Where quality comes first

Arabian Stud Europe is a boutique breeding farm in The Netherlands run by Talitha Bakker since 2003, the past years supported by her partner Louis Vulker.

Over the years, the farm collected a nice group of broodmares, all with strong pedigrees. Foundation mare of the studfarm is Manilah. A flea-bitten mare by Radameess II (Salaa el Dine) and out of Marischka, who traces back to the famous Moheba II / Halima lines. Manilah herself was a Gold medal champion and Best in show as a senior mare and gave the farm two gorgeous daughters. One is ASE Aaliyah Hlayyil – who is sired by the world champion stallion from Jordan – Hlayyil Radaman, who is by Kamar al Zaman and out of a very rare Jordanian strain through Haboub (Mashalla I). Aaliyah is the answer to modern breeding as she is free from Marwan and Justice blood. The second daughter from Manilah is ASE Bisiriya Hlayyil.

ASE Bisiriya Hlayyil

This mare has put Arabian Stud Europe on the map. She herself was shown only as a youngster where she received the silver medal. Later on she raced in endurance and successfully completed a CEI 2 120km race in Germany, qualifying herself for the CEI 3* of 160km! She was praised by her fast recovery and low heartrates.*

However, the real power of this mare is shown in her offspring. She was awarded by the Dutch registry with the ELITE certificate for her outstanding production and isase loved by breeders all around the world. Her first son ASE Faraaj (RFI Farid) won many gold medals, as well as a Best in show title and a 2nd place at the international show in Kuwait. After this colt, many followed like, ASE Juilliard (by Da Vinci FM) – who was bred in partnership with the Royal brothers from Libia and who won the Silver medal at the Tulip Cup in Holland. Another foal was ASE Magnificent (ZT Magnanimous), bred by Linjawi Arabians from Saudi Arabia and who is currently in endurance training with Anne Wegner. Bacchus KA (QR Marc), was bred and is still owned by Knocke Arabians and

was successfully shown in 2018. ASE Kamiliya Hlayyil (Kabil al Shaqab) won the silver medal at the Tulip Cup and again silver medal at the Arabian Horse weekend as both a foal and as a yearling. Bisharat al Dawla (RHR Heir of Marwan) bred and owned by Southern Chariot Stud, Australia is another stunning foal who will be shown next year. And of course ASE Farhan (RFI Farid), who won already 7 gold medals and 1 best in show title at just 14 months of age with Kelly Delen of Elba Training center on the lead! For 2020, Bisiriya is in foal to WH Justice and RHR Heir of Marwan, the first one bred and owned by Southern Chariot Stud, Australia



Geraldynne el Jamaal

Another foundation mare of Arabian Stud Europe is the Brazilian import: Geraldynne el Jamaal. Bred by Lenita Perroy from Brazil, Geraldynne is a direct daughter of Ali Jamaal and comes out of the Gainey bred Gai Natascha, who is by Bey Shah and out of Gai Radiance, who is the full sister to Gai Radiant. Geraldynne blessed us with many fillies. Three of which are being retained for the future. ASE Genevieve el Marc (by QR Marc), ASE Gabriella al Gazal (by Gazal al Shaqab) and the spectacular BLACK colt ASE Justice el Jamaal (by WH Justice) who will make his appearance in the showring next year! Therefore it is very important that they have good legs, good movement and a good disposition. We also care for strong pedigrees and proven damlines.
