

REDEFINING BEAUTY FROM THE HIGH LANDS OF CHILE

he name Haras Lonco first rang a bell in my mind with the rise of their homebred HL El Ganador in Europe who swept the old continent by storm with his beauty by winning most of its major shows in 2017. Then, with the win of Lonco Dalilah as Brazilian National Gold Champion Filly, shown by the talented Brazilian handler Neto Soldani in 2022, it became clear that their presence within the elite of South American breeders of Arabian Horses was fast becoming more and more noticeable. But it was not until march of 2024 that I had the chance to meet Ricardo Duch and Neto Soldani in person.

I was judging the Breeders Cup Show in Quito, the Capital of the beautiful country of Ecuador, a land that holds a special place in my heart, with its amazing breeders who are now my good friends and their outstanding horses. Ricardo and Neto were the special international guests of the Ecuadorian Arabian Horse Association on that occasion and therefore we were staying in the same hotel. That allowed the three of us to spend time together and somehow got me the chance to know better the brains behind the famous Haras Lonco with their plans and hopes for the future. On the other side Ricardo gave me some valuable advice in terms of work, ethics and networking.

Since then, a bond of friendship resulted in the opportunity for me to collaborate in portraying some of the show horses (home bred or acquired) owned by Ricardo. And this year I was presented with the ultimate gift of going to see the horses I wrote about up close at both the show ring at the Chilean National Arabian Horse Show as well as at their wonderful farm.

Located in the beautiful valley of Panquehue, in the San Felipe district, irrigated by the crystalline waters melted from the snow of the Andes mountains and globally famous for the high quality of its land, a place known for the production of the best avocados in the world, right in the outskirts of Santiago, Haras Lonco is fast becoming one of the leading Arabian Horse breeding operations in Chile and in South America.

The farm has started its activities officially in the year 2005 with the importation of three mares from Argentina, all of them descendants of the mighty El Shaklan. Initially the focus was in the production of exceptional endurance horses. That environment led the Duch family to become familiar also with the halter horses and since then the goal has been to produce the highest quality of show horses as well as breeding and riding horses at their facility. With that





in mind Ricardo Duch spared no efforts to find the best available stock in Chile and in others countries.

The current success achieved by Haras Lonco is a result of both the hard work of their committed team under the supervision of Neto Soldani, as well as the enthusiasm and dedication of the Duch family, especially Ricardo and his sons Cristobal and Ricardo Jr.

The property is comprised of many acres of lavish green pastures as well as conditioning and training facilities. But equally amazing is the Art Museum, "Arte al Límite", curated by Ricardo's wife Ana Maria, built inside the farm, which fosters the work of a number vanguard South American artists from different countries.

But no matter how much I try to describe the magic of the place I have to admit that being able to be there in person watching the horses presented with the Andes mountains rising behind the showing barn, is an experience that is truly breathtaking.

The increasing showring achievements of Haras Lonco through the last decade can best be evaluated by the chronology of a time line by some of the most important foundation stock of both stallions and mares, as well as some of the outstanding horses bearing the Lonco suffix, bred by the Duch family in this period.

Both stallions and mares are a good reference to trace the evaluation of the different stages of the breeding program so far. The homebreds in the other hand are a testimony of Haras Lonco's vision when it comes to their clients since selling their best stock is proving to be their best publicity in all the countries that the Lonco horses have been present, including Chile, Brazil, Ecuador, Argentina, the U.S.A as well as the continents of Europe and the Middle East. The ones that stay at home have been doing a great name for themselves and for the farm by winning in a variety of major shows around the world.

The Stallions

Matisse FM (Marwan Al Shaqab x Selket Promisses Kept by Furno Khamal)

Matisse FM was bred in the Unites States by Full Moon Arabians and imported to Brazil by Haras Stigmatas.





An impressive bay stallion he is by the iconic World Champion Stallion Marwan Al Shaqab out of Selket Promisses Kept, a mare of predominant Russian and Egyptian bloodlines through her German sire Furno Khamal and her mother Preferred Time.

Important names such as Patron, Kajora, Fame VF, Ansata Ibn Halima, Panama of Tersk and Kilimanjaro seal the importance of Matisse as reliable sire.

He is a very tall and bold horse with beautiful big black eyes and an abundant amount of show attitude.

