Best in show was the bay 4 year old stallion SF Verify by Marwan Al Shaqab and Veronica GA. The stallion was bred in the US and is now proudly owned by Beduin Arabians.

The international show was judged by Sylvie Eberhardt from Germany, Renata Schibler from Switzerland, Peter Upton and Nick Arnold from UK and Marek Trela from Poland.

Even if the number of entries were a bit low the quality of the horses were high. Entries came from Scandinavia, Poland, Germany, Austria, Belgium, South Africa and US.

Saturday night a nice party was held in a very good and relaxed atmosphere. A mechanical bull was for everybody to try and this gave much fun and laughter!

The Championships were as always exciting to watch.

The fillies champion ship was a great victory for the Polish breeder Chrcynno Palace stud as they had both the Gold and Silver Champion filly. Gold winner was the 3 year old Chaos Persefona by the Laheeb son Poganin and Ceres and Silver winner was the well moving Ekstern daughter Psyche Kreuza.

Bronze winner was also a beautiful filly Al Princess Aliha, by WH Justice out of the famous black mare Al Aliha, bred and owned by the Al Hambra Stud in Austria. Both silver and bronze fillies were 2 year old.



The colts had the extremely charming and showy colt yearling Aragon OS as Gold champion. This bay colt is by WH Justice and Al Shanina by Al Lahab and bred and owned Gestuet Osterhof in Germany.

Silver champion was a flashy chestnut Ali Moniscione by Psytadel out of Alianna Moniscione. Owned by Giancarlo Buzzi from Italy and on lease to the Malorney family from Germany. Very interestingly bred this colt with Padron Psyche close on both sire and dam.

Bronze Champion was the handsome dark grey colt Bernhard by Rohara Baccara out of Tosca bred and owned by Annika Lindhöjd from Sweden.

Gold Champion mare was the Swedish owned Rohara Rebecca by Magnum Psyche out of Somewhere Mi Love by Padron.. This ultra feminine mare was bred in the US and now owned by Naples Arabians. Rohara Rebecca also was the highest scoring horse at the show with 93 points!

To the delight of the Danish audience the mare Warina by Warin out Maritza was Silver champion.

Trained and shown by her owner Millington Andersen this beautiful mare was also Best Danish Bred horse at the show.

The extremely showy and charismatic black mare Al Aliha was bronze Champion, she is by DWD Tabasco and Gahari an interesting cross of Polish, Spanish and Egyptian lines. This mare is bred and owned by Al Hambra Arabians from Austria.

Finally Sunday afternoon also the dressage competition was finished after a lot of beautiful performances and the title of Danish Champion was finally Camilla Christensen with TA Madir by Halim Witez was the champion.

With a total of around 140 starts it was clear to see that riding Arabians has a bright future in Denmark
