and it has been seen in numerous exhibitions worldwide.

He currently lives and works in Bergamo, Italy.

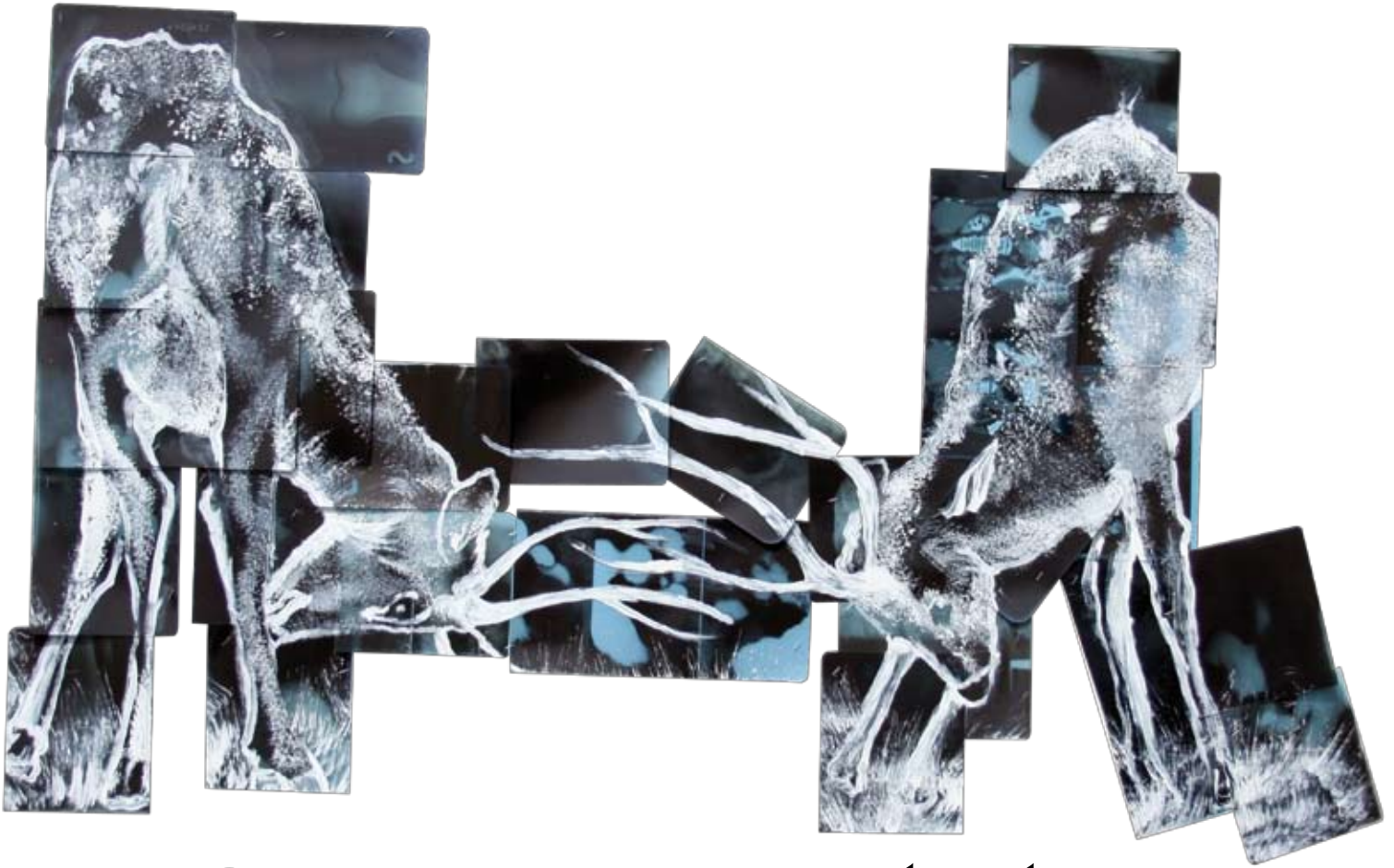
