his year, the spectacular show in Menton, is celebrating its 20th birthday.

A show loved by many Arabian horse lovers all over the world and were everyone is looking forward to ever since it was organized by Mrs. Christine Chazel, for the first time, back in 1991. Thanks to her devotion and enthusiasm, this Arabian Horse Championships is still one of the prestigious shows in Europe.

Judges for the this edition of the Menton show were: Mr. Manfred Hain and Willi Poth from Germany, Dr. Nasr Marei from Egypt, Dr. Marek Trela from Poland and mrs. Marie-Louise van Wijk from South Africa. Ringmaster of

the event was mr. Philip Jenkins from the United Kingdom.

153 horses were entered. The beautifully designed catalogue was reading the who is who in the Arabian horse world. Former world champions, leading sires and champion producing mares combined with promising youngsters. A real treat for all spectators.

Because of its 20th anniversary, the organizers of the show also wrote down inside the catalogue who were the winners of the very first show, held in 1991. A good time to reflect on 20 years of horse breeding and to see what was the hype back then and what the Arabian show horse has become to-



day.

The show started on Saturday afternoon, which meant that there was plenty of time to catch up with fellow breeders and horse lovers or to enjoy the beach, go to the center of Menton or the nearby situated Monaco.

The day started with the junior fillies, sponsored by Al Khalediah Stables

The first class to go was the one year old fillies. A big class sponsored by Anne Heiloo from Austria. Beautiful fillies sired by champion sires entered the beautifully decorated show arena. Two fillies stood out from the rest and were awarded with the first and second price. Class winner was Maysaa al Khalediah (Marquis x Hazy al Khalediah) with 90.70 points, showing for Al Khalediah stables from Saudi Arabia. Second placed with 90.40 points was Marc's Star (QR Marc x Magnums Madonna) for owner Paul Gheysens from Belgium. 3rd in this class was La Perla (Glorius Apal x Chrystal Elygance) with 89.50 points, showing for James & Chrystel Swaenepoel from Belgium.

Winner of the best head in this class, sponsored by Al Jassimya Farm from Saudi Arabia, was classwinner Maysaa al Khalediah.

The second class to go was another group of yearling fillies, sponsored by Al Nayfat Stud from Saudi Arabia. High quality young ladies with high hopes for the future paraded in the arena. A big win was for Ghazalat al Khalediah (PA Gazsi x Argentinna SS) with two 20's for type and another 20 for head and neck. She gained a total of 93.30 points, showing for owner Al Khalediah stables of Saudi Arabia. Second placed filly was the extremely beautiful AJ Sawahi (Marwan al Shaqab x Siberia SA) for owner Ajman Stud of the UAE. Scoring a total of 92.80 points with also 2 times 20 for type and another 20 for head and neck.

A 3rd place was for Rose al Shaqab (Marwan al Shaqab x QR Annah Ferrari) owned by Al Shaqab Stud, member of the Qatar Foundation, Qatar. She scored a total of 91.40 points.

Best head trophy, sponsored by Al Mohamedia stud from Saudi Arabia, was for AJ Sawahi.

On it went with the two year old fillies sponsored by Mystica Arabians, Australia. Winner of this class was Mirwanah Kalliste (Marwan al Shaqab x Nakubaya Kossack) with 91.70 points, owned by Kalliste Arabians from France. Second place in this class was for the beautiful Armonia Moniscione (Ajman Moniscione x Armonia Aktszn) with 91.40 points for owner Giancarlo Buzzi from Italy.

3rd in this class was the big moving Scarlett OS (WH Justice x Shak Lavanda) with 91.30 points for owner Verena Heiss from Austria.

Winner of the best head trophy in this class, sponsored by Al Jalawiyah Stud from Saudi Arabia, was for Armonia Moniscione.

Another big class of beautiful 2 year old fillies, sponsored by

Al Shaqab Stud from Qatar, was up next. Won with 91.50 points by the big moving AV Dalia (Ajman Moniscione x AV Dolimha), owned by Arabian Valley Stud from Italy and on lease to Dubai Stud, UAE.

Second place was for Meqbiltat Athbah (QR Marc x Martinique J) with 91.30 points for owner Athbah Stud from Saudi Arabia.

3rd with the exact same points was Jumanah-D (WH Justice x Classic Junah-D) for owner Dion Arabians, Belgium. She also won the best head trophy, sponsored by Al Jassimya Farm from Qatar.

The next class was the one of the 3 year old fillies, sponsored by Albidayer Stud from the UAE. Won by the amazing filly Felicia RLC (Shael Dream Desert x Camelia K) for owner Ajman Stud from the UAE. She scored a total of 92.60 points with 2x 20 for type and another 20 for head and neck.

