Best Breeder – Al Shaqab Stud

The time is passing by quickly, we have just ended another European show season, full of emotions, changes, new appearances, some good byes, changing of leaders, ups and downs. But still when the emotional season is turning into the new one we all meet again in one place – one of most famous, most romantic and one of the oldest for the European culture – gathering and uniting Arabian horse lovers from all over the world – Paris.

Fridays in Paris belongs to ladies. And so on Friday morning junior females divided into two groups started the show. In section A there was probably no surprise with the winner – AJ Sawahi by Marwan Al Shaqab out of Brazilian bred mare Siberia was not only one of most cheered (also by professional cheer leaders on the tribunes) filly of the show, she was also unquestionable winner of the section. Big congratulations to Sh Ammar Bin Humaid Al Nuaimi, Crowned Prince of Ajman. This is the great pride to be both breeder and owner of such wonderful creature who

confirmed her quality at the end of the show winning the trophy of World Junior Champion Filly – unanimously! Silver Champion of 2011 World Champions became AJ Sawahi's class mate – Ghazalat Al Khalediah, placed in the section 1A as second. As Bronze Medal awarded the new purchase of Athbah Stud ended her first show season ever – Shirin by Aisha, a WH Justice daughter bred in Italy and now competing for Saudi Arabia, winner of section B. Stud manager – Ward Bemong couldn't hide his satisfaction after the championships finished as its not very usual that 2 years old filly never show trained before finishes her season with several show trophies including bronze at the most important one. In the class she has been placed just in front of long time international awards winner – Alma Al Tiglio by Ajman Moniscione, also born in Italy.

Senior mares competition is always one of most pleasant time of every high quality show. Its a moment when the lovely mares, showy but also feminine, show and breeding experienced ones again confirm their most important

values. This time again Paris was a real goose bumps bringing spectacle. And the judges (Jay Costanti – US, Koenraad Detaillieur – BE, Peter Gamlin – GB, Silvia Garde-Ehlert – DE, Manfred Hain – DE, Deirdre Hyde – UAE, Richard Pihlström – FRA, Francesco Santoro – IT) had really tough job to do choosing the champions out from such equal level quality. The quality of judges panel work was though confirmed by choosing another unanimous Gold Medal winner – CR Jasmeenah by WH Justice, owned by Sh Jassim Bin Khalifa Al Thani from Qatar. His mare was high winner (558 points!) of the section A of mares, in front of Maraysia by Marwan Al Shaqab belonging to HRH Prince Khaled bin Sultan bin Abdul Aziz Al Saud who was watching her present at the VIP sector himself. Maraysia this time ended up just behind the podium of medal winners as Silver went to the winner of section B – the show veteran representing Al Khaliediah Farm – Magora by Gazal Al Shaqab. Pure Polish from her dam side Magora has beaten just for a hair in a mane the long line of 6 Polish bred and owned mares scored on the further places in this class

including 3 other Gazal Al Shaqab daughters. And it was not the end of trophies for Magora who also won the prizes for Best Mover (sponsored by Knocke Arabians) and Highest Scored Female (sponsored by Dubai Stud). Bronze medal was given to extremely beautiful Laheeb daughter – Badawieh AA from Ajman Stud, placed as third in the same section as CR Jasmeenah and Maraysia. Although lost the gold and silver, but Badawieh appeared again in the ring at the end of the day gaining well deserved trophy for Best Straight Egyptian Female sponsored by El Farida Stud. Its hard to deny that beautiful head is one of the most significant feature of Arabian horse nowadays. In every section of World Championships the Best Head Trophies were sponsored by several leaders of Arabian horse industry. Amongst females the proud winners were as follows: AJ Sawahi (sponsored by Arabian Horse Organisation from Saudi Arabia), Alma Al Tiglio (sponsored by Tutto Arabi & Salayel Arabians), CR Jasmeenah (sponsored by Al Mohammadia Stud) and Unic All JP (sponsored by Al Jalawiyah Farm).