Matisse FM has collected many wins in Brazil including the National Champion Stallion title, before his ultimate importation to Chile.

He has proven himself as an outstanding broodmare sire in different countries. At Haras Lonco a group of his daughters are helping to create the foundation that will allow the farm to make even bigger steps towards breeding the next generations of show horses.



TS Zaarife Al Khidam (TS Khidam El Shawan x Stig Zaphyra by El Tino)

TS Zaarife el Khidam is no stranger to siring National Champions in Chile. His daughter Lonco Beauty has been named Chilean National Champion filly twice, both times unanimously. Another daughter, the beautiful Lonco Tara, after winning Bronze National Champion Filly in Chile, has been named Grand Champion Mare at the Cuenca Fair in Ecuador.

TS Zaarife Al Khidam might be considered a South American blend of the best that has been produced here in the last decades: in Brazil (both his parents at Haras Arco Azul and Haras Stigmatas), in Uruguay (his grandmother at Haras del Timote) and in Argentina (both his maternal great grandparents, at Haras Mayed).

His is a paternal brother to U.S National Champion Aria Valiant and a maternal brother to Lonco Dallilah, Brazilian and Chilean National Champion Filly.

His pedigree is a combination of the best cross between the Sire lines of FA El Shawan, through TS Khidam al Shawan (Zarife's sire) and El Tino, through Stig Saphira (Zarife's





mother), and hence also bringing such names as of the charismatic Scottsdale Grand Champion Psymadre, the super sire JJ Señor Magnum and the iconic Bey Shah son, Shahllenger.

Zaarife is paving a solid road an accomplished young sire in South America today.

Braavos HAV (HDF Lugano x Bouquet El Perseus by Perseus El Jamaal)

Braavos HAV was selected as a yearling in Brazil and since his start as a sire he has been constantly producing animals with extreme refinement and movement, very much in line with the worldwide demand when it comes to show horses.

Even though he always had to share the spotlight with accomplished International and National Champions such as Matisse FM and Axell, Braavos has managed to prove his value with a limited number of mares bred to him.

His sire is the recently deceased HDF Lugano, one of the best sons of FA El Shawan a sire of multile National Champions in Brazil out of a daughter of the classic El Nabila B. Braavos HAV is likely to be a main candidate as an heir to his father in continuing his great legacy.

Braavos mother is the chestnut Bouquet El Perseus, a triple Ali Jamaal and double Bey Shah mare, being by the black Perseus El Jamaal (Ali Jamaal x Perfecshann SRA by Bey Shah) and out of a daughter of Ludjin el Jamaal and his paternal sister out of the great TW Bey Fantasy by Bey Shah.

Braavos HAV has been catching international attention with the success of his young daughter Lonco Bianca, 2024 Chilean National Champion Filly, exported to Ecuador where she also became Champion at her first show in Cuenca and now with her exotic full brother Lonco Tristan, a certain future superstar at Haras Lonco.

Axell (Preludio OSB x RL Alita MAM by El Shakhyr)

Axell is an exquisite grey stallion that has been named 2023 Chilean National Gold Champion Stallion. As a yearling he also won a National Champion Title before being imported by Haras Lonco.

Since his retirement from the show ring just a couple of years ago, he has been siring outstanding progeny. Three of





them, Lonco Orion, Lonco Blue and HLF Esmeralda have already collected Chilean National Champion Titles.

He is sired by Preludio OSB a stallion that won the titles of National Champion in both Brazil and North America, who is by one the world's leading sire of champions Dominic M who in turn is by the handsome U.S. Reserve Champion Stallion Da Vinci FM. Coincidentally Da Vinci was bred at the same farm as another stallion at Haras Lonco, Matisse FM.

Alita MAM is the mother of Axell. She has also produced the multi-National Champion Aziz MAM (by HP Ali) in Brazil. She is by El Shakhyr, a Brazilian National Champion son of the splendid FA El Shawan. Alita's mother Madinah, is by the Brazilian leading sire of champions Ryad el Jamaal and out of the mare Breeze, U.S. Top Ten Futurity Filly and one of the most beautiful mares ever imported to Brazil.

Axell has just returned to Chile after spending the last two breeding seasons in Brazil.

