

## GERMAN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

he last weekend of September is always reserved for the prestigious All Nations Cup in Aachen, traditionally starting with the German Nationals to warm up the crowd! Since last year, the horses participating at the German Nationals were also judged in liberty, which means the horses can show their movement free in trot and galop without handler inside the arena. They are then at a later moment judged in hand on movement in walk and trot, type, head and neck, body and legs. Judges for this event were Mrs. Eberhardt, Mrs. Hennekes van Nes and Mrs. Stojanowska. All judges communicated together and together they decided for the points per criteria.

Unfortunately there were not so many horses present. The junior filly championships, aged 1-2 years, was won with 50.75 points by Aurelia JMA (HL el Ganador x Aurora JMA), bred by Josef Murawski and owned by Hanaya Arabian Stud. Second with 49.50 points and Silver was IS Eufemia (Ascot DD x IS Elanda), bred and owned by Ismer Stud. Third with 46.50 points and Bronze medal winner was

her paternal sister, IS Well Done (Ascot DD x IS Wenetzia), also bred and owned by Ismer Stud.

The colt class aged 1-3 years old had the big moving IS Wincent (EBT Bel Subayan x IS Wenetzia), bred and owned by Gestut Ismer, as clear winner with 57 points. Later he also took the Gold medal unanimously. Second with 50.50 points was Hamzah al Batra (Ali Nour el Dahab x PA Haniya bint el Nil), bred and owned by Al Batra Stud. Third with 49.25 points was HA Excellent (Exagon OS x Mayrse OS), bred by Beluga Arabians and owned by Hanaya Arabians. Later in the championships, HA Excellent took revenge by taking the silver medal, leaving the Bronze to Hamzah.

There were two classes of senior mares. The first class had mares aged 4-7 years old. Winner with 49.75 points was IS Wia Appia (Poseidon OS x IS Wasabi), bred by Gestut Ismer and owned by Stephanie Hutarew. Later in the championships, she took the Bronze medal. Second with

45.50 points was WM Sasusah (Musab x Sarafine), bred and owned by Marbach stud.

The class of mares aged 8 years and older was won by the beautiful Aaida al Shaqab (Fadi al Shaqab x Aber al Shaqab), bred by Al Shaqab stud and owned by Hanaya Arabians, scoring a total of 56.75 points and winning the Gold medal in the final championships. Second with 54.75 points and silver medal champion was Nihal (Shanghai EA x GS Libera), bred by Gianfranco di Giovanni and owned by Hanaya Arabians.

The final class of the German nationals was the senior stallion class. Winner with 58 points, the highest score of the day, and the Gold medal, was for EKS Sirajj (Ibn Farid x EKS Bint Helwah), bred by Elkasun Arabians and owned by Hanaya Arabians. Second with 52.75 points was Bel Adeed (Shanghai EA x Bel Aresuh), bred by Beluga Arabians and owned by Ahayah Stud. Third with 50.75 points and Bronze medal champion was EBT Bel Subayan (FA el Rasheem x Maryse OS), bred by Beluga Arabians and owned by Gestut Ismer. In the final championships, Bel Subayan took revenge by winning the silver medal, leaving the bronze to Bel Adeed.

## CELEBRATING 40 YEARS OF MAGIC AT THE ALL NATIONS CUP

he last weekend of September is always reserved for the prestigious All Nations Cup in Aachen, and this year marked the 40th spectacular edition of this incredible event! The judging panel featured an esteemed group of experts, including Mr. Den Hartog, Mr. Ebrahim Faraj, Mr. Hegazy, Mrs. Hyde, Dr. Jung, Mr. Moschini, and Mrs. Schibler. Their expertise added to the excitement and grandeur of this unforgettable show!

This year, the show kicked off on Friday, with a full and exciting program ahead of us. Two impressive classes of yearling fillies opened the event. The first class was easily won by the breathtaking Durrat Albidayer (Jyar Meia Lua x A Vision MI), bred and owned by Albidayer Stud from the UAE. With several well-deserved 20s for type, she achieved a grand total of 92.17 points, setting the bar high for this top-level competition! Finishing second in the class with 90.96 points was the lovely Oona UMM (EKS Farajj x Zaina OS), bred and owned by Moell & Moell from Sweden.

The second class of yearling fillies featured two standout competitors, scoring neck-and-neck. Ultimately, it was the charismatic Royal Futurista (AJ Radman x HK Sweet Mustique), bred by Royal Arabians and owned by Al Wajba Stud from Qatar, who claimed the top spot with 92.08 points, earning multiple 20s for her stunning movement. Close behind, with only 0.16 points less, was the beautiful D Thaw (D Seraj x D Fannanah), bred and owned by Dubai Arabian Horse Stud from the UAE.

