German National Championship

As every year, the German nationals is in the same weekend as the All Nations Cup, Aachen. Judges for this class were Mrs Helen Hennekens-van Nes, Mr Josy Everars and Dr Marek Trela.

There were not many participants this year. The yearling fillies had four participants and the win went with 89 points to IS Emini (Ascot DD x IS Emina) – bred and owned by Gestut Ismer. Later this filly won the silver medal. Second in this class with 88.33 points was Psyara bin Lamandro (Lamandro x Psyna al Justice) – bred and owned by Sax Arabians.

The two years old fillies had again four participants. Winner with 88.33 points was Bel Mayleen (AJ Mardan x Maryse OS) – bred and owned by Beluga Arabians. Later in the junior championships she took the bronze medal. Second with 87.33 points was Bourhani Sorweeda (Wadee al Shaqab x Sotika) – bred and owned by Bourhani Arabians.

With the three years old fillies, there was won clear winner. With 90 points, Elisha bint Marshan (Marshan x Essdreaama) not only won her class but also the Gold medal. A great success for her breeder and owner of Sax Arabians! Second with 87.33 points was Aurora JMA (Emerald J x Alianah) – bred and owned by Josef Murawski.

A nice group of yearling colts was up next. The type Essandro (Lamandro x Espannja al Justice) from Sax Arabians, won his class with 89 points and later won the bronze medal. Second in the class with 88.33 points was CP Djuliano (Shanghai EA x Djasira Princess Psytadel) – bred and owned by Frank Spönle and ZG Polte. Later in the championships, CP Djuliano came back strong and took the gold medal.

Unfortunately only two participants in the class of colts aged two and three years old. Winner with 88 points and later Silver medal winner was CBA Mattheus (Fadi al Shaqab x Maharani CF) – bred and owned by Bouché Arabians. Second with 86.67 points was BS Kadjar (BS Karanji x Sherruka al Roban) from Sprave Arabians.

The senior mare classes were divided into two classes. The class of mares aged 4-7 years was won by the pretty Malala (Mesban ibn Kubinec x Marni) – bred and owned by Sax Arabians. She scored a total of 89.67 points. Later in the championships she took the silver medal. Second

with 86.33 points and later bronze medal champion was DG Schamila (Sabib x HK Kamria) – bred by Dieter Gerbaulet and owned by KF Arabians.

Only two mares entered the 8 years and older mare class. Winner with 90.33 points was the beautiful GE Maysoun (GR Amaretto x GR Maimun) – bred and owned by Gestut Eulenthal. She also took the gold medal in the championships. Second with 85.33 points was Little Miss (BS Specific x Miss Dior) – bred and owned by the Blutbacher family.

The stallion class had more participants. The 4-7 years old class was won with 91.33 points by the big moving Elshaan (Marshan x Elena bint Europe) – bred and owned by Sax Arabians. Later in the senior stallion championships, he won the gold medal unanimously. Second in this class with 88.33 points was Camar Qbinec (Arian Shah x Qair un Nissa) – bred and owned by Camelot Arabians. Later in the championships, he took the the Bronze medal, leaving the silver to his sire, Arian Shah (Jonathan el Ludjin x LM Alisha) – who won the class of stallions aged 8 years and older. He is bred by La Movida Arabians and owned by Camelot Arabians and scored a total of 89 points. A second place with 88 points was for the big moving BS Mashallah (QR Marc x FS Mona Lisa) – bred by Sprave Arabians and owned by Zenith Arabians.

Last but not least were the foal classes. Always a delight to see. Only three participants were present. Unanimous winner was Bourhani Bellavera (RFI Farid x Bourhani Fardissima) – bred and owned by Bouhrani Arabians. Second was Aziza Aarmaani (LF Aarmaan Vittorio x Monira bint Amir) – bred and owned by Sax Arabians. At the third place was IS En Voque (Ascot DD x IS Epalla) – bred and owned by Gestut Ismer.

It was a pity that not more horses were present in this National Championship. Unfortunately it is seen at many national shows. The small breeders are not showing their horses anymore and the Arabian horse world is more and more about the “big guys”. Which is really a pity seen the high quality horses still living in Germany. Hopefully some will come up with a plan to make the breeders enthusiastic again and then maybe next year we would have those full classes again! ☐

All Nations Cup

For the 37th time, the All Nations Cup Aachen took place in the last weekend of September. This event is seen as the most prestigious Arabian horse show in the world and attracts owners and breeders from all around the globe.

Judges for this edition were Mrs. Marianne Tengstedt, Dr. Gianmarco Aragno, Mr. Klaus Beste, Mr. William Oppen, Mr. George Zbyszewski and Mr. Lucas Gozdziński.

This year the All Nations Cup was spread over only two days. The Saturday started three strong classes of yearling fillies. The first two scoring over 91 points! Winner with 91.54 points was HDM Bella Ciao (AJ Azzam x Rabafa al Hawajer) – bred by Haras del Mar from Spain and owned by Ajman Stud from the UAE. This filly also scored the first twenties of the day on both type and head. Later in the yearling filly championships, HDM Bella Ciao took the Gold medal! Second in the class of yearling fillies was Taibah al Bariq (RFI Farid x Vision of Marwan AA), scoring a total of 91.25 points for breeder Ariella Arabians Farm and owner Al Bariq Stud.

