Talitha and Dakaree (Dakar el Jamaal x Ultimate Fancy)

Arabian Stud Europe is a small stud farm in The Netherlands based on Brazilian bloodlines and some Straight Egyptian breeding. For Talitha Bakker, founder, owner and manager, ever since she was introduced to Arabian horses, they became her way of life.

Having worked with Arabian show horses since the age of 13, she knows of no other world than the world of the purebred Arabian horse.

In 1996 Talitha Bakker started her own breeding farm under the name 'The Shah Arabians', then based on Russian bloodlines. One of the first horses purchased was the Russian/Crabbet mare Atlantis. A daughter of world champion Amal and out of Ghazel by Kniazj/Muslin. Atlantis gave the farm two daughters. Padrone Lanisha, sired by Padrone Kadar and Amal-Chariklia by the Abakan son Insjallah's Fayoum.

This last one became Talitha Bakker's soul mate and together they started to win numerous victories in the show ring, including supreme champion at the regional championships, liberty class in 2002.

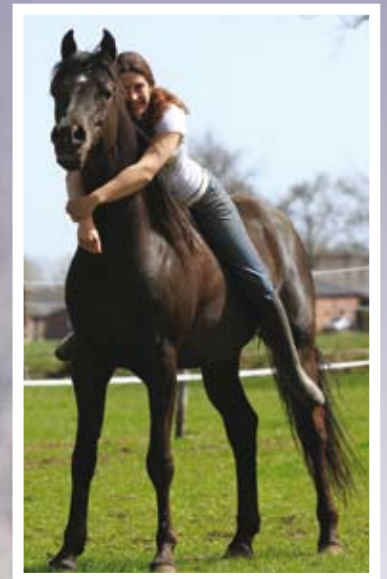
In 2006, all the Russian Arabians were sold, except for this special mare, who is still one of the foundation mares of Arabian Stud Europe today.

New horses were acquired. All of international (show) quality and coming from the best Egyptian and Brazilian lines. With these new lines and breeding programme, The Shah Arabians also changed their name to Arabian Stud Europe, to define their international character.

Ever since she got involved with the Arabian horse, Talitha Bakker was fascinated by the Brazilian bloodlines. When other teenagers had posters of Take That on their walls, Talitha admired Ali Jamaal.

Already at the young age of 14, she knew all the pedigrees by heart and was up to date with latest Brazilian products. It was therefore very clear that the new breeding programme should have some lines to the great Ali Jamaal.

At that moment she had no idea that 10 years later she would have a son, grandchildren and great grandchildren of Ali Jamaal at her stud. Combined with the blood of Marwan al Shaqab, Bey Shah and El Shaklan.

In 2007, Amal-Chariklia was the first one to give birth to an ASE (Arabian Stud Europe) foal. Sired by the Ali Jamaal grandson, Borsalino K, an amazing bay filly was born with extraordinary movement and attitude. A real eye catcher and a look alike of her mum. Talitha named her ASE Brasilia Chariklia. And with her the new breeding programme had taken shape.

In the following years, Amal-Chariklia was bred several times to the Ali Jamaal bloodlines. In 2009 she foaled a bay colt named ASE Valencio el Jary. Sired by Jary el Jamaal. Son of Ali Jamaal out of NV Justa Dream by Bey Shab. Jary el Jamaal is owned by La Movida Stud in Austria and was on lease to Arabian Stud Europe for two years. Having a direct son of Ali Jamaal at her farm was a dream come true for Talitha. Unfortunately he blessed her with almost only colts. All, however of very good quality and with big movement.

In 2010, Chariklia gave birth to her last foal. ASE Stivallo, sired by Stival (Gazal Al Shaqab x Paloma de Jamaal). Talitha decided that, with the birth of this great colt, the breeding career of Chariklia would end and she could enjoy the rest of her life as a companion and riding horse.

Brasilia Chariklia by Borsalino K took over from her mother and sired a great moving colt in 2011. Sired by Bastian el Pryam. A young stallion who came to Arabian Stud Europe in January 2008. Bastian el Pryam is a son of Pryam el Jamaal out of Bella Reyna el Bri by CH El Brillo.

