kamar, son of LC Farid, was the Silver Champion by Diego Benavente's Haras Del Mar; and the Bronze Champion was LL Mag Beau, son of LL Maglud out of ZT Magnanimous, from Zichy Thissen. LL Mag Beau was bred at Haras La Laguna by Alfredo Hasbún.

The Young Mares Championship (Jr. Filly) was one of the most contested categories of the event. The Gold Champion by unanimous decision was Brazilian Lumiar Ethna, imported by the Haras Panquehue and Haras Águas Claras. Crowned the Brazilian National Jr. Filly Champion in 2013, Ethna is the daughter of RFI Maktub, known in Europe as the father of RFI Farid. Ethna's mother is Evening Star TGS, one of the daughters of the Brazilian National Champion, Lumiar Amadeus, currently at the Halsdon Arabian in England. The Silver Champion was LL Sweet Mag, daughter of LL Maglud by ZT Magnanimous, from Haras La Laguna, and the Bronze Championship went to HSA Maja by OFW Magic Wan, from Carlos Barros' Hacienda Chada.

In Chile, the Jr. Colts are divided into two Championships: Minor Colt (6 to 12 months) and Major Colt (12 to 24 months). The Major Colt Gold Champion was HSA Ektor, son of American Abrakadabra RH by Rol Intensity, grandson of Polish Cytosk through Out of Cyte. Ektor's mother is Ppoetry, daughter of Providence by Echo Magnifico, U.S. National Champion in 1992. Ektor's full sister, HSA Rafaela, was the Minor Filly Silver Champion at same show. Both were bred at Elizabeth Kassis' Haras Santa Ana. The Major

Colt Silver Champion was HP Mabrouk, grandson of LC Farid through HP Shakir, from the Bulnes family's Haras Panquehue. The Bronze Champion was HHC Chadid, son of Brazilian Plus Aladdin, grandson of Aladdin by Laddin BA, from Carlos Barros' Hacienda Chada.

The Minor Colt Gold Champion was HSM Vincent, son of Van Gogh by Magnum Chall HVP. HSM Vincent was bred at Jorge Selume's Haras Santa Marta. The Silver Champion was HP Eman, son of HP Shael from Haras Panquehue by Bulnes Family, and the Bronze Champion was HL Maxximus, son of Brazilian Shamis El Madan by Shael Dream Desert, from the Duch Matthei family's Haras Lonco.

Among the Jr. Fillies, the Major Filly Gold Champion was LL My Kart, from Alfredo Hasbún's Haras La Laguna. She is the daughter of LL Khartoum by Echo Magnifico out of LL May Dream, daughter of Brazilian Bey Shadow, Bey Shah's grandson crowned the Chilean, Argentinean and Brazilian National Champion. The Major Filly Silver Champion was HSM Miss Bianca, daughter of American Sirajj UB out of Marajj, from Jorge Selume's Haras Santa Marta, and the Bronze Champion was HS Farah, daughter of HP Shahmaan out of LC Farid, from Pedro Gonzales' Haras Shangrila.

The Minor Filly Gold Championship went to Amalia, daughter of HP Shael in HP Ativa out of LC Farid, from the Chadwick family's Haras Águas Claras; The Silver Champion was HSA Rafaela, from Haras Santa Ana – previously mentioned in the Major Colt Championship –; and the Bronze Champion was El Palenque Monserrat, daughter of HP Dyrab, son of the Chilean National Champion HP Emir, from Menes sire line. The Bronze Champion was bred by Juan Pablo Monteiro's Haras El Palenque. □

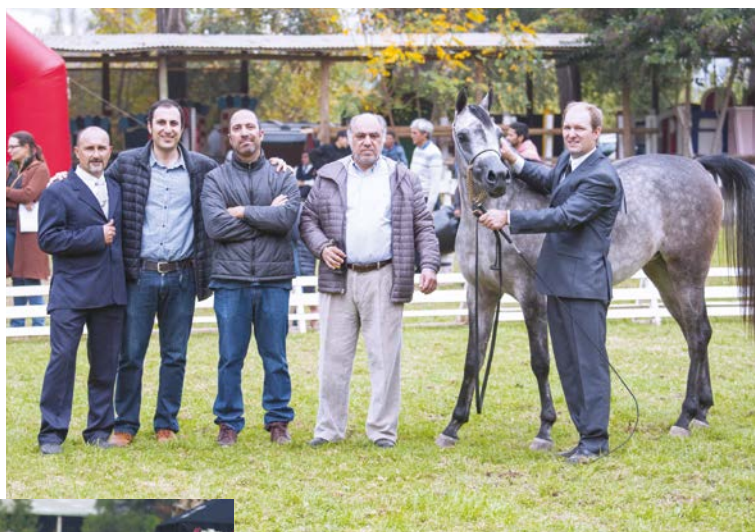
