

#### SIMEON STUD

R amses Tinah Family

I had in my mind that I always wanted a daughter of Ramses Fayek as I admire him as a stallion. He was form and function and had been a successful racehorse in Egypt. I went to the original Talaraia farm and looked through a herd of 300 horses, taking up almost a whole day. I chose Ramses Tinah, whom I leased originally to breed to Simeon Shai. When their daughter Simeon Shuala was born she was just so wonderful, I had to go ahead and purchase the old mare who I only had one more filly for us Simeon Sibolet, who has been retained. We have three of her daughters from each.

Simeon Shuala is an amazing producer. Her champion sons, all by Asfour include Simeon Sharav, recently sold by Albadeia Stud in Egypt to Iran now has champion progeny in Israel, Germany and the Middle East. The chestnut Simeon Shemini is a National Champion in New Zealand who now has National Champion progeny himself, while Simeon Segev, owned by Jack Maritz in South Africa, is a champion in many disciplines including harness, ridden and halter.

At home the family continues with the much admired Simeon Shiraz and her sister, the three year old Simeon Suzannah both daughters of Asfour. Simeon Shiraz has lovely black progeny in Spain and a son in Germany.



#### 27 Ibn Galal V Family

My mother first spotted this wonderful mare as a 2 year old harnessed to a huge flat farm dray in Hungary. She was truly an exceptional horse and a very beautiful Arabian, I was lucky enough to have seen her sire and grandsire, the original Galal at the EAO in Egypt. 27 lbn Galal V was the first Australian National Champion Mare, and through her daughters Simeon Safanad (Sankt Georg RSI), Simeon Sukari (Asfour), Simeon Simona (Asfour) and Simeon Sheba (Raadin Royal Star), she created her dynasty at Simeon.

The serene beauty of Simeon Safanad and her outstanding progeny helped put Simeon on the world map in the early days. She was not shown as an adult however her foals have won on several continents – I think it would be difficult to find a straight Egyptian mare with a breeding record such as Safanad.

#### Raffaalaa Family

I purchased another "dream" of mine in the form of a grey, wonderfully tempered pretty Dalul daughter Raffaala, who was in foal to MB Talmaar. I was especially interested in Dalul as he was a son of Yosreia. I went to Canada to see him, and he was a very handsome horse. Raffaala proved to be one of the sweetest natured horses we have come across. Her sweet nature followed through when she foaled Simeon

Seda, who was the second of my MB Talmaar daughters and a stunning grey mare who has produced a wonderful new branch for Simeon Stud including her champion daughter Simeon Se, by Asfour. Her full brother Simeon Shimui is world class, and be in fact be retained by Simeon.

Simeon Se has a yearling filly by Imperial Madaar who is close to my ideal. Her name is Simeon Seis, and I am so excited about her future.

#### The German Imports

Asfour and Imperial Madaar have common ancestors whom I admire, being the stallions Hadban Enzahi and Ghazal, and the mares Malika and her daughter Maymoonah. My theory,

after having followed their progeny over more than two decades was to bring back these old bloodlines to use with my younger stallions. As a result I have purchased 3 mares from Germany that are predominantly of these old German bloodlines in a bid to keep going full circle. These old mares are absolutely classic with huge black eyes, perfect feet and legs...so truly Arabian. We are lucky to have three embryos from these mares so far.

Simeon Stud has recently welcomed to Australia from Germany the 16 year old straight egyptian stallion Mulayh Ibn Mareesa, sire of one of our three German mares CM Moussameh. He is by Ansata Amir Zaman from Mareesa, who is a Montasar daughter.
