

Graham Smith, 2016 Breeders World Cup Judge, Australia: "I consider the Breeders World Cup to be one of the most glamorous and highest quality shows in the world – it is unique in its concept and attracts only the best horses. As a judge, you want to see depth of quality in the classes of a show. At the Vegas show, I wasn't disappointed - there was tremendous depth in every class. The World Cup is regarded as one of the most prestigious events on the international show calendar and it rightly deserves that accolade. It is a show I will long remember and feel honoured and grateful to have judged. I believe it is a must visit show for the serious Arabian breeder."