The true treasure of Arabian Stud Europe arrived in 2008. The spectacular mare Dakaree. A daughter of Dakar el Jamaal and out of Ultimate Fancy by WN Ultimate Star. Talitha had seen this mare on a promotional video of Dakar el Jamaal back in 2003 and always kept her in her mind. When this mare was offered for sale in 2008, Talitha did not need much time to think and bought the mare immediately. Since then, Dakaree has brought a lot to the stud. When still in the United States, Dakaree had achieved the title of reserve champion western pleasure junior horse. She was also bred to Marhaabah, a son of Marwan al Shaqab out of Shalina el Jamaal. This foal was born in 2009 and got the name ASE Myandour. Now a great young stallion who is still resident at Arabian Stud Europe.

In 2010, Dakaree was entered at some shows and with great succes! With Tom Oben, she achieved the unanimous senior mares champion title at the show in Koksijde, Belgium as well as champion mare at the Emerald Trophy, Brecht, Belgium. For 2012, Dakaree is bred to the bronze world champion stallion RFI Farid (RFI Maktub x RFI Fayara El Shiraz). This foal will be in partnership with Talitha's boyfriend Simone Leo.

With Simone being a big fan of Brazilian bloodlines as well, it was only a matter of time until he and Talitha would find each other. This foal of Dakaree and Farid will be their first collaboration and for sure not the last!

The first acquisition of Arabian Stud Europe, after changing their name and vision, was the amazing Manilah. A daughter of Radamees II (Salaa el Dine) and out of the famous broodmare Marischka (Plakat), who is also the mother of Major. Manilah later became a strong foundation mare for the stud and is definitely there to stay!

She won several titles on show. One of them in unanimous champion & best in show in St. Oedenrode, The Netherlands and more recently the reserve senior championship at Zottegem, Belgium and also a 2nd place at the international show in Lier, Belgium.

Manilah also succeeded under saddle in cross country and also blessed the stud with three amazing foals.

One very extreme filly in 2008 named ASE Bisiriya Hlayyil (Bishr (Hlayyil Ramadan)). She became a silver medal winner as a junior and is now bred to the bronze world champion RFI Farid.

In 2009, Manilah gave birth to a big showy colt by Marajj named ASE Marajó and in 2010 a very beautiful grey filly ASE Ajmilah by Ajman Moniscione, that unfortunately died.

Manilah is now bred to Al Ayal AA. This foal will be in ownership of Victor Arabians, Italy.

In 2007 a very special boy came in the life of Talitha Bakker. The Black Stallion Jazzmeen. A son of Triple Crown winner Essteem and the Nyhl el Jamaal daughter Jasmyne. Jazzmeen carries 2x Ali Jamaal, 2x El Shaklan and 2x Bey Shah in his pedigree and was bred by La Movidia Stud in Austria. At first, Jazzmeen came to Arabian Stud Europe for a one year lease period, then owned by Justine Bassindale from England. Already after a few weeks, Talitha knew she would not be able to part with him anymore. In 2008, she was given the opportunity by Justine to purchase Jazzmeen. This did not need much thought and in 2008 Jazzmeen became a member of the Arabian Stud Europe family. A new home where he would stay until the end of his days.

With Talitha, Jazzmeen started a new adventure. He got introduced to cross country jumping, which he loves and of course he enjoyed very much his natural life at the stud.

Because of his gentle character, Jazzmeen was able to stay out with the mares in the same fields during the daytime and even shared a stable with his precious love, Dakaree in the winter time. He knows that he is not allowed to cover them naturally and really behaves around his girls. The foals see him as a big play mate and the girls think he is a great friend. But for Jazzmeen, there are only two loves in his life: Dakaree and Talitha.