Later, in the final yearling championships, Durrat Albidayer took the Gold almost unanimously, while Royal Futurista earned Silver, and D Thaw secured the Bronze.

The yearling colts class, though featuring fewer entries, showcased exceptional quality, with the top three scoring over 91 points. The flashy AB Bandar (D Seraj x Priscilla OS), bred and owned by Abhaa Arabians, triumphed with 91.71 points. Close behind in second place with 91.54 points was KH Habs (Royal Asad x Dhma Alaainah), bred by Nasir Qasim and owned by Al Khawolid Stud. In third, scoring 91.17 points, was Asghar Akmal (Royal Asad x Akira AS), bred and owned by Akmal Stud. These three colts later took Gold, Silver, and Bronze in the championship in the same order.

The second group of yearling colts, though small, impressed the audience. The clear winner, with 91.83 points, was the big-moving colt Comoros (HL El Ganador x Cedora), bred and owned by Janow Podlaski from Poland, nearly achieving perfect 20s for his movement. Seif al Awamra (EKS Farajj x Sima AH), bred and owned by Al Awamra Stud, came in second with 90.96 points.

In the evening, a delightful reception organized by the VZAP (German Association) celebrating their 75th anniversary and everyone was invited to join this celebration! In addition the two studbook authorities, the Emirates Arabian Horse Society, UAE as well as the German Arab Horse Society signed a Memorandum of Understanding to consolidate and develop relations between them. They are looking forward to broad horizons of cooperation between the Parties with the aim of strengthen the bonds of joint cooperation in order to develop horse activities and events.

The next day continued with a strong group of two-year-old fillies, with the top three scoring well over 91 points. It was a tight competition, but with only a 0.04-point difference, the lovely D Aserah (AJ Nofan x D Shihanah), bred and owned by Dubai Arabian Horse Stud, won her class with 91.46 points. Coming in second, with 91.42 points, was the beautifully balanced Wildonara (Paris x Wildona), bred and owned by Michalow Stud from Poland. Third in this tough class was the elegant Om El Bela Magnifica (AJ Radman x Om El Beladeena), bred by Om El Arab and owned by Mr. Johns, scoring a total of 91.25 points.

The class of three-year-old fillies that followed was spectacular, with the top six scoring well over 91 points! The clear winner, with a grand total of 93 points, was the mesmerizing D Raseel (D Seraj x Elle Flamenca), bred and owned by Dubai Arabian Horse Stud. She received perfect 20s on type, several 20s on head and neck, and nearly perfect scores for movement. This filly truly embodies the ideal Arabian horse. Second in the class was another breathtaking beauty, Alawiya Al Sheikh (Shanghai EA x Algamra), bred and owned by Al Sheikh Stud, who earned



an impressive 92.42 points. Third in the class, scoring the same number of points as Bianca of Sinus but winning on type, was the stunning Reef AQ (Ghaith Al Zobair x Shikha Al Jbreen), bred by Abdulaziz Allowahiq and owned by Hanaya Arabian Stud from Switzerland.

In the final junior fillies' championships, these three fillies claimed the Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals in the same order.

The show continued with the class of two-year-old colts. The striking STA High Voltaj (Taj Raheem x Rose CME), bred by Marion Maschke and owned by Al Wajba Stud, took the lead with a total of 91.96 points. Second in this class, with 91.25 points, was the nicely moving Sahab Al Sheikh (D Meyzan x Salwa Albidayer), bred by Al Sheikh Stud and owned by Jennifer von Dahn. In the final championships, High Voltaj took the Bronze medal.

Next up was an exciting class featuring the big-moving young stallion Fajer AA (Shanghai EA x Fadwa AA), bred and owned by Ariela Arabians. He took the lead with a perfect score for movement and a total of 92.38 points. Later, in the championships, he claimed the Gold medal. Second in this class, with 91.58 points, was RD Rajan (Polidoro FC x RD Quanna), bred by Rae Dawn Arabians and owned by Hanaya Arabian Stud from Switzerland. He later took the Silver medal in the final championships.

After the lunch break, a large and spectacular class of senior mares aged 4–6 years entered the ring. The charismatic and well-balanced Echo Anastazja (Psyche Keret x Echo Aurora), bred and owned by Chrcynno Palace, captivated the crowd with her graceful movements, scoring 93.33 points, including a perfect score for movement and several 20s on type. Scoring high on all fronts, this mare was a crowd favorite and deservedly won the Bronze medal in the final championships, as well as the trophy for Best Female of the Show! Second in this class, with 92.67 points, was the typey D Judi (AJ Azzam x Elle Flamenca), bred and owned by Dubai Arabian Horse Stud.

