She started working with Arabians at her neighbours Wilkesbacka Arabians (the breeder of Edjora, the granddam of World Champion Stallion Gazal Al Shaqab) when she was 12 years old growing a lifelong love for the Polish Arabian horse. After graduating Anette started to work at Beit El Kheil Arabians, another Swedish farm with a stellar group of Polish horses in their breeding program. 1989 would be an important year as Anette bought her first SLR camera and made her first trip to Poland to visit the Polish State Studs. Since 1992 Anette has worked as a professional photographer and journalist specializing in the Polish Arabian horse. The passion for the breed and for Poland and their National Treasure - the Arabian Horse - has only grown bigger. She writes and photograph for magazines all over the world and has her own small breeding program since 1991 in Sweden and Anette is together with Mr. Joaquin Bin the owner of Polish National Champion Stallion Ecaho, standing in California.

Anette loves to capture the beauty of the Arabian horse and happiest is she when she walks around at the Polish State Studs and capture the amazing Arabian horses in her lens - mares running out to the pasture in the morning, foals playing with each other in the big open barns and grooms working with these horses.