2nd in class with a total of 92.30 points was Al Princess Aliha (WH Justice x Al Aliha), owned by Al Hambra Arabians from Austria. 3rd position was for the incredible moving mare Almasa (Monarcos DD x Jawaahir). Owned by the Royal Stables of Jordan and scoring 92.20 points with a well deserved 20 for movement.

The best head trophy, sponsored by Vila dos Pinheiros Stud, Brazil and Tutto Arabi, Italy, went to Felicia RLC.

The day ended with an outstanding senior mare class of 8 years and older. All of very high quality, sponsored by Joseph Arabians from France. (the whole senior mare section sponsored by Athbah Stud from Saudi Arabia) Winner of this class was Magora (Gazal al Shaqab x Margotka) for owner Al Khalediah Stables from Saudi Arabia. She scored a total of 94 points with the maximum score of 4x20 for type and two more 20's for head and neck!

2nd in the class with 92.63 points (1x20 for type) was Simeon Sehavi (Asfour x Simeon Sheba) for owner Dubai Stud of the UAE.

3rd in the class with 92.38 points was the Brazilian bred Baleena (CG Balih el Jamaal x NNL Prolifilia) for owner Tripodi Arabians from Italy.

Best head trophy of the class, sponsored by Al Jassimya Stud from Saudi Arabia, was for Magora.

After the show, there was a special gala dinner to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the show. To thank everybody who was closely involved with the show over the past 20 years, received a special 'thank you' award. With Mr. Santorro being one of the first judges of Menton and to Frank Boetto, who never missed the show since it started 20 years ago.

The food was delicious, the music great and everyone was having a great time!

The next day, the show started at 9:30am with the one year old colts. A class sponsored by Dion Arabians from Belgium, with Athbah stud being the main sponsor of the junior colts.

A lot of visitors were present to watch this last day of the show and it started off good!

Class winner was the amazing colt Van Gogh AM (Magnum Psyche x Ynazia HCF) for owner Al Mohamadia stud from Saudi Arabia. This young fellow scored 4x20 points on type and another 2x20 for head and neck, scoring a total of 92.60 points! What a great way to start the day! 2nd in this class was the exotic Emerald J (QR Marc x Emandoria), owned by Al Jalawiyah Stud from Saudi Arabia. Scoring a 20 for type and 2x20 on head and neck with a total of 91.90 points.

3rd position was for Hasman GYO (Ajman Moniscione x Habiba Rey) for owner Allevamento Gyo from Italy, scoring 2x20 for type with a total of 91.60 points, receiving also the best head trophy from sponsors Vila dos Pinheiros Stud, Brazil and Tutto Arabi, Italy.

The next class was for the 2 year old colts, sponsored by Al Shaqab stud from Qatar.

Winner of this class was the very beautiful Espressivo (QR Marc x Emocja), owned by Paul Gheysens from Belgium. This young boy scored 4x20 for type and 2x 20 for movement, earning the high total of 93.60 points!

Runner up was Ssharaz (Besson Carol x Ssharjah), owned by HH Shk Mohammed Bin Khalifa al Thani from Qatar, scoring a total of 92 points with a 20 for type.

3rd place was for the beautiful Makisa Adaggio (Vervaldee x Maradisha), owned by Rebecca Mc Evoy from the United Kingdom. This big boy scored a total of 91.70 points.

Winner of the best head, sponsored by Al Jalawiyah Stud from Saudi Arabia, was Espressivo!

The show continued with the class of 3 year old colts, sponsored by Dubai Arabian Horse stud from the UAE. Convincingly won by the amazing Khalil al Shaqab (Marwan al Shaqab x OFW Mishaahl) with a total of 94.40 points! Scoring the maximum of 5x20 points on type with another 20 for movement, making his owner Al Shaqab Stud from Qatar very happy!

2nd in the class with 12 points difference was the black colt Ibn Jameelat al Khalediah (Moutaz al Biwaibiya x Jameelat al Khalediah) of Al Khalediah stables from Saudi Arabia, scoring a total of 92 points.

3rd in the class with 90.70 points was the impressive, big moving Fluke (WH Justice x Guendalina). Owned by Roncaccio from Italy.

Winner of the best head in this class, sponsored by Al Mohamedia Stud of Saudi Arabia, was Khalil al Shaqab.

The last class before the break was the one of the 8 years and older stallions, sponsored by Lutetia Arabians from France. (Mainsponsor of the senior stallions was Al Khalediah stables from Saudi Arabia) An exciting class with two former World (res) champions! Class winner was former world champion Nijem ibn Eternity VI (Eternity ibn Navaronne D x Naravwa), owned by Al Khalediah Stables from Saudi Arabia. Nijem received a total of 94.10 points with 3x20 for type and four more 20's for movement!

2nd in the class was former reserve world champion LVA



Judges and Officials

Maximus (Espano Estopa x Challon Salana) owned by Athbah Stud from Saudi Arabia. Maximus scored a total of 94 points with 4x20 for type, 2x 20 for head and neck and another 20 for movement.

