n July 16-17, the yearly Egyptian Event Europe was being held at the Pietersheim Castle in Lanaken, Belgium. Judges for this event were Mrs. Irina Stigler from Russia, Mr. Jerzy Bialobok from Poland, mr. Rhodri Jones from the UK, Mr. Joseph Polo from the USA and Mrs. Silvia Garde Ehlert from Germany. The pointsystem for this show was divided in 6 parts. Type, head, neck & shoulder, body & topline, legs and movement.

The organizers did a fantastic job with the decoration of the arena and as well as some nice stands with horse attributes.

The show started at Saturday morning with the 3 year old colts. Winner of this class was the beautiful typey Al Ayal AA (Al Ayad x The Vision HG). Setting a very high standard for this show, starting with 2x20 for type and 3x20 for head, earning a total of 93 points! A great result for breeder and owner Ariela Arabians from Israel and leaser The Al Ayal leasing group from Germany. Later in the championship, this colt took the Gold Medal.

Second in this class was DHS Waheeb el Nil (Imperial Kamil x Wardshah) who is bred and owned by Dowdstown House Stud from the UK.

The high quality continued with the 2 years old colt class. Won by the gorgeous Frasera Dubai (Phaaros x Frasera Mashara). Bbred and owned by La Frasera stud in Italy, this colt scored a well deserved 20 on type. Later in the junior colt championship, he won the Silver medal.

2nd in the class was Sabeh al Salhiyah (Ansata Nile Echo x Mareeka). Bred and owned by Mohammed bin Laden from Saudi Arabia.

The yearling colts were next to go. Won by BK Latif (Nader

al Jamal x Latifah AA) from Germany. On the second place stood Pyramid el Sareei (Shagran al Nasser x Pyramid Laneya), bred and owned by Uwe Jurgen Wagner. Later in the championships, this colt convinced the judges to give him the Bronze medal.

The Non profi handlers class mares was up next. Won by Jesse Swaenepoel with the well known showchampion Ellissara (Laheeb x Ekscella). A non straight Egyptian mare, bred by Michalow stud and in the ownership of Athbah Stud from Saudi Arabia. Second in this class was Bettina von

Best head female was TF Shahraaz (Botswana x Shaamis Amira), bred by Talaria Farms and owned by GT Arabians from Sweden.

Best head male was Frasera Rames Shah (Shahil x Ansata Nefer Isis) Bred and owned by La Frasera, Italy.

After the most beautiful head classes, it was time for the 3 years old fillies. Won by Laian al Shaqab (Al Adeed al

Shaqab x Meseda al Shaqab), scoring a well deserved 20 for head. Bred and owned by Al Shaqab Stud from Qatar. This beautiful filly later took the Silver medal.

2nd place was for Noor Magidaa LDA (Mishaal HP x Illa Magidaa LDA). Bred by LD Arabians and owned by Hanaya Arabians from Switzerland.

Next to go was an amazing class of 2 year old fillies. High quality with the first 8 fillies scoring 90 points and above! Because of this good class, I will this time write down the first four fillies placed in this class. First and later Bronze

champion in the final championship, was Lutfina AA (Nader al Jamaal x Latifah AA) Full sister to BK Latif, who won the yearlingcolt class. Lutfina is bred by Ariela Arabians from Israel and is owned by Ajman Stud of the UAE. She scored a total of 93.86 points, earning 2x20 for type and 3x20 for head!

Second place in this strong class was for TF Shahraaz (Botswana x Shaamis Amira), scoring a total of 93.57. Earning one 20 for type, 3x20 for head and another 20 for movement. Bred by Talaria Farms from the USA and owned by GT Arabians from Sweden. Earlier this filly took the best

head medal and later on she convinced the judges to call her in as the gold medal winner of the junior fillies!

3rd in this class was the beautiful filly The Colour (True Colours x El L Aur Shahira Star). Bred and owned by Lauri Emiliano from Italy. This filly managed to score 92.57 points, earning 1x20 for type and 3x20 for head!

4th with 92.36 points, including 1x20 for head, was Maysuna Guasimo (Al Adeed al Shaqab x Najiba Guasimo). Bred by Frederico Fogarin and owned by Al Fala Stud from Saudi Arabia.



The 2nd and 3rd in class shared the same total of 93.14 points. Won by movement by Noof al Nasser (Ashal al Rayyan x Imperial Madanah). Bred and owned by Al Nasser Stud from Qatar. A 3rd place was for Hooria al Shaqab (Al Adeed al Shaqab x Hanouf al Shaqab). Bred and owned by Al Shaqab stud from Qatar.

4th in this amazing class was Suhalia al Saba (Thaqib al Nasser x Simeon Siboni) with 92.50 points. Bred and owned by G. North & L. Cordina from Australia.

In this class, even the mare placed at the 8th position, still

scored 91.43 points, defining the great quality always present at this show.

However, the public kept being spoiled, as the next class was unbelievable as well. Although not showing at her best, the incredible Dorar (Ashal al Rayyan x Belquis al Nasser) easily took the lead with 94.07 points! Dorar is bred and owned by the Royal Cavalry of France and scored 3x20 on type and 3x20 on head. Later this mare took the Silver Medal in the senior mare championships.

3rd in this class was Grea Bint bint Khattaara (Authentic Dahman x Grea bint Khattaara) with 92.64 points. Bred by Eliabetta Tizzani and owned by Al Shaqab Stud in Qatar.

4th with 92.21 points was True Baressa (Imperial Baarez x True Nirvanna). Bred by Merry Norwood and owned by Osman Linjawi of Saudi Arabia.

Even the 5th and 6th placed horses, still scored above the 90 points!

The next class contained the Gold Medal winner and Best in show named Simeon Sehavi (Asfour x Simeon Sheba). This beauty was flying through the arena, scoring 4 x 19.5 points for movement and a straight 4x20 for type! Also for head she was given 2x20, earning a total of 94.82 points, which was the highest score of the show! A great success for breeder Marion Richmond and owner Dubai Stud!