Parsifal Alfabia (EKS Alihandro x Mishka Al Alfabia by Sabeh Al Salhyiah)

Parsifal Alfabia is the latest addition to the stallion barn. With the birth of his beautiful daughter HLF Matilda at the farm, he has confirmed his notable siring abilities matching the incredible quality of the few babies he produced in Italy before his arrival in Chile.

A visit to Europe last year led Ricardo Duch from Haras Lonco in Chile, alongside his trainer Neto Soldani, to visit one of the most internationally acclaimed breeding programs in the world, the timeless Alfabia Stud, in the Italian region of Piemonte.

Founded by Gigi Grasso and Paolo Damilano in the early 90's, Alfabia has quickly become a landmark for producing champions and bringing hidden jewels from all over the world to their program. Since then, generation after generation, the farm has kept its presence in the spotlight by producing a succession of international champions. Among their latest masterpieces are a couple of full blood siblings who Ricardo and Neto have fallen in love with, Camily Alfabia and Parsifal Alfabia.,





Parsifal was leased to be used as a sire in South America, leaving a few mares bred to him in Italy, despite being very young.

He is by the twice World Champion Stallion EKS Alihandro out of the predominantly Egyptian homebred Mishka Al Alfabia.

Though their sire is the more famous relative, it is in their mother's pedigree that a unique blend that could have only been done at Alfabia, was developed. First due to their Straight Egyptian breeding program and then for securing the best of the best from the famous breeding of Count Federico Zichy Thyssen to their own program. Among other benefits, the Egyptian program at Alfabia has allowed them to own in partnership the father of Mishka Al Alfabia. Sabeh Al Sahliya, bred in Saudi Arabia by Salhiya Stud. A magnificent grey gifted with a very correct body structure and huge dark eyes, Sabeh is by Ansata Nile Echo, known for his amazing trot and refinement and out of the beautiful Mareeka, who traces in tail female to the iconic Nazeer daughter Yosreia, dam of the legendary Aswan.

Parsifal's first foals have arrived in Italy and Chile since the end of last year. The results are exceeding all the

expectations. They have unbelievable big black eyes that are very well set apart, sculpted faces, small scissor ears, coupled in beautiful and correct bodies and gifted with exuberant movement.

The Mares

Lonco Baby Maria (HP Emir x ZT Highromit by Focus Highlander)

Lonco Baby Maria is a mare of exquisite beauty who is quickly rising as an aristocrat mare in Chile.

She has made a name of her own by producing the incomparable HL El Ganador (by HP Shakir TE) that won, among many other shows, the coveted Gold Medal in both Aachen and Menton. HL Ganador has boosted the reputation of the South American bred horses as a source of quality for the World and is now of the chief sires at Hanaya Stud in Switzerland.

Lonco Orion came next in Lonco Baby Maria's champion producing list. A beautiful grey colt by Axell he has won the title of Chilean National Champion Colt in 2024 and has since been exported to Argentina.





Lonco Baby Maria's pedigree is a parade of champions and producers of champions including RSD Dark Victory the sire of Brazilian National Champion Lumiar Amadeus and World Champion Mare Victoria II HPS, ST Synbad, Brazilian Reserve and Chilean National Champion Stallion and the blood of El Shaklan and Padron Psyche found in her mother, ZT Highromit bred by ZT Arabians in Argentina.

Shavanna el Madan (FA El Shawan x Jedalah Cajun RMC by Cajun Prince HCF)

Despite her relatively young age, Shavanna el Madan can be considered an Aristocrat mare. She has produced three Gold National Champion Colts: the full brothers by El Tino, namely, Intense Arabco and Dominus Arabco in Brazil and the beautiful black son of Bandit SRA, Lonco Albion in Chile.

Moreover, her daughter Arantxa Arabco by QR Marc has produced the 2024 Brazilian Unanimous Gold Junior Champion Colt Bhareez Serondella (by Vision Serondella).

Shavanna was bred by Haras el Madan in Brazil being a daughter of FA El Shawan, arguably one of the best producing sons of his World Champion father Marwan al Shaqab and Jedala Cajun RLC, a daughter of Brazilian National Champion Cajun Prince, a notable broodmare sire himself.

The heiresses to the Zichy Thyssen tradition

Haras Lonco keeps a treasure in their pastures that are worth their weight in gold. Three beautiful mares imported from Alfabia Stud in Italy.