The second group of yearling fillies had a very strong top three, with all three fillies scoring over 91 points with the winner of this class, FAM Donatella (Dominic M x D Crystal Moon), scoring a massive 92.04 points! Later in the championships, this filly took the silver medal! What a great success for her breeder Frederico Jose Morales and her owner, Al Jawaher Arabian Horse Stud. The second place in this strong class was with 91.21 points for Royal Asselah (Royal Asad x R Arabella) – bred by Karen and Eric England and owned by Nesma Stud. At the third position with 91.08 points we would find the lovely Amirata (EKS Alihandro x Alhasa) – bred and owned by Janow Podlaski stud.

The last group of yearling fillies was won with 91.33 points by Lubna al Firas (Marajj x SS Lady Diana) – bred and owned by Firas Fuad. Second in this class with 91.08 points was the typy Adwaa al Arab (Emerald J x HK Jojo RLC) – bred and owned by Ali bin Mohammed, scoring multiple 20's on head. Later in the championships, this filly turned out to be the favourite of the judges and received the Bronze medal! The show continued with two classes of yearling colts. The first one being won with ease by the striking Jassid KA (QR Marc x Joumalia de Nautiac) – bred and owned by Knocke Arabians. This lovely colt scored a total of 92.17 points. At the second place with 91.88 points we found the typy ELR Ferdinand (Morion x Fabrinna) – bred by Anais el Arab and owned by Al Faisaly Stud. Later in the championships, ELR Ferdinand came out as the better one and took the Silver medal! Leaving the bronze for Jassid KA!

In the second class of yearling colts, the win was for BV Samjad (RFI Farid x Usbuaia BV) – bred by Bautista and owned by Samjad Stud, scoring 91.13 points. Second in this class with 91.08 points was the pretty Dosar Al Sayed (Validoro x Delights Diva RB) – bred and owned by Al Sayed Stud. In the championships, BV Samjad did not manage to convince the judges and was not able to take home a medal. Dosar al Sayed on the other hand, came back strong and took the Gold! What a great success for his breeder and owner from Saudi Arabia!

For the past couple of years, geldings are a welcome guest at the All Nations Cup with prize money offered by Albidayer Stud. Two classes of geldings were present. The first group being in the age of 1 to 5 years of age. Winner of this class with 91.58 points was LME Raphael (Emerald J x Lavinia's Design) – bred and owned by Armada Arabians. Second in this class with 90.88 points was Nabeel al Nasser (EKS Alihandro x Noof al Nasser) – bred by Al Nasser Stud and owned by Flaxman Arabians from Belgium.

The second class of geldings was won by EM Polar. A beautiful classic gelding sired by Lumiar Amadeus and out of Pepreszka. Bred by Bernard van de Putte and owned by Teresa van Nes. With his beautiful type and striking movement he scored a total of 91.58 points. The second place with 91.21 points was for Prince Psyche (Psyches first Ambassador x Bint Shatera R) – bred and owned by Ess Jay Arabians. The third place with 91.17 points went to El Emando (QR Marc x Emanda) – bred by Michalow Stud and owned by DG Arabians and leased by Stefanie Bovens.

In the championships, the Gold went, just like last year, to The Netherlands! EM Polar took the Gold, leaving the silver to LME Raphael and the bronze went to El Emando!

The show continued with the fillies aged two years old, divided over two classes. The first class won with 92.29 points by AJ Ghashmarah (FA el Rasheem x Bella Versace DH) – bred by Ajman Stud and owned by Al Waman Arabians. Second in this class with 92.13 points was D Nawasy (FA el Rasheem x D Nawal) – bred by Dubai Arabian Stud and owned by Danubius Arabians.

The second group of fillies was won with 92.60 points by the lovely Algamra (AJ Portofino x Ava Maryia) – bred by Dr Hodsman and owned by Al Sheikh Stud. This filly scored almost full twenties on type and head. Later in the championships, she took the Gold medal! Second in this class with 92.10 points was Encarina (Ascot DD x Eneria) – bred and owned by Janow Podlaski Stud.

The class of colts aged two years old had eight participants,

all scoring far over the 90 points. Winner with 92.55 points was the pretty EKS Farajj (IBN Farid x EKS Bint Helwah) – bred by Elkasun Arabians and owned by Al Khasbab Stud. Later in the championships, this special colt took the Gold medal. Second in this class with 91.90 points was Sinmar Albidayer (Shanghai EA x Salwa al Bidayer) – bred and owned by Albidayer Stud.