Another large class of senior mares, this time aged 7–10 years, followed. It was a spectacular competition. The winner, with 93.08 points, was the stunning Wildona (Shanghai EA x Wilda), bred by Michalow Stud and owned

She scored almost perfect 20s for both type and movement. Later in the championships, Wildona earned the Silver medal. Second in this class, with 92.63 points, was Teejan Al Muawd (Alexxander x ADH Just Divine), bred by Al Muawd Stud and owned by Al Bakhet Stud from Saudi Arabia.

The final class of senior mares featured those aged 11 years and older, and what a class it was! The top three mares all scored above 92 points. The winner, with 92.92 points, was the incredible D Shahla (Marajj x FT Shaella), bred and owned by Dubai Arabian Horse Stud. With almost perfect 20s for type, she not only won the class but also took the Gold medal in the final senior mare championships. Second in this class, with 92.42 points, was the beautiful Wadad Zamani (Laheeb x Zena Al Buraq), bred by Osman Al Kasasi and owned by Hanaya Arabian Stud.

The show continued with the geldings, featuring two classes. The first group consisted of geldings aged 1-6 years. The winner, with 91.63 points and later crowned Gold medal champion, was Apollo KA (Equiborn KA x Aria Athena), bred by Knocke Arabians and owned by Budhens Stud from Belgium. In second place, with 91.33 points, was Agmal Psadik (AJ Mardan x Psyrella), bred and owned by Agmal Arabians.

The second group included geldings aged 7 years and older. The winner, with 91.46 points and later the Silver medal champion, was Jeryan Al Jassimya (WH Justice x Psierra), bred by Al Jassimya Farm and owned by Flaxman Arabians from Belgium. Second, with 91.29 points and later Bronze medal champion, was Pacheco KA (QR Marc x Phirouettes), bred by Knocke Arabians and also owned by Budhens Stud from Belgium.

The show then intensified with some high doses of testosterone, as three strong and stunning young stallions aged 4-6 years entered the arena. All were eligible to win, with each scoring over 92 points. The winner, with 92.75 points, was the charismatic and powerful-moving Pilatus PCF (Exxalt x Alexandria PCF), bred by Sam Peacemaker and owned by Amer Stud. Scoring multiple 20s for type and full 20s for movement, he not only took the lead but also

claimed the Silver medal in the final senior stallion championships. Second place, with 92.63 points, went to Pinito (EKS Alihandro x Piniata), bred by Janow Podlaski and owned by Flaxman Arabians, who also achieved the maximum score on movement.

The excitement continued with the next class, featuring a large group of senior stallions aged 7 years and older. The top three scored over 92 points. The winner, with 92.79 points, was the stunning and powerful-moving HL El Ganador (HP Shakir TE x Lonco Baby Maria), bred by the Duch Matthei family from Chile and owned by Hanaya Arabians Stud. This remarkable stallion later took the Gold medal in the final championships and was awarded the title of Best Male of the Show. Second, with 92 points, was Sinmar Albidayer (Shanghai EA x Salwa Albidayer), bred by Albidayer Stud and owned by Xin Wang from China. This marked the first time China participated in the All Nations Cup, and it was fantastic to witness their excitement when their stallion earned a well-deserved Bronze in the final senior stallion championships. Third, with the same score of 92 points but scoring lower on type, was the powerfulmoving Janow Podlaski-bred stallion, Paris (Kahil Al Shaqab x Palmeta), owned by Polia Arabians from Poland.

Before the show concluded, several special awards were presented. Best Sire of the Show was Shanghai EA. The Best Owner Nation and Best Breeder Nation awards both went to the United Arab Emirates. The Best European Participating Breeder was Knocke Arabians from Belgium. Best Participating Farm was Hanaya Arabian Stud from Switzerland.

What a show it was, and what a perfect way to celebrate the 40th anniversary of the All Nations Cup!

During the show, there were also ridden demonstrations in both dressage and working equitation. Outside, in the big arena, several ridden competitions took place, underlining the versatility of the Arabian horse. A nice number of horses were presented in dressage, showjumping, western riding and working equitation.

With a fantastic atmosphere, an enthusiastic crowd, and breathtaking horses, the All Nations Cup, even after 40 years, remains the place where magic comes alive. A huge compliment goes to the organizers of this spectacular event!