The weekend has begun with exciting males competitions. We already got used to some great come backs to the arena while at World Championships and so also in 2011 there was a real red carpet of stars entering the ring both in juniors and in seniors. Section A of juniors was interesting comparison of three very different colts – Van Gogh AM sired by Magnum Psyche, Emerald J by QR Marc and MM Nevio by Lorenzo El Bri. First two mentioned ended up with the same total scores but the first place, as well as Bronze medal in finals went to Van Gogh owned by HRH Prince Abdullah Bin Fahd Al Saud. This colt is probably one of most exotic looking son of Magnum Psyche ever, being scored with 5 times "20" for type and head and neck that made him the class winner. Silver went to the colt placed as second in the section B – Shangai EA by WH Justice, bred and owned by Equus Arabians. Although he was probably the most cheered horse of the show he had to find his place behind Kahil Al Shaqab, very correct and masculine colt from Al Shaqab Stud, another successful son of Marwan Al Shaqab, winning the section with big difference in points, all

"twenties" across the boards for type and 7 others for head and neck and movements and the Gold Medal in junior colts almost unanimously. Kahil was also awarded by Salayel Arabians with the Highest Scored Male trophy and put his brick in the wall for Al Shaqab as the Best Breeder. For his prize giving ceremonies also dr Marek Trela, the director of Janów Podlaski State Stud of Poland was being invited as this most successful colt of 2011 World Championships his next breeding season will spend in Poland, for a prestigious start of his breeding career. The section A in senior males was a tough fight between the favourites for medal places. Several times awarded in Menton and Middle East, wonderful mover and exceptional chestnut Marwan Al Shaqab son – Marquis CAHR from Al Khalediah for the long time has been awaiting his prize from Paris. And so he finally did it in great style winning section A of senior stallions and finally – Gold Medal Champion of World Championships. Its just a pity that this time we haven't seen him with his usual couple on the lead – Michael Byatt who was this time supporting the horses from the side with

camera in his hand. In the same section Marquis had really strong competitor against – his paternal halfbrother QR Marc, former 2008 World Reserve Champion and Best Head winner from Knocke Arabians. And this year elected from the second place in the class he was looking his best and has repeated both awards as senior winning Silver medal and Best Head of his section. The Bronze went to another former World Championship trophy awarded stallion from the past – World Champion and Reserve as junior Marajj (again by Marwan Al Shaqab) from Albidayer Stud, with Scott Allman on the lead as in the past. Also all stallions and colts were awarded for their most beautiful faces. In males the trophies went to exotic: Van Gogh AM (sponsored by Arabian Horse Organisation of Saudi Arabia), Kahil Al Shaqab (sponsored by Al Nayfat Stud), QR Marc (sponsored by Al Jalawiyah Stud) and LVA Maximus (sponsored by Al Mohamadia Stud).

Paris show is not only prestigious for its value and great placement, it is also pleasant for competitors being awarded with prizes awarding both horses, breeders and...sires. The

unquestionable Best Sire of the Show (sponsored by Athbah Stud) became Marwan Al Shaqab with the largest number of offspring awarded with medals and Top Tens and he did it for the 5th following year - a great success of Al Shaqab Stud for breeding and ownership of living legend of such influence worldwide! The Trophy Espoir for the horse chosen by the sponsor (Al Khalediah Farm) was Shangai EA, bringing another joy to his widely gathered group of fans.

This year Salon du Cheval had its 40th anniversary so the spectators and participants (140 000 people present during the whole event!) had the opportunity to enjoy horses taking part in the equestrian activities for 9 days at Nord Villepinte until late night hours after the curtains of 31st Arabian Horse World Championships under the patronage of His Majesty Mohammed VI the King of Morocco had fallen down... Enjoy our photogallery from the event and see you in Paris next year!
