n 7-8th April at the beautiful East Coast of Saudi Arabia in Dammam, the Al Ahsa national Arabian horse championship took place under the patronage of HRHP Khaled Bin Sultan Bin Abdul Aziz Al Saud. Starting at 1 pm and being judged by the wide international panel: dr Nasr Marei (Egypt), Dr Mary Bancroft (Great Britain), Dr Mohammed Oussidhoum (Morocco), Anna Stefaniuk (Poland), Christian Moschini (Italy) and Mark Ismer (Germany). The event took place on the big stadium providing wide, comfortable grass arena for good movement presentation. The show accompanied by nice traditional Arabian music is very popular amongst the local breeders and owners so it was attended by the huge number of ca 200 horses that made the organizers starting the show at hot 1 pm. Good logistic (with well know Ronny Vosch as ringmaster) made the show running smoothly however the quality of the horses was quite various and some scores during the show were commented as a bit confusing. The finals, attended by HRHP Khaled Bin Sultan Bin Abdul Aziz Al Saud himself, happened to be the most successful for the well known farms of Al Khalediah, Atbah and Al Mohammadia that shared the most of champions trophies - with Al Khalediah on the lead grabbing 5 out of 12 medals. Junior fillies probably the most tough competition due to the excellent quality in the group of 3 years old mares and very close total scores in all junior female classes, ended up with gold medal for UK-bred Nyjella (El Ameen x Noura) owned by the sons of Sh Hussain Basha Al Sawary, Silver – the first medal for Atbah Stud – Bint Atbah (Sabea El Sahraa x Atbah Al Thanija) and Bronze – the opening of successful medal run of Al Khalediah Farms – Nooran Al Khalediah the daughter of World Champion Mare – Robin K and by Padrons Immage. The same farm was the most lucky winner in the junior males with

Ibn Jameelat Al Khalediah (Moutaz Al Biwaibiya x Jameelat Al Khalediah) in front of Nawaf Al Mohammadia - the son of successful champion sire – F Shamaal and Saida Bint Sahli. Bronze went to Al Khaled Farm for Ansata Safeer sired Naviel Al Khaled out of Nafertiti. In the senior championships the lead was taken by the offspring of Aja Sangali (by FS Bengali). This one of the three most successful sons of FS Bengali (now owned in Poland), bred by Aja Arabians is currently owned by Al Khalediah Farm and during 2011 Al Ahsa show he was the sire of 3 medal awarded winners. First of them was internationally well known show competitor – Lana Al Khalediah (out of Thee Evening Star), again gold for Al Khalediah Farms. Silver was US bred Ballerina BVA (Ames Charisma x LC Pirouette) owned by Al Mohammadia Stud and bronze – Pure Polish Magora (Gazal Al Shaqab x Margotka) bred by Blommerod Arabian Stud in Sweden and owned by Al Khalediah Stables. In the senior males the highest trophy went to Brazilian-bred (by Rodolfo Guzzo) stallion

Fahrenheit GAT (El Nabila B x Hannah K) – another medalist out of the mare bred by Murilo Kammer. Silver and Bronze medals in the stallions were shared again by the sons of Aja Sangali – Moutaz Al Biwaibiya (out of FS Premirra) as silver and Ashhal Al Khalediah (out of Psyches Kyss) – as bronze.

Truly congratulating to the patrons, sponsors and the organizers we wish that this national show organized in beautiful traditional Arabian style will be in the future also so widely attended with the quality of entries growing and continuouslyit can be a good way for promoting the Arabian horse competitions on the Eastern side of Saudi Arabia.