## 5. All Nations Cup - Straight Egyptians

ounded in 2015, organized by and based at the Arabian Horse Center - the State Stud of Kuwait since 2016, the All Nations Cup for Straight Egyptians has now landed in Aachen. It is agreed by the All Nations Cup Committee, the Arabian Horse Center, Kuwait as well as the German Arab Horse Society that the All Nations Cup - Straight Egyptians will have its home now in Aachen.

The judging panel was the same as the regular All Nations Cup classes and featured an esteemed group of experts, including Mr. Den Hartog, Mr. Ebrahim Faraj, Mr. Hegazy, Mrs. Hyde, Mr. Jung, Mr. Moschini, and Mrs. Schibler. Their expertise added to the excitement and grandeur of this unforgettable show!

With the All Nations Cup and the Straight Egyptian championships merged into one event, the show started this year already with classes on Friday. The first class was the one of the junior fillies aged 1-2 years old. Winner with 90.38 points was the pretty Nawara el Alya (Ansata Nile Echo x Noor al Rayyan), bred by El Alya stud and owned by Al Hamama Stud. Later in the championships, she scored the the silver medal. Second in this class with 90.21 points was Ghaya el Alya (Qamar al Zaman al Waab x Ghezlan al Waab), bred by El Alya stud and owned by Al Hamama Stud. A great victory for this farm as this filly took the Bronze in the final championships!

The next class was the class of junior fillies aged three years old. Winner and later Gold medal champion was the ultra typey Shams Huda Onallah (Naseem al Rashediah x Hyam-O), bred and owned by Hoda Onalla, scoring a total of 91.50 points. Second with 87.46 points was CA Harper (Mansour KS x Sharikah bint Sayyidah), bred and owned by Chess Arabians, who also won the award for best participating European farm.

As the SE classes were in between the ANC classes, the show continued on Saturday with the junior colts, aged 1-2 years old. Winner of the class with 90.58 points and later Gold medal champion in the final junior SE colt championships was DG Hayel (Naseem al Rashediah x DG Haya), bred and owned by DG Arabians. Second with 90.21 points and later Silver medal champion was AB Feras (Adeeb al Hilaliya x AB Farah), bred and owned by Abhaa Arabians. Third and Bronze medal champion with 89.13 points was Naeem al Baydaa (Naseem al Rashediah x Narges al Baydaa), bred and owned by Al Baydaa farm from Egypt.

Two gorgeous senior mares aged 4-6 years old were up next. Scoring a great score if 92.42 points was the ultra typey and big moving D Ameereyyah (Asfoor al Waab x Royal Emira), bred and owned by Dubai Arabian horse stud from the UAE. Second with 90.42 points was the beautiful Alghalia al Ward (Ezz al Danat x Sarreh Ezzain), bred by Al Terkeet and owned by Abdullatif al Shaya. Later in the championships, Alghalia took revenge and claimed the Bronze medal, leaving Ameereyyah out of the medals.

The second class of senior mares were aged 7-10 years old. Two beautiful mares were presented. Scoring almost perfect 20's on type, was the charismatic Nadrah al Nasser (Shagran al Nasser x Jamila al Nasser), bred and owned by Al Nasser stud. With a total of 92.75 points, she not only won her class, but also claimed the Gold medal. Second in this class was Mesteka al Bawady (Moezz al Baydaa x Mona al Bawady), bred and owned by Al Bawady stud, scoring a total of 90.58 points.

The last class of senior mares was the one of 11 years and older. Scoring an amazing total of 92.79 points, was D Afaf (Frasera Mashar x ESA Arieanna Express), bred and owned by Dubai Arabian Stud, scoring almost full 20's in type, taking the class win and also claiming the silver medal and the award for best female of the show as well as an award for the best type female! Second with 91.46 points was OEJ Mon Amour (Al Ayal AA x Moniet KA), bred by Daly Joseph and owned by Zmiro Arabians.

The show continued with the last class of Straight Egyptian horses, the class of stallion aged 4 years and older. Winner with 91.29 points and Gold medal champion was PSE Al Rakhan (Royal Colours x PSE Mistrez), bred by Prestige Arabians, who won the European best breeder award with this victory, and owned by Dubai Arabian Horse stud. Rakhan also won the award for the best male of the show and best type male award. Second in the class with 90.50 points and Silver medal champion was Azzim al Boraq (Maghribi x Jouihra al Boraq), bred and owned by Haras al Boraq.

Before the show concluded, several special awards were presented. Best Sire of the Show was Naseem al Rashediah. The Best Owner Nation and Best Breeder Nation awards both went to the Qatar. Best Participating Farm was Dubai Arabian Horse stud from the UAE.

It was great to see the Straight Egyptians being represented at the All Nations Cup in Aachen and we are looking forward to see more participants next year!


