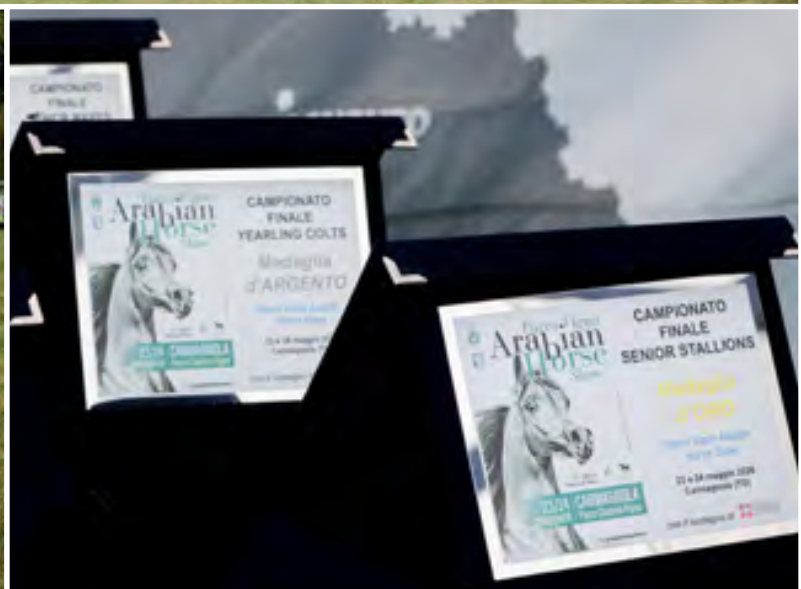

On Saturday 23 and Sunday 24 May, some thirty kilometres from Turin, we were in Carmagnola, the splendid setting for the third edition of the national Class C show dedicated to Arabian horses.

Carmagnola, a town that developed over the centuries under the influence of the Marquises of Saluzzo and the House of Savoy, is today an important agricultural centre, famous above all for the cultivation of peppers, the star attraction of the renowned National Pepper Fair. The historic centre is also of great interest, the true heart of the town, where you'll find the ancient 13th-century castle – now the Town Hall – the 14th-century Church

of Sant'Agostino and prestigious historic buildings such as Palazzo Lomellini, Casa Cavassa and the Casa delle Meridiane. The town's cultural heritage is further enriched by the Civic Museum of Natural History, the Synagogue and the Civic Naval Museum.

But let's turn to the event... or rather, the events. You'll see why later on.

We have reached the third edition of the "Parco Vigna Arabian Horse Show 2026", now an unmissable event for enthusiasts and industry professionals alike, which this year once again succeeded in combining sport,

livestock promotion and entertainment, strengthening the bond between the local area, the world of the Arabian thoroughbred and quality breeding. The event was organised by the Municipality of Carmagnola in close collaboration with the Regional Breeders' Association of Piedmont (A.R.A. Piemonte), with the support of the Regional Council of Piedmont and under the official affiliation of ANICA and ECAHO. As for the National Show competition – ECAHO C category – on Saturday 23 May, starting at 9.30 am, the competitions for one- and two-year-old foals got underway. In the afternoon, from 3.00 pm, the programme continued with the categories reserved for three-year-old foals, mares and mounted displays. To ensure the event ran smoothly in accordance with industry regulations, Mrs Barbara Raso and veterinary surgeon Dr Alice Visconti were appointed to the disciplinary committee, whilst the role of Ring Master was entrusted to veterinary surgeon Dr Gianpaolo Teobaldelli.

The show was further enhanced by the presence of an international judging panel comprising Anna Zak (Poland), Patryk Bukowczan (France), Mohamed Ahmed Al Ali (United Arab Emirates) and Fausto Scanzi (Italy). Also on the ground, acting as a probation judge, was Mrs Francesca Romana Pompeo, to whom we extend our best wishes for a long and brilliant career. There was a huge turnout, helped by a splendid, almost summery day that allowed those present to follow every stage of the conformation competition up close. Saturday saw the horses qualify for the final championship, which took place on Sunday from 2.00 pm. On Sunday morning, among the side events, there was an interesting promotional presentation dedicated to the Piedmontese cattle breed, organised in collaboration with Anaborapi and Coalvi. In attendance at the event were the director of the Regional Breeders' Association, Mr Gianfranco Drigo, the Councillor for Agriculture Roberto Gerbino, the Mayor Ivana Gaveglio and, of course, the patron and creator of the event, Mr Daniele Giaccone. The eagerly awaited championship took place in an atmosphere of great sportsmanship and fairness.

In the Yearling Fillies category, the gold medal was won by "JASMINE MONISCIONE" from the Buzzi Giancarlo Farm; the silver medal went to "DAHLIA EL AZIZ", owned by Hamie Hamie, and the bronze to "BEL AMIE" from the La Chiesetta Farm.

Among the male yearlings, only two medals were awarded: Gold to "ISHAAN EL AZIZ" from Giampaolo Gubbiotti's Woody Arabian and Silver to "MAGIC GIULIANO" from Fontanella Magic

Arabians.

In the 2- and 3-year-old fillies category, the Gold medal went to "SS BELLA HADID" from Stigler Stud; Silver to "HH JAWAHER" from Hami Hami and Bronze to "HILAH HACNAIBAC" from Rota Alessandro. For the 2- and 3-year-old Colts, Gold went to "MEKONG MONISCIONE" from the Buzzi Giancarlo stud, Silver to "ADELCHI" from Società Agricola Badia di Cartabia and Bronze to "CLINTON LA DAMA" owned by Caterina Adelfio. There were three classes dedicated to Mares and, unanimously, the Gold medal was awarded to "EUPHORIKA" by Sparapan Amadio, who also won the special prize for Best Type and the highest score for Conformation. Silver went to "NAKSATRA" owned by Trifoglio Gioia and Bronze to "ANNA DZ" owned by Seyadeh Zayed. The weekend concluded with the announcement of the Best Stallion: once again, Hamie Hamie took Gold with "IRONFIST SCAH". Silver medal for "PICCADILLY" by Scalvini Maria Angiola, whilst the Bronze went to "SAHIL BY KAHIL" by Giuseppe Battisti.

Our thanks also go to the President of the Regional Council, Mr Davide Nicco, and to Roberto Gerbino, who worked closely with Daniele Giaccone to ensure the success of this third edition. A special thank you to Mayor Ivana Gaveglio who, at the close of the event, challenged the farmers to turn out in even greater numbers for the upcoming fourth international edition.
