n july 2nd and 3rd 2011, the pastures of Flaxman Arabians were again open for the 7th Emerald Trophy. Like every year a good organized show with a beautiful outdoor arena and good facilities for the horses and visitors!

The show started on Saturday with the National show. Judges for this show were Mr. Jaroslav Lacina, mrs. Ann Green and mrs. Valdés y Colon de Carvajal Cristina. The classes of the National show were maybe not large, but the quality presented was very high! A big compliment to all the Belgium breeders!



First to go were the filly foals born in 2011. Winner of this class was MA Cherie Rose (Eternity ibn Navaronne x WH Marissa Rose) Bred & Owned by Dion Arabians.

Later in the foal championship, this filly became Gold Medal

Second in class was Nile LA (Ansata Nile Echo x Anasta) Bred & Owned by El Diva Arabians, Belgium.

The colt foals born in 2011 was won by El D'Jaffar AO (Muranas Jassher x Nesj el Kiyara) Bred and owned by Arabian Obsession. This little boy also scored a 20 for movement! Later in the foal championships, he took the silver medal.

2nd in this class was Azraff (Ansata Nile Echo x VD Ethni) Bred & Owned by Roger Schoefs. Later this colt took the Bronze medal in the foal championships.

Off it went with the Geldings. Again a small class, one by Alisayyah (FS Bengali x Scheherazade bint Nile) Bred and owned by Sophie Roevens. 2nd in this class was Prince al Maraam (Al Maraam x Princess last love) Bred and owned by Vissers Hippique.

The show continued with the yearling fillies. The class was won by Mahalya el Jamaal (Al Ayad x Mahity el Jamaal) Bred & Owned by Jean Mattens. She later took the Bronze medal in the final junior championships.

2nd in this class was Estola Estopa (Psytadel x RL Masala Estopa) Bred and owned by James Swaenepoel.

The big class of the 2 year old fillies was also of good quality. Won by Golden Sunset J (QR Marc x Gomera J) bred and owned by Christine Jamar. This filly later took the Silver medal in the final

junior filly championship. A second place was for her half sister Rectors Carmelita (QR Marc x Essita) Bred and owned by Hubert Rector.

The three year old fillies were up next. Again a class of very good quality. Won by Atheena (Kubinec x Estania el Shaklan) Bred and owned by Wenche Roefs. She later took the golden medal in the junior filly championships. Second in this class was Flaxmans Gabriela (FA Zain x Kapella T) bred by Flaxman Arabians and owned by Caroline Meyer.

Now it was time for the colts! Starting with the one year old boys. Won by Farhajj D (Ajman Moniscione x Farhanah bint Navaronne-D) bred and owned by Dion Arabians. Later in the colt championship, he took the silver medal. Second in this class

The show continued by a class of good quality two year old colts. Won by El Esquido (Om el Extreem x Nesj el Kiyara) bred and owned by Arabian Obsession.

Later this colt took the bronze medal in the junior colt championships.

A second place was for the big moving ASE Marajó (Marajj x Manilah) Bred and owned by Arabian Stud Europe and on lease to Boscarino/Leo from Italy. This interesting colt scored a well deserved 20 for movement!

Next up were the 3 year old colts. Again a group of high quality colts. A big win in this class was for D'Justin (Wh Justice x

The show continued with the 4-6 year old mares. Only one horse entered, bred and owned by Dion Arabians and won by Classic Junah-D (Authentic Dahman x HMT Princess Karima) She later took the bronze medal in the senior mare championships.

The class of the 7 years and older mare had only two mares entered. First in class was Danuta (Ekstern x Dahna II) Bred by Eleonore Hussmann and owned by Christine Jamar. She later

Later this colt won the Silver medal in the senior championships.

The class of stallions 7 years and older had only one competitor, won by Gloriet Psyche (Padrons Psyche x Glorietta) Bred by

The day started with the geldings won by Alisayyah (FS Bengali x Scheherazade bint Nile) bred and owned by Sophie Roevens. After it went on with a good class of yearlingcolts. Won by Pavorotto K.A. (QR Marc x Palanga) bred and owned by Knocke Arabians from Belgium. A second place was for AJ Complutum (Shael Dream Desert x RGA Kouress) Bred by Markelle Arabians and owned by Complutun Arabians from Spain.

Second in this class was Nashwah AA (Al Ayad x Insha Sha Latifa) bred and owned by Ariele Arabians and on lease to Ajman Stud of the UAE., scoring a 20 for typa and head & neck as well, earning a total of 91.33 points!

Off it went with the senior mares, 4-6 years old, won by Maraysia (Marwan al Shaqab x Aysia) bred by Hickmann in the USA and owned by Al Khalediah Stables from Saudi Arabia. This mare scored two 20's on type and another 20 for head and neck, earning a total of 91.33 points! Second in this class was BS

Silhouette (Al Hakim x Sivka) bred and owned by Thomas Mayer from Germany, scoring a 20 for movement!

The class of 7-15 year old mares had two mares with the exact same total of 92 points! Eventually won on type by Psynderella (Psytadel x VD Arna) bred by Vido Arabians and owned by Isabelle Evrard from Belgium, scoring a 20 on type! Second place was for Mirage (Premier x Medallela) bred and owned by the Maxwell family and owned by Marley Arabians from the UK. This lady definitely inheritaged the great movement of her sire, scoring the maximum score of 3x20 for movement and a remarkable 18 points for legs! A 3rd position was for former worldchampion Nesjla (Kais x Loasa) bred and owned by Nesj Arabians from Belgium, scoring a beautiful 20 for type!

This moving star scored the maximum of 3x20 for movement, earning a total of 91.33 points.

Second and third in class had the same total score of 90.67 points, but won on type by Najjar (Khidar x Narada DA) bred by J. van de Let and owned by Nadine Koo from The Netherlands., also scoring one 20 on movement. Runner up was Taymar (Kyro KA x Tamara) bred by Sax Arabians and owned by Charlotte Bowskill from the UK, who got a 20 for movement as well!

The class of 7-10 year old stallions was again of high quality. A big win was for Master Design GA (Versace x BEA Society Belle) bred by Warren Bentley and on lease to Gregor Aymar from Germany. This stallion scored two 20's on type and the perfect score of 3x20 for movement! Earning a total of 93 points! What a great success for this stallion!

Second in this class was Emenes (Emiratus B x Yasmena) bred by Jones and owned by Miles Buckley from the UK, scoring a 20 for type and two 20's for movement!