The show continued with the class of the 3 years old fillies. Some gorgeous fillies were presented and even the 9th placed filly still scored over the 91 points! Winner with 92.13 points was the exotic LR Era de Excalibur (Excalibur EA x Expected Beauty RP) – bred by Las Rosas and owned by AlSayed Stud. In the junior championships, this gorgeous junior filly took the Silver medal. Second in the class with 91.96 points was the big moving filly, Parantella (Kabil al Shaqab x Palanga) – bred and owned by Michalow stud. At the third place with 91.92 points we saw the ultra exotic A Vision MI (Allegiance MI x Always Valentine MI) – bred by Mularwa Arabians and owned by Albidayer Stud. This filly took the Bronze medal in the final championships.

The last class of the Saturday was the colts aged three years old. Winner with 92.75 points was the gorgeous HL El Ganador (HP Shakir TE x Lonco Bay Maria) – bred by Matthei Duch and owned by Hanaya Stud. This colt scored almost unanimous 20's for type and neck and in the championships he took the silver medal. Second in this class with 91.92 points was Saif Albidayer (Excalibur EA x Nesj el Markhisa) – bred and owned by Albidayer Stud. At the third place with 91.79 points was D Ibn Rasheem (FA El Rasheem x Angelicah) – bred by Dubai Arabian Horse Stud and owned by Iosif Mertyris. Later in the championships, this colt took the bronze medal.

The Sunday was reserved for the senior classes, starting with the senior mares. The 4–6 years old mares was split in to two classes. Already in the first class, the scores went out of the roof! Even the last in the class still scored over the 91 points! Winner with the massive score of 93.33 was Wildona (Shanghai EA x Wilda) – bred by Michalow Stud and owned by Al Sheikh Stud. This mare scored almost perfect 20's on type and movement. In the championships, this Beauty took the Bronze medal. Second in this class with 92.58 points was Prunella (Abyad AA x Pradera) – bred by Janow Podlaski and owned by Surweco Stud.

The second group of 4–6 years old mares was won with again a massive score! This time 93.83 with perfect twenties for movement and almost all twenties for type and head. Also (Kabil al Shaqab x Alameda) was bred by Janow Podlaski and owned by Ajman Stud. Later in the championships, this mare took the Silver! Also also won the award of the highest points winner female 2019. Second in this class with 92.71 points was Anawa (Abyad AA x Anarchia) – bred by Janow Podlaski and owned by Armada Arabians.

The class of mares aged 7–10 years old was won by the timeless beauty Maisa al Nasser (Sinan al Rayyan x Zenubia al Nasser) – bred and owned by Al Nasser Stud. This mare scored 20's on type, head and movement and took a total of 93.38 points. Just overall a very high quality mare that claimed the gold medal in the final championships. Maisa also won the award for the Best Straight Egyptian bred horse 2019. The big moving Wieza Mocy (QR Marc x Wieza Marzen) – bred and owned by Michalow Stud, scored 92.71 points and took the second place.

The last class of mares was for the mares aged 11 years and older. They do get more beautiful by age! Wow! The top three of this class all scored over the 93 points! Winner with 93.70 points with straight 20's on movement was the beautiful 15 years old Ekspulsja (Gazal al Shaqab x Elandra) – bred by Michalow Stud and owned by Halsdon Arabians. Second with 93.30 points was the timeless Pepita (Ekstern x Pepesza) – bred by Janow Podlaski and owned by Akmal Stud. At the third place with still 93.05 points was SA Minerva (Royal Colours x Cicilla) – bred by Angelo Scipioni and owned by Al Nasser Stud.

After these spectacular mare classes, it was time for the senior boys! The class of stallions aged 4–6 years old was won by the big moving Calateon (Vitorio TO x Calatea) – bred by Mark Arabians and owned by Halsdon Arabians. With straight 20's for movement, this stallion scored a total of 92.71 points! Later, this stallion also won the award for the Best European private bred and owned horse 2019. At the second place with 92.25 points was Aali Farid (RFI Farid x AJ Deena) – bred by Ajman Stud and owned by Ali Abdulla al Alaali.

The next class was the one of stallions aged 7–10 years. The beautiful ultra typy Shadi al Khalediah (F Shamaal x Layan al Khalediah) – bred by Al Khalediah stables and owned by Raza Allahdadi, won his class with 93.10 points, scoring perfect 20's for movement. In the final championships, he took the silver medal. Second on this class with 92.90 points and bronze medal winner was the big moving Atius O (Shahim al Nakeeb x Atia Cone) – bred by Oone and owned by Jas Stud, scoring also perfect twenties for movement.

The last class was the one of stallions aged 11 years and older. The king of the ring, Shanghai EA (WH Justice x Salymah EA) – bred by Equus Arabians and owned by Ajman Stud, scored straight twenties on type and head and got a total of 93.21 points! Later in the championships, he took the gold medal unanimously. He was also awarded with the award for the highest points winner males 2019! Second in this class with 92.71 points was Lissar (Gazal al Shaqab x Larissa) – bred by Michalow Stud and owned by Barakah Arabians. With these last championships, the All Nations Cup Aachen 2019 edition, came to an end. A wonderful weekend with incredible horses, great people and as always, a fantastic atmosphere. □