For Talitha he will go through fire without even blinking his eye. The love he has for her is truly amazing and rarely seen. They share an amazing bond together and many people already enjoyed the many pictures posted on the internet of this great combination. Jumping, dressage, Spanish walk, piaffe, rearing... he can do it all. Riding with or without saddle or bridle... One or four girls on his back. Jazzmeen will never ask questions or doubt any decision. He will always do as told. However, don't think that this makes him a boring horse! Once he is in the cross country field, there is no one that can stop him and he just flies over every jump he sees!

His first filly Imeleena J, out of Illyeria el Jamaal and bred by JB Arabians, UK, achieved a 2nd place at the international A-show in Wels, Austria.

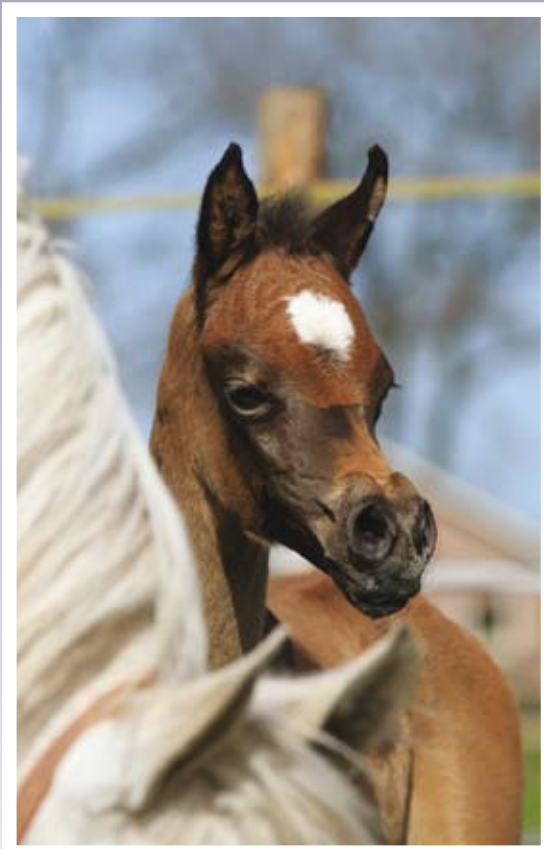
More recently, his son Amurath Kamsin, born in 2009 out of Amurath Kobeilah and bred by Amurath Gestut, Germany, was named reserve champion at the show in Marbach, Germany.

In 2009, another amazing foal sired by Jazzmeen was born. A bay filly named ASE Jazzelle. Bred by Arabian Stud Europe out of the Nadir I daughter Charelle Monpelou. This extreme moving filly was sold to Al Jenan Stud in Kuwait, where she will be shown next year!

However, the best of Jazzmeen is yet to come! In 2011 he sired an unbelievable pretty filly that will be shown next year.

Because Talitha wants more private time with Jazzmeen, she decided to close his breeding book by the end of this season. Frozen semen will still be available for a selective number of mares.

Maybe in the far future his breeding book will re-open, but the next upcoming years will be dedicated to riding, relaxing and fun!

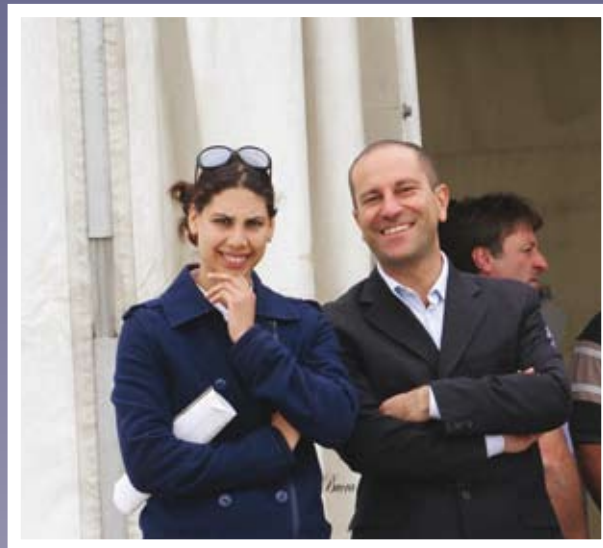