Alfabia in the other hand is owned by Gigi Grasso, who some years ago was able to select the very best from the stud of Count Federico Zichy Thissen before the dispersal of his stud in Argentina. The Count was one of the wisest breeders in the world and through over five decades of breeding he was able to select the best individuals from the greatest farms in the world, including Ansata Arabian Stud, Om el Arab. Gainey Arabians, Lasma and Haras Meia Lua.

The happy ending of this story only became possible because this legacy went to yet another magnificent breeder. Alfabia was able to turn what they acquired in Argentina into an even more spectacular outcome.

These three mares represent the best of the best that the





world has to offer in terms of bloodlines and producing abilities.

Havanna Alfabia is by the black stallion Jakhal Alfabia, a son o ZT Marwteyn and ZT Magna Psyche. Her mother ZT Fantmaisa is by none other than the World Champion ZT Shakfantasy and the straight Egyptian AK El Maisa, bred by the legendary Bentwood Farms. She has just produced a filly this year that might become the best horse ever born at Haras Lonco.

Emily Alfabia is the successful outcome of blending three of the world's most traditional breeding programs. Her sire Lawrence El Gazal bred by La Movida Arabians in Austria is by Gazal Al Shaqab and out of one of Haras Meia Lua's greatest mares Lara el Ludji. Her mother is the beautiful black ZT Magna Psyche, a daughter of ZT Magnanimous out of WN Obssession, a full sister the World Champion Mare WN Fawn Obssession. Emily is a beautiful and tall grey mare that honors her heritage with her quality.

Last but not least is EA Magnela a daughter of ZT Magnofantasy, who carries de blood of the noted AB Magnum as well as an extra cross to El Shaklan, on a granddaughter of the above mentioned World Champion ZT

Shakfantasy, tracing in the dam line to the Russian elite stallion Prichal, the first son of Aswan ever imported to South America and sire of the exceptional Don el Chall.

Camilly Alfabia (EKS Alihandro x Mishka Al Alfabia by Sabeh Al Salhyiah)

Imported from Alfabia Stud in Italy, Camilly Alfabia became the 2024 Chilean National Gold Champion Young Mare upon her arrival in her new country. She is one of the most talked about candidates to take the gold at the upcoming Brazilian National Champion Show this year.

While waiting for her return into the showring Camilly is in Brazil collecting some embryos with the some of the country's finest stallions.

Displaying a unique combination of beauty and structure Camilly has been generating a big fan club everywhere she goes and receiving high praises from judges and breeders alike.

Bred in Italy by the famous Alfabia Stud, owned by the acclaimed Gigi Grasso, Camilly Alfabia is by the World Champion EKS Alihandro and Mishka Al Alfabia.





Camilly Alfabia is therefore a third generation of Alfabia breeding through a blend of the blood the best Egyptian lines of Ansata through Ansata Nile Echo, Maysoun and Prince Fa Moniet and the epitome of Zichy Thyssen's breeding program with direct lines to ZT Magnanimous and World Champion ZT Shakfantasy.

SA Talya El Patrol (Patrol Al Ventur x Toulouse Serondella by El Jahez WH)

SA Talya El Patrol in one of the most recent acquisitions at Haras Lonco. She was discovered by Neto Soldani while still a yearling, who was taken by her exotic face and her overall quality.

She was bred by Haras Sant'Ana in the center region of Brazil, in the state of Goiás, where her sire Patrol al Ventur is standing as the senior sire. He is by one of the most important sires of all time, Magnum Psyche and out of an accomplished daughter of Haras Fortaleza's Chief Sire Delmar, a son of the U.S. National Champion Stallion Marsianin and Love Melody, whose parents Aladdin and Bask Melody were both U.S National Champions.

Toulouse Serondella, Talya's mother is a modern descendant

of the famed E line from Poland, through being a granddaughter of the great Elle Dorada and sired by the iconic El Jahez WH. Her full sister Elzunia Meia Lua was named U.S National Champion and her full brother Ektor Meia Lua is a chief sire at the famous Haras Dharamsala.

The Lonco Legacy: Past, Present and Future

HL El Ganador (HP Shakir TE x Lonco Baby Maria by HP Emir)

The term El Ganador means "the winner" in Spanish. And that's exactly what this beautiful grey colt has done since he has stepped in the show ring for the first time in 2017.

