







"Horse, thou art truly a creature without equal, for thou fliest without wings." — The Koran





We call them "Drinkers of the Wind." This statement creates visions of flaring nostrils and thundering hooves. They have inspired painters, writers, and poets. They have led us in wars and they are our humble friends. They are living art, Nothing is more beautiful than an Arabian mare and foal and nothing is more romantic than an Arabian stallion.

My passion for Arabian horses began early on in my life when I used to walk through my grandfather's fields of mares and he would discuss with me, very intently, the bloodlines of his prized females. Always dancing beside them was a new foal. My grandfather would point to one of his stallions and say, "This is her sire ... but never forget ... the outcome of foals is always reckoned with their dam." That is why, to this day, three Arabian breeding generations later, my mares are my treasures.

My family's breeding program began with the influence of Ferzon and Azraff. For the most part, these exquisite white mares that graced the fields, exemplified Arabian type. They were typically beautiful faced mares with large dark eyes, compact smooth bodies, and beautiful motion. This was my first vision of what an Arabian should be, and still, this vision influences my purchasing and breeding decisions.

With time, the blood of Ali Jamaal and Bey Shah were incorporated into my family-breeding program. The idea was always to go to the next level, constantly demanding improvement on the previous generation. This sometimes required outcrosses to other bloodlines ie. Spanish, Egyptian, Polish, Russian or Crabbet to attain certain characteristics. My grandfather and my aunt were both very successful using this breeding philosophy.

Bloodlines and the business of breeding are my focus. Breeding decisions are sometimes like the science of creating "The Perfect Storm," the results being something powerful, beautiful, and exciting. My ultimate goal, however, is to breed a "global looking" Arabian. What this means to me is consistently breeding horses that can win anywhere in the world. To reach this goal, I have selected a group of mares that are not only great individuals, but also have excellent pedigrees and are proven broodmares. Some of the bloodlines my mares carry are: Versace, Bey Shah, Ali Jamaal, \*El Shaklan, Ansata Halim Shah, Padrons Psyche, and WN Ultimate Star.

Two years ago, I was fortunate enough to buy the last straws of \*El Shaklan semen from Count Zichy-Thyssen. \*El Shaklan is

a legend and progenitor of Arabian type. His powerful influence on my mares has produced two stunning daughters. These two fillies will mature and go on to carry the torch of these rare bloodlines.

My interest in Arabian horses has taken me all over the world, from the Salon Du Cheval in Paris, to the National Championships in Brazil, and has forged friendships that have lasted many years. This year I plan to visit the Dubai show and spend time with my friends from the Middle East. I always love to receive email from other Arabian enthusiasts from around the world. I tell my kids that if we spin the globe and put our finger down on a continent, we are sure to find a friend in the Arabian horse industry.

Because of this international connection, our family who has also been in the Hollywood film industry for years is looking for an international film project about Arabian horses. I believe the viability and vitality of the Arabian horse needs to be supported in this way by people who love this breed.

# JEISA


(WH Justice x Sharon El Kendal)


