# THE ALI JAMAAL LEGACY IN EUROPE FOUNDED BY TALITHA BAKKER

lready since a young age, Talitha Bakker was fascinated by the bay stallion Ali Jamaal from Brazil. She made a promise to herself that one day she would own one of his daughters. Later realizing how costly this would be, it was not until 2011 that she got the opportunity to purchase a direct Ali Jamaal daughter from an auction in Brazil. This mare, Geraldyne el Jamaal, was not only by Ali Jamaal but was also out of a beautiful dam named Gai Natascha from the famous Gainey stud farm. Gai Natascha was a daughter of the great Bey Shah and came out of Gai Radiance, who was a full sister to the Halsdon Arabians owned Gai Radiant, a descent of Gai Parada.

### Geraldyne el Jamaal

Geraldyne el Jamaal was the cornerstone for the breeding program of Talitha Bakker. Not only did this mare blessed her with many top offspring, several being BLACK but also developed herself to an incredible riding partner. Together they rode more than 2000 kms in competition. One of which was just very recent. At the age of 21, Geraldyne and Talitha successfully finished the very tough race in the mountains of Germany where they completed 350km over 5 days. With her extraordinary performance as an endurance horse, Geraldyne received the Sport certificate Endurance which is a kind of "medal of honor" for extraordinary performances.

Geraldyne was also awarded with the ELITE certificate for her accomplishments as a broodmare.

Today, Talitha still owns two daughters of Geraldyne. The dark bay ASE Gabriella al Gazal by Gazal al Shaqab and the black filly ASE Gioia el Yas by AJ Yas. Now that Geraldyne has successfully fulfilled her sportcareer, she will be bred to Wadee al Shaqab for a 2024 foal.

# ZT Ludjteyna

Another mare with a large Ali Jamaal influence at the farm, is the ELITE senior mare ZT Ludjteyna. A mare who already

made a name for herself, being the dam of the world famous ZT Marwteyn. Ludjteyna is a daughter of Ludjin el Jamaal and comes out of the black US National champion mare Shahteyna by Bey Shah out of TW Forteyna. A royal pedigree which shows when you look at her. ZT Ludjteyna came to Talitha Bakker at the age of 24. Here at Arabian Stud Europe, Ludjteyna really blossomed and is enjoying her days in the field with her best friend Geraldyne. In 2022, she gave birth to an unbelievable pretty filly by embryo transfer. This filly, ASE Juillye el Teyna is sired by the young upcoming exotic stallion ASE Juilliard (Da Vinci FM x ASE Bisiriya Hlayyil). Juillye is everything you wish for in a young filly. She is exotic, feminine, has long legs and loves

to show off. She impressed the crowed at her first show where she immediately took the Silver medal. She will continue her show career in September with her presence at the prestigious All Nations Cup. For 2024, ZT Ludjteyna is again in foal to ASE Juilliard.

## Sihaam al Salhiyah

One of the most recent purchases for the stud is the 10 years old mare Sihaam al Salhiyah. This incredibly beautiful mare is sired by ZT Magnanimus and comes out of the beautiful ZT Fantmaisa by ZT Shakfantasy. Sihaam is one of those mares who simply takes your breath away by just looking at

her. She has an extreme neck, a beautiful face, strong body and can move for 20s. This year she is on lease to Ilona Bax of Just Arabians who got her in foal to their champion stallion Wadi Kahil by Kahil al Shaqab for 2024. Sihaam will also be presented in the showring this year by Tom Oben.

#### **ASE Bisiriya Hlayyil**

The foundation of Arabian Stud Europe was formed with the Egyptian related mare Manilah (Radamess II x Marischka). Her daughter, ASE Bisiriya Hlayyil, was very successful at the highest level of endurance, including a 3rd place at the

CEI 2\* of 120km. She was also awarded with the ELITE certificate from the Dutch studbook for her accomplishments as a broodmare. Bisiriya sired many champion offspring. Both in the showring as in endurance. Today, Talitha still owns three of her daughters and two of her sons.

One of the daughters is the multiple champion filly ASE Kamiliya Hlayyil, sired by Kahil al Shaqab. This mare is currently in training with JL Training center for the upcoming show season! The other daughters still owned by Talitha are the full sisters ASE Eshadah Bisiriya and Bisharat al Dawla. Both sired by RHR Heir of Marwan by Marwan al Shaqab. Bisharat just gave birth to her first foal.

A fantastic colt by Jyar Meia Lua named ASE Zaytoun. Two sons of Bisiriya, still owned by Talitha today are the gelding ASE Magnificent and the successful breeding stallion ASE Juilliard. Magnificent is a son of ZT Magnanimus and is very successful in the sport division. He was Allround Champion at the Arabissimo in both 2022 and 2023, exceeding in showjumping and cross country. He is also very successful in endurance where he won many races, including a 80+km race. He also won two Best Condition titles and was also successful in the CEI 1\* of 100km. On top of this all, he is also successful in dressage competitions.

#### **ASE Juilliard**

The other son of Bisiriya is a young exotic stallion named ASE Juilliard. This stallion is a son of Da Vinci FM by Versace. Juilliard is only 7 years old but already created a strong name for himself, producing extremely exotic fillies who are winning show champion titles all over Europe. This year alone, his daughter ASE Graciela el Juilliard (out of Geraldyne el Jamaal), was Bronze medal champion junior

filly at her very first show in Bruges, while his other daughter, ASE Juillye el Teyna (out of ZT Ludjteyna) got silver medal at her very first outing on the Eurozone nat show! We believe ASE Juilliard is going to make a big impact on the Arabian horse world. With his mother being both an ELITE mare as a winner in international endurance and with a pedigree that represents no Marwan or Justice, Juilliard is a great choice for any breeder!

Jazzmeen is a son of world champion Essteem (Fame VF) and comes out of Jasmyne by Nyhl el Jamaal. In his past years, Jazzmeen was very successful in showjumping, cross country and dressage. He

also sired some great athletic foals who are exceeding in both dressage and endurance.

With in total 10 horses, Arabian Stud Europe is a small boutique breeding program where the horses are not just very pretty, but can also perform under saddle at the highest level!