HL Ganador during his early years, after being exported to Nayla Hayek of Hanaya Stud, has won in all the major shows in Europe, with special focus to three of the World's most important shows: The All Nations Cup in Aachen, the Mediterranean Championships in Menton and the World Championship at the Salon du Cheval in Paris.

His success has brought attention to the horses from South America and Chile, but specially for Haras Lonco that now have gained international recognition in a global scale.





His father HP Shakir TE is by LC Farid, a son of the Scottsdale Junior Champion Colt Palisade and San Jose Camila, a maternal sister to the U.S. National Champion Mare San Jose Javiera. His mother is a champion daughter of Cajun Prince HCF out of a Ludjin el Jamaal daughter. Shakir is also the sire of the noted HP Ali, a sire of many champions in South America.

His mother is the ethereal Lonco Baby Maria, one of the pillars of Haras Lonco. Maria has also produced the Chilean National Gold Champion Colt Lonco Orion, by Axell. She is by HP Emir out of ZT Highromit, a daughter of Focus Highlander bred by Federico Zichy Thissen in Argentina.

HL Ganador is now fulfilling his duties as a sire with success producing beautiful foals for his owner Hanaya Stud in Switzerland.

Lonco Dalilah (Dominic M x Stig Zaphyra by El Tino)

The chestnut beauty Lonco Dalilah is a landmark in the breeding of Haras Lonco.

She was the first filly from the breeding program ever to

earn a major title in the tough Brazilian Nation Championship Show being 2022 Brazilian National Champion Gold Filly at the show presented by Neto Soldani.

Lonco Dalilah is by the superb sire Dominic M and out of the champion producer Stig Zaphyra, a daughter of El Tino out of the Uruguayan Daphne HDT. Daphne's father is JJ Señor Magnum, who also sired the U.S. National Champion Mare Honeys Delight RB and the Brazilian National Champion Filly Sahara Gallina. She is out of JJ Serena a daughter of the memorable Bey Shah son Shahllenger and out of a daughter of Ali Jamaal.

Lonco Dalilah is now retired from the ring and enjoying a life at Haras Lonco occupying her special place at the farm's broodmare band.

Lonco Albion (Bandit SRA x Shavanna El Madan by FA El Shawan)

Lonco Albion is beautiful dark bay (if not black) colt that comes from greatness on both sides of his pedigree.

That allied with the fact that he was named 2024 Chilean National Gold Champion Colt, makes him a strong





contender to soon occupy the highest spot as a future chief sire for Haras Lonco.

At the same time, he reflects his own greatness as an outstanding individual by any standards.

His father is the Brazilian National Champion Stallion Bandit SRA, one of the most important sons of the immortal DA Valentino out of the beautiful Chilean National Champion and US Top Ten Mare LL Albufera.

His mother Shavanna El Madan is a daughter of multi–Brazilian National Champion FA El Shawan, making her a maternal sister to one of the world's most famous stallions FA El Rasheem. Shavanna is also the mother of Brazilian National Champion Colts the full brothers Dominus Arabco and Intense Arabco, both by El Tino, therefore 3/4 brothers to Lonco Albion.

The Duch family expect great things for his future.

Lonco Bianca (Braavos HAV x HL Sophia by Matisse FM)

I am prone to affirm that the filly recently imported from Chile by Jorge Carrasco, Lonco Bianca, bred by Haras Lonco, is about to be on the top of the list of the crowd's favorites for the upcoming Brazilian National Show that she is likely to be entered in.

Lonco Bianca is indeed the full package. A filly that can honestly compete and win anywhere in the world.

After her National Junior Filly Gold title in Chile earlier last year, she appears to have traded her junior looks for a more mature and dramatically refined older filly. She has then won the title of Gold Champion Filly in the Cuenca Show in Ecuador.

Her hooky neck and her sculpted face decorated with those huge black eyes are bound to enchant all of those who witness her regal entrance at the show ring during any given show.

Carrying the banner of her family through her looks, one can spot the influence of the greats HDF Lugano specially through Bianca's sire Braavos HAV, as well as her maternal grandsire Matisse FM not to mention the Ali Jamaal and Bey Shah influence flowing through her veins.