3rd in the class with 11.5 points difference was EK Dehor (Psytadel x April Carol), owned by Massimo Menfredi from Italy.

The best head trophy, sponsored by Al Mohamadia Stud from Saudi Arabia, was for Nijem ibn Eternity.

After the lunch break, the show continued with maybe two of the most exciting classes of the whole show. Starting with the 4-7 year old mares, sponsored by Rabab Stud from Egypt.

Class winner was the stunnig CR Jasmeenah (WH Justice x Fforget me not), owned by Al Jassimya farm from Qatar. With 3x20 for type, 2 more 20's for head and neck and also a 20 for movement, this lady scored a total of 93.90 points. 2nd place was for Maraysia (Marwan al Shaqab x Aysia), owned by Al Khalediah Stables from Saudi Arabia, scoring a total of 93.40 points, what was the exact number of points also given to the 3rd placed mare; Badawieh AA (Laheeb x Bahiha) from Ajman Stud, UAE.

The two mares then had to return to the arena where Mrs. Van wijk (Judge E) from South Africa had to decide who would be the best of both, resulting in Maraysia being the better one.

Both mares had scored 4x20 for type, with Badawieh AA

scoring another 20 for head and neck.

Best head trophy, sponsored by Al Mohamadia Stud from Saudi Arabia, was awarded to CR Jasmeenah.

The last class of the day was a very spectacular class were old competitors met again. Former world champions Marquis (Marwan al Shaqab x Rohara Magnifica) and Marajj (Marwan al Shaqab x RGA Kouress) both had their own big fan club.

The big winner and also receiving the highest score of the entire show (95.20 points) was Marquis for owner Al Khalediah Stables of Saudi Arabia. The stallion scored the maximum points of 5x20 for both type, as well as for head and neck with also scoring two more 20's for movement! The last points maybe thanks to his handler Michael Byatt, who was able to make some samba-dancing moves while presenting the stallion, entertaining everyone watching.

A good second place was for the incredible Marajj for his owner Albidayer stud from the UAE. Also Marajj won the maximum points of 5x20 for type and 3x20 for head and neck as well as a 20 for movement. He received a total of 94.70 points.

A 3rd place with 16 points less was for Al Fakhir (Mahadin x Al Estrella) of Al Hamra Arabians from Austria. Best head trophy was awarded to Marquis. Sponsored by Al Jassimya farm of Qatar.

Time to go to the championships! All champions were announced by rider Hassan and his horse, who were carrying



the flag of the winning country.

The championships started with the junior females, sponsored by Al Zobair stud from the UAE.

Gold medal winner: Ghazalat al Khalediah, owned by Al Khalediah Farm from Saudi Arabia.

Silver medal winner: Mirwanah Kallista, owned by Kallista Arabians from France.

Bronze medal winner: Maysaa al Khalediah, owned by Al Khalediah Farm from Saudi Arabia.

Next were the senior female championships, sponsored by Al Khaled farm from the Saudi Arabia.

Gold medal winner: CR Jasmeenah, owned by Al Jassimya farm from Qatar.

Silver medal winner: Magora, owned by Al Khalediah Farm from Saudi Arabia.

Bronze medal winner: Simeon Sehavi, owned by Dubai Stud from the UAE.

Next were the junior male championships, sponsored by Ajman Stud from the UAE.

Gold medal winner: Khalil al Shaqab, owned by Al Shaqab Stud from Qatar.

Silver medal winner: Van Gogh AM, owned by Al Moha-





madia stud from Saudi Arabia.

Bronze medal winner: Espressivo, owned by Knocke Arabians from Belgium.

Last championships of the day was for the senior males, sponsored by Dubai international Arabian Horse championships from the UAE. A championship with a line-up of three former (reserve) world champions! Divining the quality always present at this show!

Gold medal winner: Marquis, owned by Al Khalediah Farm from Saudi Arabia.

Silver medal winner: Marajj, owned by Albidayer stud from the UAE.

Bronze medal winner: LVA Maximus, owned by Athbah Stud from Saudi Arabia.

There were also some other trophy's to be presented.

Menton 20th anniversary trophy, sponsored by Alnayfat stud from Saudi Arabia was won by: Marquis.

Best sire in the show trophy, sponsored by Athbah Stud from Saudi Arabia was given to: Marwan al Shaqab.

Trophée Espoir, sponsored by Al Khalediah farm from Saudi Arabia was won by: Journalia de Nautiac.

Arabe from France was won by: Mirwanah Kalliste.

Coup de Coeur trophy, sponsored by Dubai Arabian Horse stud from UAE was given to: SW Juliette.

Best in show female trophy, sponsored by Al Shaqab Stud from Qatar was won by: CR Jasmeenah.


Best in show male trophy, sponsored by Al Shaqab Stud from Qatar was won by: Marquis.






