athleen Ohlsson - who developed from a small family farm in Sweden into the owner of one of the most beautiful stallions and most successful sires in the world - Magic Magnifique. While the famous black stallion is spending his days on lease to Israel Sweden Arabian Stud of Kathleen Ohlsson is opening new chapter to create its future new blood champions!

Tutto Arabi: Kathleen, you are well known for promoting stallions into the great sires worldwide already - is the way to reach it the same always?

Kathleen Ohlsson: I just want to work with stallions I really belive in and I know how they produce. To be honest with people and show them real photos without any photoshop on both the stallion and his offspring.

TA: After promotion and successful use of Magic Magnifique as a sire in your stud and worldwide you decided to choose another great bred stallion in your program - why your choice went for Massai Ibn Marenga being the one?

KO: By following Massai Ibn Marengas offspring during many years, he was a naturally choice for my breeding programme. I love what he produce. A lot of type with huge eyes - a correct horse with movements. His offspring are both very successful at shows and in the breeding barn. Darius Family used Magic Magnifique on some of their Massai Ibn Marenga daughters and the result is just outstanding! They really got the best parts from both of the stallions, so - of course - I will use Massai on my Magic Magnifique daughters. The combination is what we call -magic!

Its time to start thinking "outside the box" in this industry today. The genepool is starting to be small when many breeders are using the same populair stallions, and for me, Massai Ibn Marenga, with his fantastic straight Russian pedigree, is a great sire to use.

TA: What do you admire in Massai Ibn Marenga career and what are his most significant babies so far?

KO: Flying the flag of the United Arab Emirates for his then owner HRH Sheikh Ammar Bin Humaid al Nuaimi of Ajman Stud, Massai Ibn Marenga speeded from one success to the next as a yearling, winning numerous Championship titles from renowned B-shows in European countries. At the end

which is quite obviously just the right kind of genetic background for a sire destined to put his stamp in his breed.

From his first foal crop, there are the lovely bay Da Rhomara (out of Rosinka by Princip) and the extremely typey Da Afrika (out of Aplikala by Karnaval) who caused quite a stir for her stud even during her first presentations. Top scores for type as well as for head and neck earned her class wins and reserve champion titles at international B-shows and a nomination for the Top Five Junior Females at the Wels A-Show and at the German National Championships in Aachen.

A short time later, the young stallion moved over to the Darius Arabian Stud in Germany and as a three-year-old in the following year, managed to start off right where he had left, winning a number of important national and international Championship titles at A and B-shows.




TA: Did you use to owe any of his offspring before and what are your favourite foals?

to lease Massai, I was more than happy! Now I have the