Lonco Beauty (TS Zaarife Al Khidam x HLP Exquisita Bella by Krayon Sams)

The magnificent bay Lonco Beauty is no stranger to the winner's circle.

A dual Chilean National Champion as a youngster, she has won the title of Chilean National Champion Filly in 20222 and 2023, both times unanimously.

Names like FA El Shawan, Psymadre, DA Valentino, JJ Señor Magnum and Ali Jamaal are all present in the early generations of her pedigree.

Her value as an elite broodmare might be even higher than her success as a show horse.

Lonco Orion (Axell x Lonco Baby Maria)

Lonco Orion is a handsome grey colt with a noble heritage. On top of that he has been named 2024 Chilean National Gold Champion Colt.

His father, the Chilean National Champion Axell, is by multi National Champion Preludio OSB, and though still very young he sired both the above-mentioned Gold Jr. Champion of Chile as well as the Bronze Jr. Champion Colt, Lonco Maximo. Therefore, they represent the famed Mirage sire line, through the iconic Bey Shah.

Orion's mother is none other than Lonco Baby Maria, one of the foundation mares at Haras Lonco and the mother of the famous HL El Ganador.

Lonco Tristan (Braavos HAV x HL Sophia by Matisse FM)


If a lightning can strike twice in the same spot, Lonco Tristan is the living proof of that.

This amazing grey colt is a full brother to Lonco Bianca, and like her sister has a dramatically beautiful face with the most impressive big eyes and overall outstanding type.

Tristan is destined to the same glorious path of both his sister, as well as his famous grandparents HDF Lugano and Matisse FM.

Even at such a young age several foreign breeders are already inquiring about him. And by looking at his picture, this is just the beggining.







HLF Esmeralda (Axell x Trisha Van Ryad by Rya del Jamaal)

HLF Esmeralda brought moments of great joy to owners and breeders Ricardo Duch of Haras Lonco and Eduardo Fernandez of Haras Los Frenos, during the recent Chilean National Show, when she was crowned the National Champion Silver filly of Chle.

She is the result of crossing the Chilean National Champion Axell and the beautiful Ryad el Jamaal daughter Trisha Van Ryad, both born in Brazil. A cross that is likely to be repeated.

HLF Matilda (Parsifal Alfabia x Lonco Penelope by Braavos HAV)

HLF Matilda is Parsifal Alfabia's first foal in Chile. She reflects the confirmation of some important decisions taken in the recent past by Haras Lonco, specially the one of taking the chance on Parsifal and bringing him on lease to Haras Lonco last year.

Earlier this year, in Italy, Parsifal sired three exquisite fillies from the time he settled a handful of mares before his overseas journey. Matilda is a confirmation of that same quality he is printing on his early foals.

Matilda also represents the materialization of a promising cross for the farm, that of Parsifal Alfabia and the daughters of Braavos HAZ, thus balancing extreme beauty with the amazing attitude that her heritage encompasses.

And lastly, she brings strength to a very important partnership between Ricardo Duch and Eduardo Fernandez of Haras Los Frenos, whose collaboration has produced the reigning Chilean National Champion Silver Filly, the Axell daughter HLF Esmeralda.

Lonco Tiana (EKS Alihandro x Havanna Alfabia by Jakhal Alfabia)

The last horse that was presented to the guests at Lonco's Open House moments before my flight back to Brazil, was a statuesque black filly that was born just two days prior. She dazzled all of us in the audience. Her name is Lonco Tiana.

She was presented as the future of the farm's breeding program and, in many ways, she represents with perfection their latest moves in terms of new blood infusion performed with the import of the two full siblings Parsifal and Camilly both by EKS Alihandro with lines to the revered breeding program of Count Federico Zichy Thissen in Argentina.

Tiana is also by Alihandro and a Havanna Alfabia whose mother and both paternal grandparents were bred by ZT Arabians. Both her sire and maternal grandsire produces the beautiful black color that distinguishes her from others.

Her hesitant baby moves reminded me of how fragile life is and how important it is for us lovers of the Arabian Horse to protect their legacy and help it to keep moving forward.

This is a work of love and gladly the Duch Family will guard and protect their future, while redefining beauty with their own special philosophy, from the ancient Andes mountains to the world.





HLF MATILDA (Parsifal Alfabia x Lonco Penelope by Braavos HAV)
